Welcome 2021 NWAL Teams!

Premier Aquatics is proud to present our **16th ANNUAL SUMMER THUNDER MEET**, sanctioned by NWAL. Once again, we will be offering a pre-seeded timed final meet with electronic timing to provide swimmers with an additional opportunity to qualify for the post season championship meets.

Due to current Klein ISD capacity restrictions, we plan to divide up sessions by age groups, and will allow approximately 200 swimmers plus 1 spectator per swimmer each session. All swimmers in session plus 1 spectator per swimmer will sit in stands in pool area during their session, then exit once session is over to allow next session to enter.

Due to smaller than usual sessions, we estimate that each session will only last approximately 2 – 2 1/2 hours.

Sunday, June 6th: 2 sessions - 9-10 Session and 8 & Under Session.

Sunday, June 13th: 3 Sessions – 11-12 Session, 13-14 Session and 15-19 Session.

Maximum Number of Entries Per Swimmer: 4 individual events per swimmer plus 1 relay event.

12 & Under events have qualifying times. There are no qualifying times for 13 & Over Events.

BONUS EVENTS - Swimmers that have a qualifying time for at least 1 individual event will be allowed to swim additional events, for a maximum of 4 individual events, provided they have a legal time swum at a time trial or a sanctioned NWAL meet, with exception of 11 - 12 100 Free; 10 & under 50 Free and 100 IM for 12 & Under.

At the end of each session, we will offer a Mixed 100 Free Relay for that age group (with 2 girls and 2 boys). We are offering these relays as a bonus to teams entering the meet, and there are no entry fees for the relays. Teams may enter up to 2 relay teams for each event (A & B relay).

Swimmers in relays must be entered in meet in at least 1 individual event (No Relay Only Swimmers).

NOTE: Per NWAL rules, all meet entries must be submitted with entry file from Swimtopia.

We will accept meet entries from teams in the order they are received, and if we reach the maximum number in any sessions, we will not be able to accept any additional teams. Meet entries will **ONLY** be accepted **VIA EMAIL** (See page 5 & 6 for entry details). Based on number of swimmers entered in each age group, we may combine or further divide sessions as needed, to maximize total number of swimmers in the meet

Awards: Custom Medals will be awarded to top 8 for each individual event by single age group as described below. Special awards will be given to relays 1st – 3rd. Team trophies to top 3 teams in each of 2 divisions.

Each Individual Event will award at most 2 groups of swimmers. See the following examples:

6 & Under events – awards for 6 & unders only;

7-8 yr old events – awards for 7yr olds and 8yr olds;

9-10 yr old events – awards for 9yr olds and 10yr olds;

13-14 yr events – awards for 13 yr old and 14 yr olds

8 & under events – awards for 8 yr olds and 7&unders;

10 & under events – awards for 10 yr olds and 9&unders;

11-12 yr old events – awards for 11yr olds and 12 yr olds;

15-19 yr old events – awards for 15yr & over only.

Attached you will find full meet invitation, team entry form, meet events, and qualifying standards.

We look forward to your team attending the meet this year!

Directions: From I-45 exit Louetta. Drive west on Louetta. After passing Stuebner Airline, turn left at light at Lyons School Road. Park in large student parking lot on your right. Walk across crosswalk on Lyons School Road from parking lot to the pool. **See attached map of campus on page 14.**

POOL: Eight lane, 25-yard indoor pool with non-turbulent lane lines, with 3 additional warmup lanes.

Due to current Klein ISD Capacity restrictions, **we will allow for approximately 200 swimmers plus 1 spectator per swimmer per session.** If Klein ISD capacity changes prior to accepting entries, we will add capacity. All swimmers in each session and their 1 spectator will sit in stands in pool area during their session and then exit once their session is complete, to allow for next session to enter. No additional seating within the school building will be available. Please only bring 1 spectator per swimmer to the meet. No additional spectators will be able to enter.

