

# 2023 NWAL Red 1 Division Championship Meet

**When:** Saturday, June 17th, 2023; Meet starts at 8:30am

**Location:** Cy-Ranch High School Natatorium  
10700 Fry Road, Cypress, TX 77433

**Parking:** See map. Reserved spots must have a tag. Do not block area for food trucks in the back of the school. Handicap parking is available in the back of the school near the cafeteria.

## Indoor Setup

Air-conditioned setup is available in the main school hallway and in the cafeteria. Each team has a designated area — see attached maps. No setup in the pool stands. The school may be accessed via the rear cafeteria doors or the main hallway doors leading to the pool. The doors at the front of the school will be locked — you will not be able to enter through these doors.

## Food Trucks / Concessions

A variety of food trucks will be on site to provide food items and limited drinks. These food trucks will be located in the back of the school and will be accessible through the cafeteria doors. There will not be any separate concessions. Spectators and swimmers should bring plenty of water, Gatorade, and other snacks for the meet.

## Awards

Individual awards given by age group and gender: 6U, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-18. Medals for 1st - 8th place. Ribbons 9th - 16th place. Points are only awarded to 12th place.

Relay awards given by age group and gender (except mixed relay): 6U, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-18. Medals 1st to 3rd place. Ribbons for 4th and 5th place.

Team trophies will be awarded after the conclusion of the meet and after all results have been verified.

## Pool Deck Restrictions

The pool deck is closed to all persons except swimmers, coaches, safety marshals, officials, meet personnel, and timers. If you are asked to leave the deck by any meet personnel or Cy-Ranch staff, please do so. It is for your safety.

## Volunteering

See your team volunteer coordinator for your assigned roles and duties.

Shift changes will occur after events 18, 30, 48 and 60. The last shift will run until the end of the meet.

Please report to your area on time and get an update of the job description from the person you are taking over for. The meet is to keep running and volunteers need to filter in and out without stopping the meet.

If your replacement does not arrive on time, please stay a little longer and reach out to your team's volunteer coordinator.

**Do not abandon your role/duty.**

## **FACILITY RULES**

- Seating in the pool stands is come and go only. NO SETUP allowed in stands.
- Please follow the traffic flow on the maps.
- NO alcohol, tobacco, or vapes are permitted on school property.
- Setup is only allowed within the blue tape. DO NOT block walkways, doorways, exits or bathrooms.
- NO running, horseplay, or throwing/bouncing balls allowed in school.
- NO setup is allowed on the upper level of the cafeteria.
- NO setup in the front entrance of the school (around horse statue) — will be roped off.
- NO one is allowed on the stairways or in the upper level of the school.
- NO blow up mattresses, bean bags, cots, strollers, playpens, hammocks, or large inflatable seating is allowed.
- NO blankets spread out on floor (encourages “campfire” set up — see meet highlights).
- NO steel chair legs are allowed on the school’s floors.
- NO setup is allowed overnight. All belongings must be picked up.
- NO setup is allowed on the outdoor walkways. These walkways must be kept clear per Cy-Ranch’s fire code.
- NO generators are allowed inside or outside on the grass areas.
- NO playing/jumping off the small brick walls / ledges in the courtyard outside the cafeteria.
- You may use wagons to transport your gear inside, but the wagons must be stowed outside during the meet.
- Cy-Ranch security, Cy-Ranch staff and Divisional / Team Leadership staff reserve the right to remove anyone from the premises who violate any of the above rules.
- If you or a guest drop something under the bleachers, please be aware that it may take up to 2 weeks to retrieve your item.

- No blankets/tarps, chair arrangement (see picture to right)
- No horseplaying, no throwing balls
- No alcohol, tobacco, vapes
- School Entrance: Back of school or doors near Natatorium

- **NO** Parents

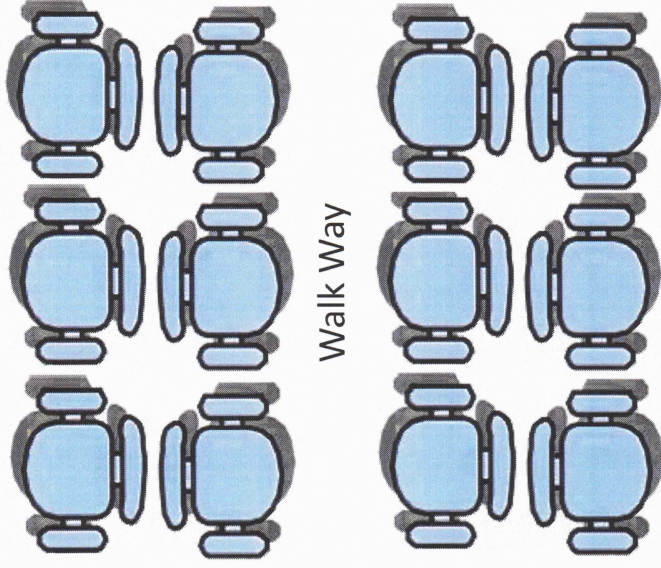
Natatorium: Come and go sitting (**NO SETUP**), please follow entrance/exit signs (one way in, one way out)

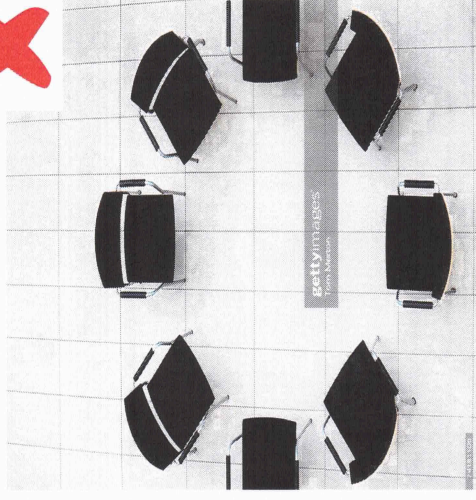
- Please report to area on time/when called upon

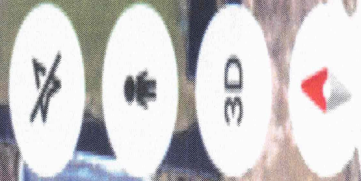
