The pool is located behind Belton High School in the large white building. Please follow the directions below, as google will send you through parking lots with closed gates and you will have to back up!

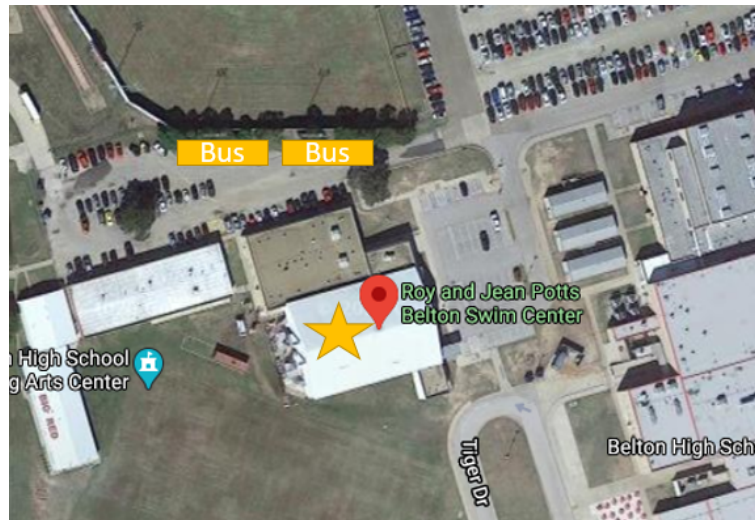
From Austin I-35

- Take exit 292
- Turn at the light onto Loop 121
- Take a left at the light onto Sparta Rd
- Take a right onto Dunn's Canyon
- Take a right onto Tiger Drive (at the entrance to Chisholm Trail Park).
- At the stop sign take a left to go by the tennis courts
- Loop around until you see Belton HS and a large parking lot. The Swim Center is the large white building at the end of the parking lot.
- Buses should park at the small parking lot on the side of the swim center. See the second picture below for a close up view.



BUS PARKING

Teams with buses should park in the parking lot entrance just before the Swim Center in a single file line.



POOLS: Competition will take place in the eight (8) lane, 25 yard indoor pool. Warm up and warm down will take place in the three (3) lane, 25 yard shallow indoor pool. There is no diving allowed in the shallow pool.

SPECTATORS:

Spectators are permitted to attend. Entry fee for spectators will be \$5 per adult/child and \$2 per student with their ID. Heat Sheets will be sold at the door for \$2 (Cash ONLY). Parking is VERY limited at the Swim Center and will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Overflow parking can be found behind the jumbotron at Tiger Field and spectators can walk through the soccer fields. School is in session, spectators MUST enter off of Dunns Canyon by Chisholm Trail Park.

Masks are not required, but are encouraged.

SEEDING: The meet will be timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest. Swimmers who are entered with NT for No Time will be seeded in the slowest heats. Coaches are encouraged to have an accurate time for every swimmer. No proof of time is needed

ENTRIES: All entries must be sent electronically via email using Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager computer software. Include relays and relay only swimmers.

There are no limitations on the number of swimmers per individual event, however only the four (4) competitors from each team may score points for any given event. Each athlete may enter a maximum of four (4) events of which no more than two (2) events may be individual events.

Teams may enter only 2 relays, please number relays A and B.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The Hy-Tek entry file must be sent to sean.barry@bisd.net by **Tuesday, October 4th, 2022 by 6:00pm.**

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are \$15 per athlete entered in the meet. There is no fee for relays. Entry fees are due at the start of the competition.

ORDER OF EVENTS:

Standard high school order of events will be followed, with the exception of diving. There will be no diving at this meet. There will be 5 minute breaks after the 200 Medley Relay, 50 Free, 500 Free, and 100 Breast.

Relay Events:

AWARDS:

There will be no awards at this meet.

RULES AND SANCTIONS:

The 2022-2023 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and all UIL rules and guidelines will be applied. Pending official availability, this meet MAY be USA swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. Please be sure that USA swimming IDs are correct in the Hy-Tek entry file.

OFFICIALS:

Certified UIL and/or USA swimming officials are welcome! If a team has anyone interested, please contact the Meet Director - sean.barry@bisd.net for more information.

TIMING SYSTEM:

A colorado electronic timing system with Daktronics electronic scoreboard will be used to time the meet. Two watches per lane will be used as back up. This meet will be available on Meet Mobile with free heat sheets.

TIMERS: Belton HS will provide all timers and volunteers for the meet. Should there be any open timing or volunteer positions, visiting teams may be asked to provide timers.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers, or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION:

Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Athletes will have access to changing rooms, showers, and restrooms.

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will not be available at the meet. Teams are welcome to bring their own meals, and drinks, but must clean up their team area after the meet.

HOSPITALITY:

There will be hospitality in the front office of the Swim Center.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

All coaches should self screen themselves and athletes before arriving. Anyone who does not feel well, or shows symptoms of COVID will not be permitted to enter the facility.

Spectators will be permitted with their payment of the entry fee. The meet will be on Meet Mobile, however heat sheets will be available for purchase for \$2.

Spectators, athletes, and coaches are not required to wear face coverings, but they are strongly encouraged.