With the small size of the sessions, there will be plenty of seating in pool area for all swimmers each session plus 1 spectator per swimmer. Do not bring additional items, such as chairs, coolers, blankets, pillows, etc.

Due to smaller session sizes, we estimate each meet session will only last approximately 2 – 2 ½ hours.

We will use a linear ready area for swimmers within the pool area for the meet to line up for their heat.

There is no flash photography at the start of a race.

TIME AND DATE:

Sunday, June 6th: 2 sessions - 9-10 Session and 8 & Under session.

1st Session warm-ups start at 9:30 a.m. and the meet will start at 10:45 a.m

2nd Session warmups will start immediately after 1st session. Times posted week of meet.

Sunday, June 13th: 3 Sessions – 11-12 Session, 13-14 Session and 15-19 Session.

1st Session warmups start at 7:30 am and the meet will start at 8:45 am.

2nd and 3rd Session times will start immediately after prior session and be posted week of meet once estimated timeline is run.

Split warm-ups will be in effect, with team and lane assignments posted on Premier Aquatics' website, www.packswimming.com, at least 3 days prior to the start of the meet.

NOTE: Sessions may be combined or further divided, based on total of swimmers entered in each age group.

OFFICIALS: 2021 NWAL certified officials will officiate. Teams are requested to supply officials.

ENTRIES: Entries must be submitted in yard times. **Due to the yard setup of this event, Swimtopia Events File will convert to yards.** Entry times will be converted to the proper course by the Swimtopia software using the default conversions and meet Templates.

QUALIFYING TIMES: This Invitational Meet is designed to encourage and foster competitive Summer League Swimming. All swimmers 13 years and older are invited to attend regardless of seed times. Swimmers 12 years and younger must have achieved minimum qualifying times in the attached order of events. **Time Trial times WILL be allowed as long as the swimmer has not achieved an official time. Once an official time is achieved, the Time Trial Time is no longer available to use. NT or No Time will not be allowed.**

BONUS Events – Swimmers that have a qualifying time for at least 1 individual event will be allowed to swim additional events, for a maximum of 4 individual events, provided they have a legal time swum at a time trial or a sanctioned NWAL meet, with exception of 11 - 12 100 Free; 10 & under 50 Free and 100 IM for 12 & Under. NTs will not be excepted.

****EXCEPTION – 11 - 12 100 Free, 10 & under 50 Free and 100 IM for all ages:** The 11-12 100 Free and the 50 free for swimmers 10 & Under and 100 IM for swimmers 12 & Under **cannot** be added as a bonus. Swimmers **MUST** achieve the time standard in that event in order to enter.

NUMBER OF EVENTS: Maximum of 4 individual events per swimmer.
Teams may enter up to two relay teams in each relay event (A&B). Any relay team is eligible to score points for the team score.

ENTRIES DEADLINE: **Entries will be accepted through Tuesday, June 1st until 3:00 pm ONLY VIA EMAIL to entries@packswimming.com on first-come first-serve basis, and will be accepted in the order they are received. Any entries received prior to 1:00 pm will be returned and not accepted.**

ENTRIES: All teams MUST submit their entries by email to entries@packswimming.com, using Swimtopia software and email the following: HY3 entry file from Swimtopia, .PDF of entry report and attached team entry form (see page 10). **PER NWAL RULES, ONLY SWIMTOPIA ENTRY FILES MAY BE SUBMITTED.**
Meet entries will be limited to 135 swimmers for each meet session on a first come first serve basis in the order they are received. The team that fills the meet up will be allowed to fully enter the meet, after which no additional teams shall be permitted to enter.
NOTE: Based on how many swimmers enter meet, may combine or further divide sessions as necessary to stay within Klein ISD capacity limitations.

ELIGIBLE TEAMS: All NWAL teams.

FEES: \$11.00 per Individual Event. No charge for Relay Events.
Make checks payable to **Premier Aquatics**. Entry fees must be postmarked no later than Tuesday, June 1st.

