MEET DETAILS:

Swim & Dive 4A District Meet

Friday, January 20th, 2022

- Warm Ups Begin at – 8:00 am - lanes assigned sent the week of meet
- The Meet Starts at - 10:00 am - when all teams have completed warm ups.
- The Diving Competition will happen after the swimming competition.

LOCATION: The YMCA of Highland Lakes Aquatics Center

Parking Located On Site (Busses-please park in the back of the YMCA)

From TX-29 State Hwy 29 (US-183 Hwy N)

- Take Hwy 29 N or US-183 HWY North
- Continue on Hwy 29 or US-183 North
- Turn onto W State Hwy 29
- Continue straight onto TX-29 W/W State Hwy 29 (Pass The Whataburger)
- Turn left onto N U.S. Hwy 281/S Water St. (Pass O'Reilly Auto Parts)
- Buses should park at the back parking lot behind the YMCA near the baseball fields on the right side when you enter the YMCA.

POOLS: The competition will take place in six (6) lanes. During competition lanes 9 and 10 will be used for warm up and warm down (No Diving). Lanes 7 and 8 will remain empty during competition. The Warm up's down will take place in the 10 lane, 25 yard indoor pool before and after the Meet. There is no diving allowed in the shallow pool. Open Warm Up/Cool Down will be allowed during the Meet in the shallow indoor therapeutic pool, Note: this is a heated pool, use your best judgment.

SPECTATORS:

Spectators are permitted to attend. Entry fee for spectators will be \$6 per adult/child and \$2 per student with their ID. Heat Sheets will be sold at the door for \$2. Parking is limited at the YMCA and will be available on a first come, first serve basis.

*Masks are not required, and we ask that you self-monitor for any illness or symptoms.

SEEDING: The meet will be timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest. Swimmers who are entered with NT for No Time will be seeded in the slowest heats. Coaches are encouraged to have an accurate time for every swimmer. No proof of time is needed

ENTRIES: All entries must be sent electronically via email using Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager computer software or Emailed Spreadsheet for Smaller Teams (Less Than 5 swimmers) without the Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager Software.

This includes team relays and individual events.

- There are no limitations on the number of swimmers per individual event, however only the four (4) competitors from each team may score points for any given event.
- Each athlete may enter a maximum of four (4) events of which no more than two (2) events may be individual events.
- Teams may enter only 2 entries per each of the 3 relays, please number relays A and B. Only 1 relay can advance to the regional competition.
- Relays are encouraged to be entered with 4 swimmers to enter the event and alternates as available. If your relay does not change and is correct on the published heat sheet, before the meet there is no need to enter a relay card.
- Change Only Relay Cards are due before 9:00 am the day of the meet.

Please use the official UIL Team Code and use the numeric grade level (09, 10, 11, 12) for each swimmer/diver. Also please refrain from using the short team name or LSC code.

If you do not receive an email confirming your entries were received on Tuesday, November 28th, please contact Rene Rodriguez by 10am Wednesday morning.

ORDER OF EVENTS:

Standard high school order of events will be followed, with the exception of diving. There will be 5 minute breaks after the 200 Medley Relay, 50 Free (15 Minutes), 500 Free, and 100 Breast.

SCORING: Individual Events:

1st - 16th place: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events:

1st - 16th place: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

AWARDS: There will be Medals & Ribbons for Individuals & Relay placings up to 10th place at this meet. The top Girls Team, Boys Team & Top Over All Team will win team planks.

RULES AND SANCTIONS:

The 2022-2023 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and all UIL rules and guidelines will be applied.

Championship Meet – All Rules for a Championship Meet will be observed.

Declared False Start – A declared false start is allowed before the short whistles of a swimmers heat for that event, DFS must be communicated to the Meet Admin or the Deck Referee, A DFS card (admin table) is required for that event signed by the swimmer or the coach.

USAS Observation - This meet will be USA swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. Please be sure that USA swimming IDs and birthdates are correct in the Hy-Tek entry file, or times for that athlete will not be uploaded into SWIMS Database.

TIMING SYSTEM:

A colorado electronic timing system with Daktronics electronic scoreboard will be used to time the meet. Two watches per lane will be used as back up. This meet will be available on Meet Mobile with free heat sheets.

TIMERS: We ask that each team submits **4 timers and or volunteers** for the meet. Should there be any open timing or volunteer positions, visiting teams may be asked to provide more than 4 volunteers.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers, or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event. Also, flash photography is not permitted during all the diving events as this is unsafe for the athletes.

Drones – No drones are allowed to be flown during the meet or warm ups inside the YMCA swim center

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION:

Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Athletes will have access to changing rooms, showers, and restrooms at the YMCA.

SPECTATORS/CHEERING:

All bells, whistles and other noise creating effects are not allowed during any part of the swim meet. This is very distracting to the swimmer/divers while competing. Also, flash photography is not permitted during all the diving events as this is unsafe for the athletes.

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will be available at the meet in the lobby area of the YMCA for purchase.

HOSPITALITY:

There will be hospitality for all Coaches and Officials in the pool area by the diving blocks. Coffee is complimentary and located in the lobby area of the YMCA.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

- All coaches should self screen themselves and athletes before arriving. Anyone who does not feel well, or shows symptoms of COVID will not be permitted to enter the facility.

- Spectators will be permitted with their payment of the entry fee. The meet will be on Meet Mobile, however heat sheets will be available for purchase for \$2.

- Spectators, athletes, and coaches are not required to wear face coverings, but they are welcome to wear if they wish.
