Entry Limit

Swimmers in the 9-10, 11-12 and OPEN age groups are limited to three (3) individual events per day. Swimmers in the 8 & under age groups are limited to four (4) individual events per day. All entries are to be submitted in short course yards (no meters or conversions, please). This meet will be limited to the first 400 swimmers.

All events on Friday night may be limited to the top 32 swimmers after positive check-in. The positive check-in deadline will be 1 hour prior to the start of the meet (approximately 5:00). If the timeline allows for additional heats, additional heats will be swum. **If necessary the meet director reserves the right to limit participation in other selected events, or adjusting the "maximum number of events per session", in order to maintain a meet of reasonable time duration.** Clubs may check the meet homepage online on the Wednesday before the meet to determine if entries will be limited. Fees will be refunded at the meet if swimmers are not able to compete for this reason.

The 1650 may be limited to the top 16 swimmers in each gender after positive check-in. The positive check-in deadline will be 9:00 am on Saturday morning. All heats will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating gender, and may be combined at the meet director's discretion. All entrants in the 1650 are asked to provide a time or estimated time to be used for timeline purposes (NT's will not be accepted).

Website

Please visit the team website at www.daytonraiders.com for meet information, psych sheets, final results, and downloadable electronic files once the meet is concluded. The host entry chair reserves the right to allow changes and/or updates to team entries after the psych sheets are posed and before the heat sheet is sent for printing.

E-mail

Please provide the entry chair all email addresses your club administrators will use for communication. Once the deadline has passed and your team's entries have been processed, a psych sheet will be posted to the website and a notification email will be sent. It may be possible to add entries or fix any typos prior to the heat sheet being sent to the printers if a visiting club responds in a reasonable timeframe. Entry changes may be allowed, but swimmers cannot be deleted after the deadline; no-shows will not be refunded.

Rules

The meet will be conducted under the rules of USA-Swimming and Ohio Swimming, Inc. All participating swimmers, officials and coaches on deck must be members in good standing of USA-Swimming. No swimmer will be allowed to compete unless he/she is a member of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302. On-deck registration will not be accepted. **All officials and coaches will be asked to show proof of identification and current USA Swimming membership.** All personnel on the deck must wear identification tags. All persons wishing to photograph or videotape events from the deck must obtain an identification tag from the meet director. **Whistling is not permitted in the natatorium.**

This is a swim your own age meet. There will be 1 heat of each age group (9, 10, 11, and 12) in finals and 2 heats of the open age group. All 8 & under events will be contested during prelims as timed finals. All Friday night events and the 1650 will be contested as timed finals. All 25 yard events will be timed using stop watches.

A swimmer must notify the scratch table if they are scratching finals within 30 minutes after the announcement and posting of prelim results. Any swimmer qualifying for any final heat who fails to compete in the final without properly scratching, shall be barred from his/her next individual event. On the last day of the meet, failure to scratch for the final shall result in a \$50.00 fine per event charged to and payable by the swimmer's club to the host team.

Participants in the 500 must provide their own counter (if desired). Participants in the 1650 must provide their own timer and counter (if desired).

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Under no circumstances are cameras or any other recording device allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for race starts during the competition and warm-up. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.

Adaptive Swimming: Dayton Raiders welcome swimmers with disabilities to participate in the meet. The Meet Director requests 1) the athlete's coach provide advance notice of any necessary accommodations; and 2) list in the email with the Hy-Tek entry (or on paper) the swimmer's name, entry times, strokes/distances, days/sessions, and how the swimmer prefers to be seeded. Swimmers with a disability will be seeded with the same age group in either the same distance race or a longer distance race (i.e., 50 free during the 100 free). More information is available under Athletes>Adapted Swimming on the Ohio Swimming website.

Warmup Procedures

Warm-up times will be announced once all entries are received and a timeline has been established. By default, USA-Swimming and Ohio LSC swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet. However, if the coaches and Meet Referee agree, a 'control-your-own-lane' warm-up procedure may override the default format. The diving well will be available during the course of the meet for continuous warmup/warmdown.

Deck Entries

Deck entries will be permitted if the meet is not closed and will only fill open lanes; no new heats will be added. The cost per event is twice the individual event fee. If a swimmer is not previously entered in the meet, then the swimmer must show proof of registration for the current season and pay the applicable \$2 Ohio Swimming, Inc. surcharge in addition to any event fees.

Clerk-of-Course

There will be no clerk-of-course or 'bullpen'. All events will be announced over the loudspeaker. Swimmers should report directly to the starting blocks for their events. **Any swimmer, morning or afternoon session that leaves the pool area is responsible for returning to the pool area for their event.**

Awards and Scoring

This meet is an age group format meet. Ribbons will be awarded for first thru eighth for the following ages: 6un, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and OPEN. Heat Ribbons will be given in all 10 & under age groups. Team scoring will follow standard USA rules for an 8-lane pool.

Swimmer Conduct

Swimmers are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. It is the responsibility of all parents to ensure all minor spectators are well behaved and under supervision at all times. Any swimmer or minor spectator acting in an inappropriate manner will be reported to their coach or parent for disciplinary action which may include removal from the meet and facility. Any swimmer or spectator caught damaging or defacing property will be banned from the meet and appropriate remedies for damages will be pursued.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Officials

Facilities

The facilities at include an eight-lane pool, hybrid STS and Colorado Timing System, and horn start with touchpads at the start end of the course.

There is a large spectator area with a clear view of the pool. A concession stand offering a variety of foods will be open. Hospitality for coaches and workers will be available in a separate room.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. The competition water depth is measured at or greater than a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls.

Directions to Dayton Raider Aquatic Center 560 Grange Hall Rd., Beavercreek, Ohio 45430

From I-675 take the Indian Ripple Rd Exit, head east (if traveling northbound on 675 turn right; if traveling southbound on 675 turn left). Travel approximately one mile to the 3rd traffic light and turn left onto Grange Hall Rd. The aquatic center will be approximately one mile on your right. Off-site parking may be necessary dependent upon the number of entries. Any change will be communicated to the entry chair prior to the meet.

USA-Swimming SWIMS database

USA-SWIMS database is the official database of tracking performances for all USA athletes. The host club will be responsible for submitting an electronic backup of the meet shortly after the meet's conclusion to the Ohio Swimming Permanent Office for uploading to the official USA-Swimming database, SWIMS. This will be done in accordance with the policies & procedures set forth by Ohio Swimming, Inc and the USA-Swimming governing body.