AWARDS: **Individual events:** Summer Thunder Custom Medals for individual 1st – 8th place. (Awards to 6&U, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11,12,13,14, and 15-19). **Note: 2 sets of awards at most will be awarded for individual events that span ages. For example, 8&under events will award for 8 yr olds and 7&unders)**

Relay events: Special Awards for 1st – 3rd place.

Team Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams in two divisions. Divisions will be based on number of swimmers/entries and will be determined after entries are received.

SCORING: Individual Events: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay Events: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

SEEDING: The meet will be a pre-seeded meet. There will be no “on-deck” entries per NWAL rules. All heat and lane assignments will be made prior to the meet. There will be no reseeding at the ready bench. The heat and lane assignments will be shown in the Meet Program. **The coaches must turn in relay cards with either no changes or with swimmer name changes by start time of each session.**

All swimmers must be shown in the order in which they will swim on the relay. Relay swimmers MUST be entered in the meet in at least 1 individual event to be eligible for a relay.

RULES AND SANCTIONS: The 2021 NWAL rules will apply. The meet will be held under the sanction of the NWAL League Officers and Board of Directors. No entries can be accepted unless the entrant is a member of a registered NWAL team. Please see Qualifying Times section for information on **BONUS Events**. Teams may enter as many as 2 relays per event and all relays are eligible to score points.

All participants must be registered 2021 NWAL swimmers. All participants must have competed in at least one NWAL meet during the 2021 NWAL season. Eligibility for an age group is determined by the individual’s age as of the end of May 31, 2021 per NWAL rules.

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

See attached Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures.

TIMING SYSTEM: A Daktronics electronic timing system with electronic scoreboard will be used. Two electronic buttons and two watches per lane will be used as a back-up. Teams will be requested to furnish timers based on their percentage of swimmers at the meet. Timing assignments will be published in the Heat Sheet and on the Premier Aquatics website (www.packswimming.com) prior to the meet.

POOL DECK RESTRICTION: Because of Insurance Safety Regulations, the swimming pool deck, during the operation of the Summer Thunder swim meet, is closed to all persons except swimmers, coaches, safety marshals, officials, meet personnel, and timers. If you are asked to leave the deck by any meet personnel, please do so. It is for your safety.

All coaches must display NWAL issued coach badge to be allowed on deck. Under current Klein ISD capacity restrictions, we will be limiting number of coaches on deck to 1 or 2 coaches per team, based on size of team. Once entries are turned in, we will publish week of meet, coach capacity based on number of teams entered and team size. **Coach setup on deck will only be allowed on the day of the meet.**

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES: Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition and for providing their own assistant or equipment. However, Coaches/Swimmers may contact the Meet Director at least two weeks in advance of the meet to help arrange any additional equipment.

CONCESSIONS: No concessions expected to be sold at meet, based on current Klein ISD guidelines.

HOSPITALITY: Lunch, Snacks and bottled water will be available for coaches and officials.

MERCHANDISE: D&J Sports will be selling apparel and swim gear at the meet. A custom Summer Thunder Meet shirt will be on sale as well.

MEET RESULTS: Meet results will be posted on the NWAL Web Page (<http://www.nwal.org/>) within two days after the conclusion of the meet.

Thank you for taking the time to become familiar with these procedures prior to the meet to help insure everything goes smoothly!

- Swimmers, volunteers, spectators, officials and coaches in the meet agree to abide by PACK's COVID-19 Safety Procedures and Protocols.
- This meet will be conducted in compliance with local, state, and USA Swimming COVID-19 restrictions.
- The Meet Referee has final authority over conduct of this event and will be working with the Meet Director, Facility Management, and PACK Covid-19 Task Force to enforce Covid-19 safety guidelines and resolve any issues.

