

Sugarwood Stingrays want to inform visiting Swim Team of the following.

1. Directions can be found on the GKAIISA website or below to Sugarwood Stingrays Pool
2. Parking is NOT allowed on ANY streets within the subdivision. Orange cones will be placed on both sides of the street to indicate NO PARKING allowed. There is PLENTY of parking available in the GRASSY fields around the pool. Follow the instructions of the Parking Attendants that will be available to direct vehicles. Please instruct your swimmer families to observe these parking requirements in respect for the Sugarwood Subdivision Homeowners. Any vehicles parking on the subdivision streets WILL BE TOWED at owner's expense.
3. Visiting swim team is to utilize the south side of the pool in and outside of the fence as the visitor's side for the swim meet. Inside the pool area there will be allowed a single row of seating only along the pool rope and one row of seating along the inside of the pool fence. A clear unobstructed path must be maintained around the pool at all times for the swim meet.
4. Visiting swim team warm-ups begin at 5:30PM.
5. 5:45PM Brief meeting with parent volunteers of both teams.
6. 5:55PM first shift parent volunteers are to be in place for both teams
7. 6:00PM swim meet start time.

Some things about how Sugarwood Stingrays run their swim meets

1. SWSR will be using Swim Team US website for scoring and 2018 is the first year SWSR has done this. Please assist with file share by NOON on swim meet day.
2. Visiting Team will need to bring a computer for scoring purposes also.
3. SWSR Ribbons will be available for visiting team
4. 8-under and 9-10 relays swimmers #1 and #3 will enter the pool off the starting blocks, Swimmers #2 and #4 will start their leg of the relay IN THE WATER. NO DIVING IN THE SHALLOW END OF THE SWSR POOL.
5. SWSR requests visiting teams to provide
 - a. 3 timers per shift
 - b. 3 scribes per shift
 - c. 4 runners per shift
 - d. 3 clerk of course per shift for visiting team lanes (2,4,6), one worker per lane
 - e. 1 scorer per shift
 - f. 1 sorter per shift
 - g. 1 computer input per shift
 - h. 1 ribbons 2nd shift only
 - i. 2 jump judges for entire meet
 - j. 1 finish judge per shift
 - k. 2 stroke and turn judges per shift

1. there may be additional workers needed as determine prior to meet starting or at their discretion the previous is the minimum needed. SWSR does not have a concession area but will have a FOOD Truck servicing the swim meet.

1. Head south on N. Campbell Station Rd toward Kingston Pike 1.5 mi
2. Turn right at Kingston Pike/TN-1/US-11/US-70 1.4 mi.
3. Turn left at Sugarwood Dr 0.2 mi
4. Turn right at Butternut Ln 0.2 mi
5. Turn right at Butternut Circle
6. Turn right on pool access road - plenty of parking is provided adjacent to the pool in the grassy field follow parking attendant's directions when arriving for a swim meet.

*****NOTE*** parking is NOT allowed on ANY Sugarwood Subdivision Streets. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNERS EXPENSE !!!!. There is plenty of parking around the pool in the grassy area. Look for and follow the parking attendants directions once you arrive at the pool.**
