- II. By-Laws & League Rules Language Change **ROLL CALL VOTE**
 - a. Article X. B. Each swimmer must have competed in to two (2) league dual meets to qualify for championships. (*Motion Passed 8-0*)
 - b. Article X. C. Seeded entry times for Championships shall be only those swum during the dual meet season. Championship entries must have a seeded time for heating purposes, removes language pertaining to (NT). Swimmer must contest the event during the year to swim that event at championships. (*Motion Passed 8-0*)
- III. Treasurer's Report
 - a. 1 May 2022 balance *\$8436.62*
 - b. Check 1073; \$52.99 printer supplies to Alex Blakely to be reissued to Williamsport representative at the 1 June 2022 meeting.
 - c. Check 1078; \$437.25 senior blankets to be reissued to Sunbury/Norry representative at the 1 June 2022 meeting.
 - d. League authorizes the treasury to purchase needed supplies (checks, stamps, etc.) to conduct business on behalf of the league without need for further clearance or vote.
 - e. League gives the treasurer permission to destroy/dispose of financial records outside of the tax audit period of 7 years.
 - f. Teams below need league insurance; final count of swimmers to be submitted to the Treasurer by Friday, 27 May 2022.

- IV. Communication Sheets
 - a. Distributed to League teams via email from league president on Sunday, 1 May 2022.
 - b. Communication sheets with local pandemic concerns to be submitted to Brandon or Julie by 1 June 2022 to update the league's website prior to the first competition weekend.
- V. Additional Meets
 - a. Meets (above and beyond the 5 scheduled) between GSVAL member teams are permitted with the following considerations.
 - i. Meets are considered exhibition, not counting towards league standings.

- ii. Meets must be conducted in accordance with GSVAL bylaws and rules regarding officiation, timing, swimmer eligibility, and scoring.
 - iii. Swimmer times from the exhibition meets are permissible as seed times for championships but CANNOT be used to break standing league records.
- VI. Championships
 - a. Tri-Town will present the league with the event order and schedule for the day at the 1 June 2022 league meeting.
 - b. Lock Haven is to order and design the awards in accordance with league bylaws for the championship meet. Lock Haven is also responsible for the Senior Gifts; league advises them to coordinate with Sunbury/Norry to acquire "leftovers".
- VII. Officials Training
 - a. Williamsport will organize a training TBD: proposed date 10 June 2022 & proposed location Robert M. Sides music store.
 - b. Danville will host a training by Steve Shannon (SunNorry) on Sunday, 5 June 2022 from 1-5 pm. Cost \$20.00.
- VIII. Meet Contest Organization Discussion
 - a. Sunbury Norry provided the league members a list of attached documents as an assistive measure via email on Monday, 2 May 2022.
 - b. 6 league team use Swimtopia for registration, meet declaration, volunteer, timer, and official sign-ups. Teams with Swimtopia in place were encouraged to manage a meet with Meet Maestro (as well as meet manager) for demonstration purposes.
 - c. Panel discussion regarding the potential unification of the league to all adopt Swimtopia and Meet Maestro. Williamsport will schedule a swimtopia presenter for our September meeting. The league asks that each team explore swimtopia throughout the current season for its potential adoption & implementation for the 2023 summer season. More discussion solicited and forthcoming.
- IX. New Business
 - a. Williamsport will be hosting the Cannonball Classic on the morning of 17 July 2022 (done by 1pm). Chad will be forwarding event information and registration details before the end of this month. Teams are expected to dress one coach or team representative as a pirate. Possible cardboard regatta boat race in the discussion/planning process.
 - b. Lewisburg motioned, Loyalsock seconded, an edit to the GSVAL by-laws pertaining to swim up eligibility. Motion is to replace the language from Article X. E. Remove "**There are no swim-ups for the league championship meet.**" Replace with "A swimmer can ~~only~~ compete in the age group events corresponding to the swimmer's league age or move up one (1) age group and must remain in that age group for the entire championship meet". The change would be consistent with the swimmer eligibility for the dual meet season as defined by Article VI. C. A roll call vote of in-person representatives is schedule for the 1 June 2022 meeting.