- Prior to coming to the pool, everyone should self-screen by answering the following questions. If you answer yes to ANY question below, you should not come to the pool.
 - *Do I feel sick in any way, dizzy, have a cough, have shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?*
 - *Do I have a fever, sore throat, chills, headache, loss of taste or smell or diarrhea?*
 - *Have I been in contact with anyone known to have tested positive for COVID-19?*
- There will be plenty of bleachers in the pool area for swimmers and spectators to sit.
- Only coaches, officials, swimmers, lane timers and volunteers required to be on-deck are allowed on the pool deck, and will maintain current social distancing guidelines throughout the meet.
- Everyone will exit the building through the exit doors past the restrooms. This is a separate set of doors than the entrance doors.
- Previous session will be required to completely exit the building before next session will be allowed to enter.
- We will only have 1 or 2 timers per lane at the meet to maintain social distancing from others. They will move forward only to obtain the ending time of the swimmer in their lane and will immediately move back prior to swimmer exiting the water.
- We will allow adequate time between each event to provide rest for the swimmers by inserting short breaks in the timeline in between events as needed. An estimated timeline will be published for each session and will be posted on the PACK website.
- When a swimmer's heat is 3 heats after the heat in the water, the swimmer will move to a Ready Area on the side of the pool on the spectator side. There will be dots on ground, numbered 1-8 and they will stand on their dot that matches their lane #. Please do not gather in that area early, as we do have plenty of time in between heats, so nobody has to rush. The volunteer at that ready station will let them know when it is time to go to next ready area. Then, once the starting block area is clear for their heat, the volunteer in that area will direct the swimmers to approach the block area. Once a heat exits water, they will then be directed to exit the block area towards the side where coaches are (opposite spectator stands), and then walk around pool to return to their seat.
- Swimmers must enter and leave the facility in their swimsuits. **Locker rooms and restrooms will be for restroom use only, no changing allowed.**
- **Masks are strongly encouraged inside Klein ISD buildings, but no longer required.**

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES

WARM-UP PROCEDURES

- A. General warm-up (Initial portion [1/2] of the warm-up session or with the agreement of all of the coaches in a particular lane.)
 - 1 **NO DIVING OR RACING STARTS** allowed from the blocks edge of the pool. Swimmers must enter the pool feet first cautiously.
 - 2 **NO SPRINTING OR PACE WORK** allowed during this general warm-up session.
- B. Specific warm-up (Last portion [1/2] of the warm-up session or with the agreement of all of the coaches in a particular lane.)
 - 1 **RACING STARTS ONLY**, either from blocks or from backstroke starts.
 - 2 Lanes are **ONE WAY ONLY**.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- A. Swimmers Responsibilities
 - 1. All unattended swimmers, and/or their coaches, should arrange, prior to their arrival at the meet, for a certified coach to observe them during the warm-up, competition and warm-down. Any unattended swimmers who have not made previous arrangements with a coach to observe them at the meet should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee for assistance in making such arrangements prior to their participating in the warm-up.
- B. Coaches Responsibilities
 - 1 Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practice.
 - 2 Coaches shall stand near the starting end of the pool when starting swimmers on sprint and pace work.
 - 3 Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session.
 - 4 Coaches shall maintain as much contact with their swimmers as possible, both verbal and visual, throughout the warm-up period.
- C. Safety Marshals
 - 1. Appointed Safety Marshals have the authority to remove from the deck for the remainder of the warm-up session, any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety guidelines or warm-up procedures. **THE MEET REFEREE MAY EXERCISE ADDITIONAL ADJUDICATION AUTHORITY AS NECESSARY.**
- D. Miscellaneous
 - 1 Swimmers should be reminded by coaches that breaststrokers need more lead time than freestyle or butterfly swimmers.
 - 2 Backstrokers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks. Swimmers shall not step up on the starting blocks, when a backstroker is waiting to start.
 - 3 Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
 - 4 Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during warm-up periods.
 - 5 Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks, scheduled or otherwise, during the competition.
 - 6 All diving boards and equipment are **OFF LIMITS**.
- E. Pool Rules
 - 1 Smoking or use of other tobacco products is not allowed on the grounds of Klein ISD
 - 2 Glass containers are prohibited.
 - 3 Swimmers, coaches, and spectators are expected to observe all rules and regulations included in the invitation.
