Entries and Fees: Entries must be received **NO LATER** than 10PM on Saturday, July 6.

DO NOT build your own meet using the regular PPSL dual meet template in SwimTopia.

Create the meet in SwimTopia using the document sent. It has the divisions for 6 & Under swimmers already created.

- **Fee** of \$2.00 per individual entry and \$8.00 per relay will be charged. Please make checks out to Madeira Swim & Tennis Club.

- **Deck entries** permitted, if availability in heat. Fee is \$2.50 per individual and \$10.00 per relay. Cash or checks will be accepted.

Heat Sheets: Heat Sheets will not be sold or distributed to parents. Heat sheets will be available for coaches and volunteers at the front shelter.

Awards: Individual ribbons – 1st to 16th; Relays 1st to 8th

All 8 & Under swimmers will compete together. However, 6 & Unders will be awarded separately in 25m freestyle and 25m backstroke. We will also run one additional event, the 6 & Under free relay. Relays with any 7- and 8-year-olds must compete in the 8 & Under event.

All 8 & Unders who do not place will be awarded Best Effort ribbons, provided by Madeira.

Events:

- **New event this year** - Coaches Relay! Before the start of the first event, we invite our summer league coaches to compete in a 200 Freestyle Relay. This event is for fun and will not be awarded points or ribbons but we do hope your coaches rise to the challenge as Madeira hopes to earn bragging rights as victors in the first annual Eastside Champs Coaches Relay. You may swim coaches, alumni, or parents to fill out your relay. No need to enter anything on swimtopia, just have your swimmers at their assigned lane at the start of the meet.

- All 8 & under and 9-10 must report to their team's clerk of course.

Team Volunteer Responsibilities:

Each team is required to provide the following workers. Additional volunteers may be required.

Each team is responsible to get their swimmers to the blocks or to the Clerk of Course.

- 1 Official – for entire meet
- 1 Ribbon Volunteer – for entire meet or 2 if each half
- Clerk of Course – assigned as needed within your team
- Timers, which will include back up timers, will be assigned to each club by lane:
 1. Anderson Hills
 2. Harper's Point
 3. Kenwood
 4. Madeira
 5. Mt. Lookout
 6. Wyoming

Madeira will also provide 1 backup timer.

Volunteers from all teams should check in by 5:00PM at the Volunteers Table under the main shelter. The timers meeting at 5:00 is mandatory as we are running a new timing system this year and need to give specific instructions. You do not need to bring stopwatches to this meet.

Parking: Limited parking is available at the swim club. There is also parking available next door at Madeira Middle School, behind the middle school at Sellman Park, or across the street at St. Gertrude.

Food: Grill food, snacks, candy, beverages, and bake sale items available during the warmups and meet. Cash or credit card can be used at the snack shack or at the grill, but do bring cash for the bake sale and split the pot.

Seating: We have limited seating. Please plan on bringing your own folding chair if you require a seat.

Inclement Weather: In the event of Thunder/Lightning Delay—We will leave the pool deck and seek shelter for the required 30-minute delay. If the delay causes the start time to extend past 9:30PM, all remaining events will be canceled.
