#### **Entry Information:**

All entries must be submitted electronically **by 4:00PM on Monday January 20, 2020. Entries must be e-mailed to Nick Ljubi: ljubine@gmail.com** 

The entry process for the 2020 OCC Tournament requires electronic entries. The computer software of choice is the Hy-Tek Team Manager Program. An events file for TM will be provided to you for your entries format.

All competitors must be listed in the events the competitor will be swimming.

All divers should be entered in the entry file submitted for the swim and dive champs that is due Monday, January 20th.

Relay swimmers do not have to be entered, unless they are competing in relays only. Relay times must be entered for seeding purposes. There is only 1 relay entry per school per relay event.

Entry times must be entered for seeding purposes. If a competitor/relay does not have an entry time, they will be entered with a "no time" (NT).

All competitors must be entered with their **full name and grade level**.

Additions/deletions are allowed in accordance to the rule approved by the Athletic Directors, which allows for substitutions for a swimmer that is scratched from the meet.

## **Meet Information:**

All participants must be eligible under the rules of the OHSAA.

Coaches are responsible for reading and understanding the 2019-2020 NFHS Swimming & Diving Rules for championship swimming.

The Swimming and Diving meets will be held concurrently.

Each school is permitted four (4) entries in each individual event and one (1) entry in each relay event.

An individual may be entered in no more than two (2) individual events. At the coaches meeting only scratches and substitutions shall be made.

An individual shall be permitted to participate in a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which shall be individual events.

In relay events, eight (8) individuals may be listed as entrants; any four (4) may compete. Certification in the relay **shall not count as an entry <u>unless</u> the individual actually competes in the relay event**. Relay cards with swimmer's names must be submitted directly after the coaches meeting.

All events will alternate; girl's events will be odd numbered events and boy's events will be even numbered events.

The meet shall be a timed final championship meet.

Championship scoring for sixteen (16) places shall be followed.

The official coach/representative must be with their team/swimmers at all times. During the coaches meeting a coach/rep shall remain with the team. If it is determined that the coach/representative is not in attendance at any time, the team and all swimmers will be disqualified from further competition.

Non-competing team members, cheerleaders, significant others, etc. must purchase admission tickets (\$10/All Day Pass). Individuals that are not competing may not sit in the competitor's area(s).



EACH TEAM IS TO PROVIDE 2 VOLUNTEERS FOR THE ENTIRE MEET. THE TEAMS ARE WELCOME TO HAVE 2 DIFFERENT SHIFTS WITH 4 PEOPLE COVERING THE TEAM'S COMMITMENT. THOSE TIMERS WILL NOT HAVE TO PAY FOR ADMISSION. SUBMIT THOSE NAMES IN EMAIL TO MEET DIRECTOR.

Passes for contestants that are "scratched" from the meet must be returned to the meet director.

No air horns or noise making devices will be permitted in the natatorium. Only school banners may be used. No signs shall be posted without the meet director's permission. The use of video-recording equipment must adhere to the OHSAA policy.

Coaches and competing team members shall use the designated seating areas and are responsible for cleaning their area upon leaving. Coaches and competing team members are asked to not sit in the seating reserved for paid spectators.

Only officially certified high school coaches/reps, swimmers, officials, and newspaper photographers are permitted on the pool deck during the warm-up and meet competition.

All swimmers, including relay swimmers, must stay behind the timers before and after they swim.

Neither Kenyon College nor the meet management will be responsible for personal valuables.

Each school shall administer its own discipline and litter problems. Any individual(s) found guilty of vandalism, theft, or conduct unbecoming to an athlete will be barred from further competition.
