AWAY TEAM WARMUPS BEGIN AT 7:20

Welcome to the St Johns Stingrays! We are excited to have you as our guests and hope that you enjoy our facilities as much as we do! In order to ensure a relaxed, fun, and positive atmosphere for all, we ask that you please review and respect a few guidelines:

- 1) **Parking:** *Please carpool!* We share parking with the Golf Club which is very busy on weekends. We ask that you please respect the golfers and residents accessing other amenities. Parking is available in the main lot or along the **right** side (as you enter) of the roadways designated in **green**. Please do not park in the **red** areas or **on the grass as it will damage sprinklers**.



- 2) **Visitor Seating:** We want to make everyone as comfortable and as near the action as possible. We should be able to accommodate most visiting teams within the pool area marked in **green**. If overflow seating is required, you may use the areas marked in **orange**. Access to the pool deck is indicated with a **★**.



- 3) **Pool Layout:** Parents may not enter any areas marked in **red**. This is reserved for coaches and volunteers running the meet. Our ready bench area is marked in **blue** and feeds in from the area marked with the **★** - please drop off your swimmers here. For 25yd events, we start from the blocks. You can cheer on all swimmers from the shallow end of the pool or from the side opposite the areas marked in red. **NO pictures will be allowed behind starts per SJSSL Guidelines.**



4) **Care and Feeding:** Your swimmers will be hungry (you may be too!). We will have concessions available within the pool area serving cold drinks and snacks (please bring cash). Please ensure you and your swimmers are properly hydrated - bring water. Shade structures and personal seating is highly encouraged. **ALSO – ALL HEAT WINNERS CAN TAKE THEIR RIBBONS TO CONCESSIONS FOR A FREE ICE-POP!**

5) **Volunteers:** Please check in before the meet with your volunteer coordinator and be aware of the announcements when it's your time to go. We appreciate your help - this would not be possible without you!

6) **Other info:** *This is an early morning for everyone. We are ALL volunteers and we are doing the best we can.*

Please be on time and ensure your swimmers are ready and marked properly. This will help the meet run efficiently. There is limited time to get all our swimmers through the events before the pool must be opened to the community – please have them ready to go! The meet must end by noon per pool policy.

We will follow league rules, but we will always give the benefit of doubt to the swimmers and encourage a positive atmosphere for them.

Listen to ready bench calls and be aware of the events. We will start events when ready, even if all swimmers are not present.

The recreational pool areas is “closed”. Please monitor your children and ask that they not run on the pool deck.

7) And finally, **HAVE FUN AND RELAX!!!!** SJSSL is a developmental summer league focused on positivity and fun. We love all our swimmers and hope they get the best experience possible out of this event. Cheer for all, especially those who may be struggling, and help out where you can – we're all in this together!
