# APPENDIX

## GKAISA General Rules

### 9. GENERAL CONDUCT

9.1. All **tobacco products, vaping, e-cigs smoking** and alcoholic beverages are absolutely prohibited **in** at the pool area **at** in all GKAISA meets

### 11. GENERAL MEET RULES and PROCEDURES

#### 11.11. Pool Depth Requirement

11.11.3 Depth measurement should be made and agreed upon by coaches from each team prior to any swimmer entering the water (includes warm up). Once the meet begins, only the referee can request the depth be re-measured if safety is a concern.

#### 11.13 Meet Safety

11.13.1 The meet referee has the responsibility and authority to see that the meet is conducted in a safe manner and may halt the meet at any time due to hazardous conditions.

## GKAISA Championship Meet Rules

### 2. Entry Requirements

2.1.3. Entry Limits - A swimmer may only be entered in **and swim** 4 events with a maximum of 2 relays or a maximum of 3 individual events. **There will be no exhibition swims allowed.**

### 3. Meet Protocols

3.1. Preliminaries for ~~the~~ **swimmers ages** 11 and ups will be held on Friday; **swimmers ages** 10 and unders will swim their preliminaries on Saturday; and all Finals will be on Sunday; **unless otherwise specified in the meet invitation.**

3.8. After the Preliminary session, a team coach may add one alternate swimmer's name to the four swimmers that participated in the preliminary session **relay** and this alternate may replace any one of the four preliminary **relay** team swimmers. The team coach must make any changes in Relay Team members known to the Meet Referee prior to the stated time to turn in Relay Cards for that particular event. The alternate must be eligible (not swimming in more than three preliminary events but must have swum in at least one preliminary event) and be present at the meet. The coach will sign the Relay Card indicating any change in membership ~~or order of swimmers on the back of the relay card.~~ The swimmer being substituted for in a relay shall not be allowed to compete in subsequent events at the meet. **Once a relay team is seated on deck, the coach may change the order of swimmers and must submit those changes to scoring at the conclusion of the race.**

3.11. Photography and/or videography is prohibited from behind the starting blocks. Any person in violation of this rule may be removed from the pool deck.

### 7. Scratches and No-Shows

7.2. There ~~will~~ **may** be a ~~\$1.00~~ scratch or 'No Show' fee assessed to each club for each entry scratched or if a swimmer does not swim in an entered event. **Amount of fee will be specified in the meet invitation.**
