**A FEW FACTS TO HELP PLAN A GREAT ALL STAR MEET**

- This meet will be very fun and fast, with our awesome all stars. It will be hot, so please bring shade structures and LOTS of water and sports drinks.
- We will have the teams distributed around the grounds. Please look for your team's sign and set up in the designated area.
- Food and drinks will be available in the pool-side Lakeview Café. The café accepts **credit card and is able to offer reciprocal charging privileges to the other country clubs**. Please note that the **café is NOT ABLE to take cash at this time**. Thank you!!
- Parking – Parking will be along 35<sup>th</sup> Street. Because this is a large meet, you should leave an extra couple of minutes to park and get to the pool. We will also send a golf cart out to help move people back and forth. PLEASE ONLY PARK LEGALLY (e.g., not in fire lanes, too close to stop signs, ETC). ALSO, PLEASE CONSIDER CARPOOLING! No parking on Mt. Bonnell Dr. **Please plan extra time for arrival.**
- We like to keep extra parents and swimmers out of the ready bench area. Please cheer for your swimmers from elsewhere on the deck! In addition, no parents allowed by the computer table.
- Volunteer assignments - we have informed every team representative of their volunteer assignments, and we need everyone to help out. Please come prepared to work! Even if you are not assigned a job by your team, every parent should be prepared to help when asked.
- Please remember that this is a FUN event to conclude a great summer swim season! Let's all work together to keep the mood FUN and light---hearted. If you have any concerns about the meet, please take them to your parent representative or coach, and they will work with the Meet Director to solve the problem. Please DO NOT attempt to address problems directly with other parents or volunteers.
- Inclement weather: We will use our Thor Guard lightning system and have a designated "Weather Watcher" that will be responsible for calling the meet if lightning appears within 10 miles on the Weather Bug App. If this occurs we will have spaces to house swimmers & families

during bad weather. If bad weather continues and the meet is called, the makeup date is Tuesday, June 21st.
