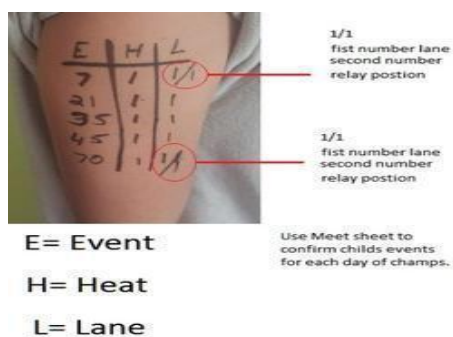
What to Bring-

Swimmers need to have their OWN equipment/swim bags with them, with the following items:

- Team swimsuit, cap, goggles (an extra pair of goggles is a good idea!), team t-shirt, towel, and sunscreen. Make sure all items are well labeled with your child's name.
- Plenty of snacks and drinks to keep your swimmer hydrated and energized.
- Cash for concessions.

Marking Your Swimmer Before Drop Off

- Please mark your swimmer to reflect which event, heat, and lane they are racing. This is used to help remind the swimmers of their events and for Ready Bench volunteers. Please write your swimmer's name on their back to assist at the start.



Swimmer Drop-Off, Zoos, and Parking: South West Side of RRISD pool. Enter off Gattis School Road.

Swimmer Drive-Through Drop-Off—Parents are allowed to drive through and drop off swimmers at the southwest end of the RRISD pool (see [RRISD Pool Map](#)). Swimmers will then enter the check-in area and reach their zoo area. Parents are encouraged to use the drive-thru drop-off system for all ages. If you are more comfortable escorting your swimmer to their team zoo, you may do so between 6:30 & 6:45. An announcement will be made at 6:50 for all parents to immediately vacate

the zoos. After 6:50 you may only enter the zoo if you are a registered volunteer for that area or are checking your swimmer out for the day. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Younger swimmers may be escorted to the bathroom hallway or doors by a zoo volunteer from their team with the same gender. If your child needs assistance in a stall we will notify the parents to come and help.

If you need to reach your child for dropping food truck orders or just a general check-in, you may ask one of the Marshals posted at the zoo gates for your team's Zoo Runner contact info. You can text them and they can meet you at the gate for pick up or respond to any questions. Please keep your requests at a minimum as they are part of the overall zoo team and will be assisting the swimmers all shift.

Zoos: Zookeepers will ensure swimmers get to the ready bench for their event. If you decide to take your swimmer before the session ends, you will need to sign them out at the zoo. If you are volunteering, please stay through your entire shift! :) Please note that you will not be able to walk through the pool to get your child from the zoo.

The following items are not allowed in the zoos this year:

- **Tech Items** – We are requesting all swimmers leave their screens at home. They will have plenty of friends in the zoos and will be well cared for. Tech can get damaged and lost, but the biggest issue is potential inappropriate content. Every family has their own rules on what is acceptable for their child to access. Our zoo keepers are there to maintain safety and flow for the meet. They cannot monitor what any child sees on another child's screen.
- **Canned sugar drinks.** They spill everywhere on the tarps. Please only send drinks with screw caps that can be closed.

Parking: (see map below) Parking is on the **east** side of the RRISD pool. Please do not move cones. Cones are used for lifeguards and to transport food and equipment. **We will also reserve additional spaces for handicapped parking needs.**

Spectators: Please see the RRISD Pool Map below for the spectator section. You may set up a tent anywhere on the grass behind the gate outside of the pool. No chairs on the deck. It is to stand and watch only. There will be a spectator bench for those needing mobility accommodations.

Swimmer Photos: Several teams will have professional photographers there capturing the entire meet. Your team leads will have access to photo links in the weeks following the event and will share when ready for download.

Concessions: A variety of food trucks will be available throughout the day. Look at our [Champs page](#) to see the options. Due to the nature of food truck vendors we suggest bringing your own snacks in case they have an unforeseen circumstance that prevents them from serving.

Merchandise: There will be a shirt vendor on site selling regular and custom Champs merch. Order early to ensure it's ready before you leave your session.

Swim Suits: "Tech" swimsuits are not allowed at Champs. Please double-secure tie-back suits.

