Dear CMSL Coaches and Reps:

With the 2022 swim season underway, we want to start the preparations for the 2022 Straehle Invitational to be held at PADONIA on Wednesday July 27, 2022. Information such as entry forms, instructions, directions and other information will again be posted on [the Straehle 2022 website](https://straehle2022.wixsite.com/straehle-invitationa).

## **ENTRY INFORMATION** (excerpted from the CMSL Handbook)

- Eligibility:
  - Competitors must have swum in at least two dual meets during the current season to be eligible to qualify for League Individual Championships.
- Entries:
  - No contestants may enter more than 3 individual events and a relay. Each team may enter 1 relay team in each relay event.
  - Qualifying times shall be determined by the League Statistician and approved by the Board of Directors and available at the spring meeting. This meet is a championship meet for all swimmers of the league; therefore, care should be taken to include as many swimmers as possible while keeping the meet to within 6 hours.
  - Contestants entered for a relay event must have swum on an official relay in a dual meet which recorded a time that qualifies for that event. This includes relay alternates.
  - Times submitted for seeding purposes must have been swum in a dual meet of the current season. Converted times (from SCM to SCY) are allowed.

- Times submitted for seeding purposes must be converted to the distance (yards or meters) of the pool in which the championships are to be swum.
- Entries must be submitted to the host club via Team Manager/Team Unify Meet Entries Zip File according to the Meet Notice

## ENTRY PROCEDURES

1. Teams must enter the meet electronically using Hytek Team manager. This file should be e-mailed. A paper or electronic copy of the entry report is also required (PDF preferred).
  - a. A Team Manager/Team Unify (TM or TU) *event file* is posted on the [Straehle website](#).  
**Please be sure to use the Straehle event file and not a dual meet event file.**
  - b. When importing into TM/TU, please double click the meet and set/select the following options:
    - i. Enforce Qualifying Times. Converted times (to SCM) are allowed.
    - ii. For those teams that use TM/TU for both USAS/Y and Summer League, you can easily comply with the requirement that qualifying/entry times are from the current dual meet season by using the following:
      - All your “qualifying” summer league meets should be set to a specific meet type (e.g. “SL” or “AAU”), including the Straehle meet
      - For the Straehle meet select “Restrict Entry Best Time to the Same Meet Type” (the meet type should already be set to specific meet type you chose above)
    - iii. Please include all relays swimmers and alternates on your entries. Please list the swimmers in order that they will swim.

Note: The TM/TU event file is setup to use times since 06/25/2022

2. Electronic entries should be submitted by e-mail and include:
  - a. The .sd3 format entry file (Hy-Tek or Team Unify)
  - b. Entry summary report (PDF preferred). Please check the proof of times option.
  - c. Meet entry fee summary.
- E-mail entries must be submitted to [straehle2022@gmail.com](mailto:straehle2022@gmail.com) and be received by **5:00 PM Sunday July 24<sup>th</sup>**. E-mail entries must contain the subject line “**STRAEHLE ENTRIES FROM XXXX**” where “XXXX” is replaced by the team acronym. Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail when the download and import is successful.
3. A team rep, coach or responsible entry person must be available Sunday afternoon/evening and Monday in case of questions. Please provide phone numbers with your entries.
4. All entry fees are due before your team is permitted to warm-up or participate in the Straehle meet competition. Please make **checks payable to “CMSL”**

## VERIFICATION OF ENTRIES

- The [Straehle website](#) will maintain an updated summary of entry status for all teams

- Each team will receive an e-mail of their team's meet entry summary once processed. Any corrections due to errors (i.e. no additional entries/swimmers) must be e-mailed back by **12:00pm Monday July 25<sup>th</sup>**.

#### **ENTRY TIMELINE**

- Through **5:00pm Sunday, July 24<sup>th</sup>**: Meet entries accepted.
  - *Entries received after 5:00pm until 11:00pm, if accepted, will be assessed a late fee. The fee is payable before the meet begins.*
- Through **12:00pm Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup>**: Entry corrections accepted. The Meet Manager must approve requests for any additional entries/swimmers.
  - *Entries received after 11:00pm Sunday until 12:00noon Monday, if accepted, will be assessed a higher late fee. The fee is payable before the meet begins.*
- The *Meet Psych Sheet* will be posted approximately **5:00pm Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup>**.
- After the *Psych Sheet* is posted any entry change requests received (for other than administrative errors) requires the approval of both the Meet Manager and the CMSL President (or their appointee).

Note: The *Entry Status* document will be periodically updated on the website to show the status of each team's entries.

#### **AWARDS**

- Individual event awards: medals will be awarded to individuals placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place.
- Relay Events: medals will be awarded to individuals placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place.

#### **WORKER ASSIGNMENTS**

- A warm-up schedule and worker assignment schedule will be posted on the Straehle website page by Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. Warm-up schedules will be set based on location relative to PADONIA and team worker assignments will be set based on year's entries. To alleviate the time-consuming switching of timers, we will have timers positioned at both ends of the pool. This will require more worker assignments per team, but the time savings recognized will be worth the extra effort. We appreciate the help and support of every team fulfilling their responsibilities. Teams that do not fulfill their meet obligations will be reported to the Rules, Grievances, and Ethics Committee for possible sanctions.

#### **POOL FACILITY**

- The meet will be held at PADONIA's 8 lane, 25-meter competition pool. Starting blocks will be used for all events. Electronic timing will be available for all events provide by the CMSL board. Specific system to be determined by CMSL board. PADONIA uses non-turbulent lane lines.

- The Olympia pool will be available during the meet for warm-up/warm-down. Lanes will be assigned based on age group and labeled at the pool. **NO DIVING IS ALLOWED IN THIS POOL.**
- Team tents/pop-ups will be allowed the spectator seating area.
- Swimmers and spectators are asked to stay in the upper field area when not using the Olympia Pool for warmup and warm down. All other pools and areas are only open to the club's members.
- The pool fence will be reserved for coaches. Bleachers will be available for spectators. A detailed map of the pool area will be shared closer to the meet date.
- The basketball court and volleyball court will be closed during the meet.
- Port a Potties will be available for spectators. Swimmers, coaches and officials will be allowed use the pool bathrooms.

### **STRAEHLE PROGRAM**

- PADONIA is offering local advertisers and family "Spirit" ads for sale to be printed in the heat sheet program. Information will be posted on the website that gives details on the advertising costs and submission.

### **DIRECTIONS**

- Our club is located at 12006 Jenifer Rd., Cockeysville, MD 21030
- PARKING WILL BE TIGHT – PLEASE ENCOURAGE CARPOOLING. We hope not to need overflow parking.
- Swimmers and families will have to walk from the parking area to the field. Please see the attached map. Additional maps and changes may be made.

### **T-SHIRTS**

- T-shirt pre-orders will open on July 9<sup>th</sup>.
- T-shirt orders should be submitted by the team rep for the whole team. Card and Venmo will be accepted.
- Orders are due July 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Limited quantities will be available the day of the meet.
