SITE	The Swasey Indoor Pool, University of New Hampshire, Durham, NH, is an 8-lane, 25-yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines, fully-automatic Colorado Electronic Timing System with touchpads at the finish end of the pool. The pool is equipped with a six-lane scoreboard and a diving well warm-up and warm-down area. There are no touchpads at the turn end of the pool. The start end is a minimum 5 ft. deep and the far end is a minimum 4.5 ft. deep. A large 610-seat balcony area is available for spectators. The pool deck capacity is 232 persons. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 11-14 prelim/final events will swim as 11-14 in the prelims with two heats of 11-12 and two heats of 13-14 advancing to finals. The 11-12 400 IM and 500 Free will be timed finals. • The 11-14 prelim final events on Friday will swim the Prelim on Friday and the finals on either Saturday or Sunday AM session. (See event list below) • 10 & U will swim as timed finals. • No events will swim with more than one swimmer per lane.
DISTANCE FORMAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 1000- and 1650-yard Freestyles will be competed mixed gender and mixed age fastest to slowest. • The 13-14 500-yard Freestyle will be competed mixed gender but separated out for finals. If the number of entries exceeds 5 heats, the fastest three heats will be competed slowest to fastest followed the remaining heats swimming fastest to slowest.
SCRATCHES	<p>All events except the 1000 and 1650 free are "scratch only."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The scratch deadline for Friday's events is 12:00 PM Friday except the 1650 free which will be positive check in by 30 minutes after the start of the session. • The scratch deadline for Saturday's events is 6:15 PM Friday. • The scratch deadline for Sunday's events is 6:15 PM Saturday except the 1000 free which will be positive check in by 11:00 AM on Sunday. <p>Scratches may be submitted via email to solomeetentries@gmail.com or made on deck with the Administrative Official at the meet.</p>

	<p>Coaches and swimmers are expected to understand the scratch, verification and relay rules before the meet begins.</p> <p>In all events where preliminary heats are necessary or in any timed final event for which the swimmer has been positively checked in, after the heats have been seeded, any swimmer who fails to compete in an individual event heat in which such swimmer entered and has not been scratched in will be barred from all further individual and relay events of that day. The application of this penalty shall pertain to the order in which the event/heats are swum, not the numerical order of the events. Additionally, that swimmer shall not be seeded in any individual events on succeeding days unless that swimmer declares an intent to swim prior to the close of the scratch box for that day's events.</p> <p>Failure to compete in the finals round of a prelim/finals event, without properly scratching, will result in the swimmer being barred from all further competition for the remainder of the meet, including relays and time trials. If the swimmer has no further competition from which to be penalized, a \$100 fine will apply. Scratches from finals will be conducted in accordance with articles 207.11.6D and 207.11.6E in the USA Swimming rules. Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies for Finals must notify the Admin Referee of his/her intention to withdraw from Finals within 30 minutes of announcing the results; email scratches from finals will not be accepted.</p> <p>A swimmer not originally announced or posted as qualifying for finals, who is seeded in a final due to the scratch of another swimmer, will not be penalized for failing to swim in that final; however, ALL swimmers are asked to scratch from finals if they do not intend to swim, so other swimmers are given the opportunity to be ready to swim in Finals should there be empty lane(s)</p>

ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All swimmers must be currently registered as New England athlete members of United States Swimming before 5:00 pm on the day before the first day of the meet and must have a proof of age on file by the above deadline in order to compete ● Achieved at least one of the Qualification Standards for their age group ● Age is determined by the age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet. ● Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. ● Coaches must be registered before the start of the meet. ● If a swimmer who is not properly registered with USA Swimming competes in a sanctioned competition, the host LSC will impose a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against the individual, member coach, or a member club submitting the entry. ● Deck registrations will NOT be accepted.
BONUS EVENTS	<p>Any swimmer who qualifies for B Championships in any event, may enter bonus events in any other event 200 or less in which their time is slower than the B Championship cut for their corresponding age group. Bonus event times must be verifiable in SWIMS except for 25s. DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. • The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
ENTRY POLICY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 & under are limited to 6 events per day including time trials. • 11 -14 are limited to 3 events per day and a total of 7 events for the meet. Final events that are carried over from prelim events on Friday do NOT count in the daily event total limit of the day that they are swimming finals, including time trials. Time trials are not included in the total events for the meet.
CUT PROTOCOL	<p>If a session is over-subscribed, the following changes will take place in the meet format (in no particular order):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Relays may be cut or limited to one or two entries per team. • Bonus Events may be limited. • Sessions may be split in concurrence of meet director and meet referee.
ENTRIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic entries should be emailed as an attachment to the entry chairperson. Please check that your team's name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. For email entries, payment and hardcopy of the entry (including signed entry cover page and waiver) must be received by: March 6, 2023. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. <p>Mail completed signed entry cover page and waiver, and payment to:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Seacoast Swimming Association PO Box 272 Dover, NH 03821</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any team that fails to send payment, cover page and waiver form, by the entry due date may be scratched from the meet and may be assessed a \$100 fine at the discretion of the Entry Chairperson. If no payment is received after 30 days, the fine is doubled. This fine is payable to the SOLO AQUATICS. TIMES VERIFICATION	Times from the USA Swimming Sanctioned, Approved, and Observed competitions will be in SWIMS, the national times database. Anyone entering a swimmer in events where their time is not in SWIMS will be fined \$100 per event. The swimmer will be scratched from the event and may jeopardize their team's participation in future New England Swimming Championship meets. All teams must provide a proof of time report by athlete when submitting entries.
RELAYS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dual Human Confirmation of relay take off violations will be required at all New England Swimming meets. • Relays will not be limited to relays per team per event. • All relay swimmers must be officially entered into the meet. • Unattached swimmers may not participate in any relays.

LEGAL SPLITS	<p>Individual Events: Preferably, legal splits should be requested before the event, by a coach, using a legal split form (available from the Control Table) and the requesting party should supply an additional timer(s) on the lane for the split, if necessary, to ensure an accurate time. (1 timer with touchpad timing, 3 timers without touchpad timing). Timers must be positioned over the lane at the end of the racing course. Optionally, a legal split may be requested after the event using a legal split form when using a fully automatic timing system. The Admin Official has discretion to either grant or deny the request after reviewing the available evidence. Backstroke legal splits must be requested in advance to ensure a legal finish.</p> <p>LEGAL SPLITS – Relays: All lead-off splits for relays are automatically loaded into SWIMS and do not require additional watches for validation unless there are no touchpads present, or the second swimmer starts in the water. If there are no touchpads, or the second swimmer starts in the water, a legal split form with three watches will be required for entry into SWIMS. Timers must be positioned over the lane at the end of the racing course. It is recommended that coaches report lead-off time discrepancies to the Administrative Referee or Administrative Official.</p>																										
SWIMWEAR	Per USA Swimming rules (102.8.1.F), 12 & Under swimmers may not wear a Technical Suit at any Sanctioned, Approved, or Observed meet. The age of the swimmer is determined on the first																										

	<p>day of the meet. Guidance on identifying compliant and non-compliant suits can be found on the USA Swimming website under Tech Suit Restriction for 12-and-Under Swimmers.</p>
RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet. ● Operation of a DRONE, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. ● Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. ● PHOTOGRAPHY: As per New England Swimming policy, professional photographers contracted by the SOLO Aquatics, or press photographers who have been approved in advance by the Meet Director, are allowed on deck. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including in any spectator area behind the starting blocks, nor in any other marked NO CAMERA ZONE, including on deck. All NO CAMERA ZONES will be clearly designated. Email the Meet Director with questions and requests. ● VIDEO STREAMING: All video streaming must be approved in advance by the Meet Director. Any such video stream must conform to all current Safe Sport policies defined by USA Swimming, New England Swimming, and the Meet Host. No video stream may originate from behind the starting blocks or from any other area marked as a NO CAMERA ZONE. ● Deck Changing is PROHIBITED. ● An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. ● According to New England Swimming Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool. ● In accordance with New England Swimming Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
SAFETY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No shaving is permitted at the competition site. ● No glass containers are permitted within the facility. ● Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups. ● Medical Assistance will be provided at the facility. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard, or a member of the meet staff. <p>WARM UP SAFETY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time ● For all sessions with 12 & Under events, swimmers must utilize a “sit and slide”/“three-point” entry to enter the pool for warm-ups, by first sitting on the deck, and then sliding, feet-first, into the pool. If the session includes both 12 & Under events and 13 & Over/Senior events, two warm-up sessions must be utilized, or the “sit and slide”/“three-point” entry will be required for all swimmers.” ● If a warm-up area for use during competition is provided at the facility: During competition, when entering the warm-up/warm-down area, a “sit and slide”/“three-point” entry is required at all times
SAFE SPORT	<p>The conduct of all participants and spectators at a meet is governed by USA Swimming Rules 304/305. All infractions must be reported to the Meet Referee or Meet Director.</p>

