Lake Hills is very excited to host Barton Creek West this Saturday morning. Please read the following information regarding logistics for the day of the meet. Please note our volunteer requests.

SET UP LOCATION

Barton Creek West will set up on the grassy section of the lake park (near the water), outside of the fenced-in pool area. Your team's area is shaded some by trees, but you may want to bring some tents for additional shade. You will want to bring your own chairs and blankets to make yourselves comfortable.

Please ensure kids and parents pick up after themselves after the meet—trash-cans are located around the lake park. (We suggest assigning a clean-up crew as one of your volunteer assignments!)

FOOD/BEVERAGE

Payment options: Cash and Credit Card

Lake Hills concessions will be open for the duration of the meet. We will sell assorted breakfast items, (including vegetarian options), as well as snacks and sweet treats. Lunch will be offered, contingent on meet conclusion time. Coffee and a variety of drinks will also be available for purchase.

PARKING

Parking is very limited, and our pool parking lot requires a permit—towing is strictly enforced. Families should plan to park on the side streets in the neighborhood where there are no posted restrictions. We are not allowed to park on the side of Edgewater in restricted areas. Lake Hills will have parking attendants directing you where there are open spaces. Please abide by any posted restrictions on streets. Arrive early, and carpool if possible! Thank you for your understanding.

RESTRICTED AREAS

- Do not stand in front of the computer area or near the starter area. The pool bleacher stands (near the play-scape) is best place to cheer for swimmers. Please help keep swimmers and parents away from the edge of the pool on the lake-side. We need to keep this section clear for stroke judges, coaches, and runners.
- Ready bench is for swimmers only. Please keep extra parents and swimmers out of this area.
- Timer tent and finish line are very crowded areas and should be limited to

swimmers and timers only.

- Computer tent is limited to LH computer volunteers and coaches. If there are questions related to times, results, or DQs, please communicate with your President first. Each Team President should resolve those issues.
- Please keep children out of the baby pool and shallow end of the main pool at all times during the meet.
- Please try to refrain from allowing kids to play in the sand before swimming in the pool—use the shower to wash off before entering the pool area, as needed.

VOLUNTEERS

- **Stroke Judges:** The visiting team will provide **2 stroke judges** on deck at all times. All stroke judges will meet on deck at 7:45a. You may substitute as you see fit; however, please remind anyone rotating out to provide the reliever all pertinent information. Our head stroke judge is Rob Housley; he can be contacted at xxxxx prior to the meet if you have questions.
- **Ready Bench:** The visiting team will provide **3 volunteers** at ready bench at all times (2 to work ready bench; 1 to work relays). Our Head Ready bench volunteer is Andrew Schulz.
- **Timers:** The visiting team will provide **6 timers** at all times. They can rotate in and out, but we need 6 for the entire meet. We are also requesting that Barton Creek West provide 3 back-up timers to cover any timer gaps during the first or second shift of the meet. Our head timer is Blake Garrison.
- **Awards/Ribbons:** Please provide **2 volunteers** from your team to help hand out heat winner ribbons. One will work the first half and one will work the second half.
- **Clean-Up:** Please designate a volunteer to make sure the BCW team area is free from litter and to gather misplaced items following the meet.

COMPUTER

- **Entries/Roster:** Please contact Amanda and Ashley directly if this timing does not work. We will not have heat sheets available during the meet, so please provide to your parents ahead of time.
- **Meet changes:** We strongly discourage deck entries, but understand there are circumstances requiring it. Also, please ask your computer team to keep us abreast of any last-minute changes. It's much easier to take care of changes before we are on deck for the meet early Saturday AM. Please communicate to your team these should occur as a last resort. We will accept deck entries no later than 30 minutes prior to the meet start.

GENERAL

- **Parent/Coach relay**—respond back ASAP if you have any coaches/parents who are interested in participating in a relay after the meet!!
- ***If there are weather related concerns leading up to the meet, the team presidents should connect with Jessica and Julie directly to discuss contingencies.***