Flyover Starts: CCSL Champs will run flyover starts (flyovers), meaning swimmers remain in the water immediately following their swim until the next heat of swimmers enters the water.

Rain/Inclement Weather Plans: In the case of thunder/lightning, the meet will be paused so that all swimmers and event volunteers can relocate indoors. The meet can resume once everyone is inside and the doors are all closed. With having all swimmers inside the pool area, this will severely limit the amount of space for spectators. We just want everyone to be aware that this could happen. Keeping the swimmers indoors and safe is the #1 priority.

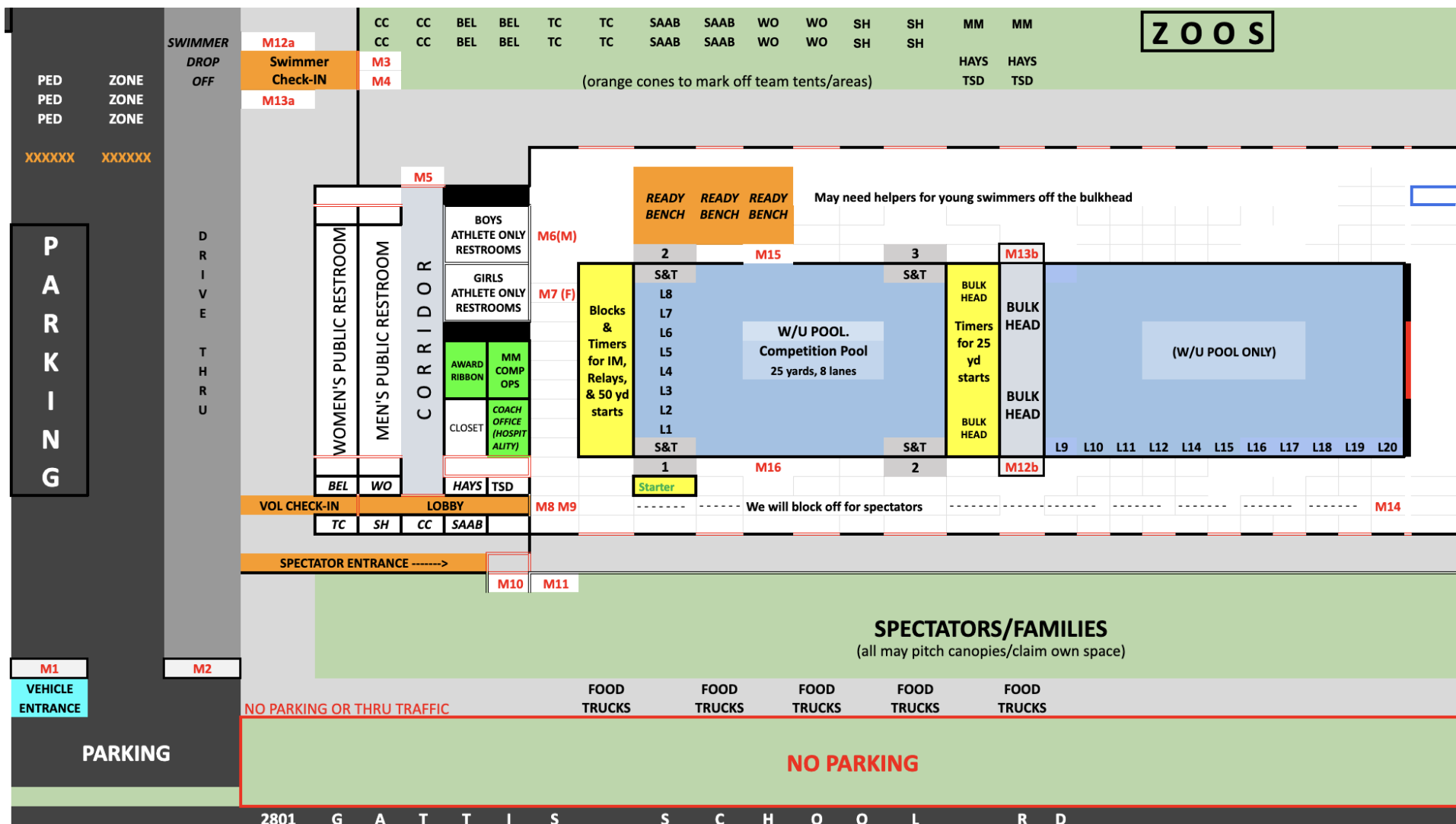

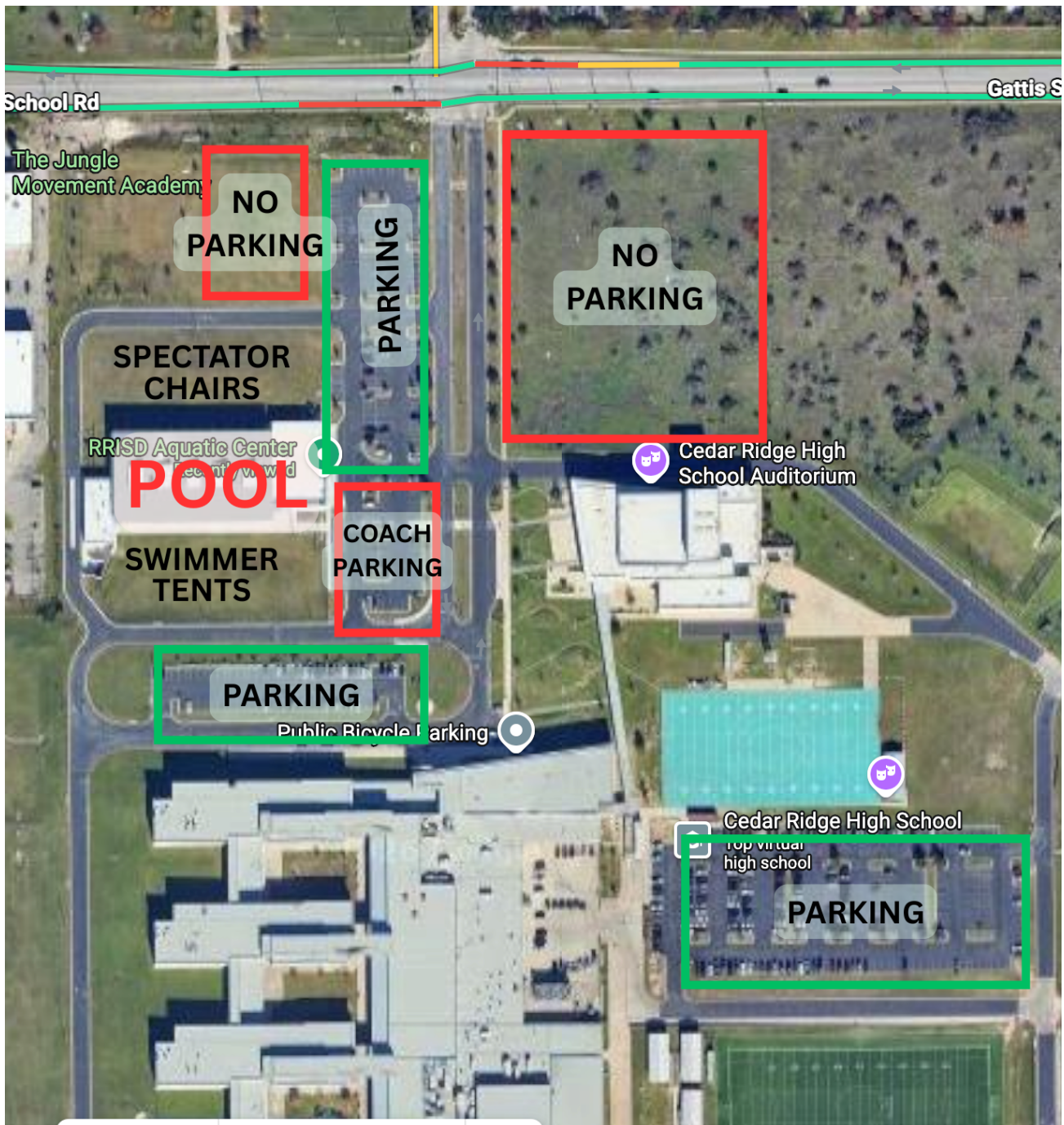


**ENTRANCE FROM