	<p>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP 2.0"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP 2.0 policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</p> <p>USA Swimming and NE Swimming encourage all to report any witnessed or suspected forms of abuse/safe sport violations to the NE Swimming Safe Sport Chair, Susan Pascale-Frechette: safesportne@gmail.com (401-965-0183), or through the USA-S online reportable form.</p>
FACILITY RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No helium balloons in the building. • No glass on deck. • Shoes must be worn beyond the aquatic center locker room and gallery. • No food or coolers on deck. Drinks in plastic containers only. • Athletes, Coaches, and Spectators are restricted to the aquatic center and main lobby. • Please bring bags on deck and do not leave belonging in locker room. • Clean up team area after each session. • Deck changing is not allowed at any time! • Use of audio or visual recording devices include cell phones are not permitted on deck except during final award ceremony. Only professional media representatives who have been credentialed through the meet director and UNH will be allowed equipment on deck.
CHANGES TO MEET	<p>Once a meet is sanctioned, changes can be made to the meet invitation before the meet, only with the approval of the Technical Chair, Patrick Johnstone. Any change to the meet format after the meet begins will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee and will be presented to the coaches at a coaches meeting.</p>
MEET JURY	<p>The Meet Jury will be made up of one official, one coach, and one athlete to be selected by the Meet Referee who will present issues and moderate the Meet Jury but not vote. When possible, the three members shall be from separate teams. The Meet Jury will decide all issues of eligibility, and anything not addressed in the Meet Announcement. The Meet Referee shall have authority as described in the current USA Swimming Rulebook.</p>
WEATHER PROTOCOL	<p>If weather or facility conditions make it impossible to follow the original timeline of events, the Meet Director and Meet Referee have a right to make changes to the meet sessions. The Meet Director will notify the teams of the changes with as much notice as possible. Cancellation of the meet, or a session, is the decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee. If weather requires the cancellation of any finals session, the results of the preliminary session will be the final order.</p>
DECK ACCESS	<p>Only current USA Swimming registered athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff are permitted on the pool deck. All non-athletes on the pool deck must produce proof of their valid USA Swimming registration when asked. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of membership. Individuals without proof of a valid membership in USA Swimming will be removed from the pool deck and will be fined by New England Swimming of \$100 to the coach, and \$200 to the coach's club.</p>
OFFICIALS	<p>Officials that know they will be attending the meet are highly encouraged to email the Meet Referee and let her know your level of certification, team, and sessions you will be available. Walk-on officials may not be accepted to limit the number of people on the deck. Officials meetings will be at least 30 minutes prior to the start of a session and may be conducted virtually in the days before the meet.</p>
GENERAL	<p>Concession stand will be operated by UNH near the basketball courts.</p>
TIMERS AND OTHER WORKERS	<p>According to New England Swimming policy, the host team will make timing assignments for this meet based on the size of a team's entry. Please be cooperative and punctual. We need the full cooperation of all teams, large and small, to adequately run this meet. All teams will be given timing/work assignments based on the number of entries. Teams treating this meet as a team travel meet need to assure that they have enough parental workers at the meet to fulfill their team obligation. The timing assignments will be posted on the web page with ample time for teams to provide workers. All swimmers in the 1000, and 1650 Freestyle must provide their own Lane Timers and Lane Counters (if applicable).</p>

“NO-SHOW” WORKERS	If a team does not provide the timers it has been assigned at a championship meet, the team will be fined \$100 per incident and will not be allowed to enter swimmers in another New England meet until the fine(s) is paid. This can be appealed to the Board of New England Swimming and is enforced only if the meet management has properly assigned timers based on the number of swimmers a team has entered in the meet.
