10 Black Robic Stopwatches

Timer Sheets for each lane on clipboards.

Dolphin and Robic Cheat Sheets for each stop watch.

Heat Winner ribbons (~100)

Setup for the Meet

EQUIPMENT

Support the Timing Assistant in powering on and distributing the three CTS Dolphin and one black Robic stopwatches to each lane.

Include the Cheat sheet with each stopwatch.

PRINTOUTS

Setup timer sheets for each lane on to a clip board with a ballpoint pen and Place clip board at each respective lane.

TESTING

The Starter, Referee, Timing assistant, and or Computer Operator will lead a few tests of the timing system before the meet starts. Be support for the timers to make sure everyone is ready to go and resolves any problems that show up. (e.g. Stopwatch not on or out of power, clarification of instructions, etc)

Running the Meet

Positioned on the west side of lane one.

Start both of your Robin stopwatches (red and blue) at the beginning of every race.

Keep an eye out for timers that have a failure to let them borrow one of your backups.

You are the liaison between the timing assistant/Computer team and the timers. Provide guidance from computer team to timers as needed. (e.g. consistently inaccurate times. Missing information from timer sheet. Clarification of information on timer sheet.

End of Meet

Support the Timing Assistant in packing out all timing supplies.

Return clipboards and pens to grey chest.
