Location	Upper Lake, Upper Lakeview Avenue and Pequot Road, Ringwood, NJ ELAC has eight, 50-meter swim lanes using a two button semi-automatic Colorado timing system. A minimum of two backup watches will be used on each lane.

Entry Deadline	Entries must be received no later than Thursday, August 3, 2023 at 10 PM will be included in the meet program. Any other entries must be given at the Scratch Meeting.
Officials	All teams submitting entries must provide timers and officials. All coaches and officials will be provided with a food ticket. Timers will be provided with beverages.
Swimmer Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● This event is a closed invitational swim meet and is open only to Lakeland Swim Conference Teams ● Swimmers may swim in as many individual or relay events for which they are qualified using an age as of June 1, 2023. ● Swimmers must meet all rules for eligibility and be listed on current LSC rosters. ● Swimmers must have a 'C' time on record with LSC as of the Highland Lakes "B" invitational swim meet or have no time on record for the event. Any LSC entrants who have no time on record for a given event will be entered in a scored event for that event. Swimmers with a time faster than published A standard will be entered in the age group open event for that stroke. ● The dual meet that occurs in the week between the Highland Lakes "B" and Erskine Lakes invitational swim meets will not affect swimmer eligibility in the Erskine Lakes invitational swim meet. Entries will be accepted based on times on record with LSC following the Highland Lakes "B" invitational swim meet.

Meet Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The Erskine Lakes invitational swim meet will use the “C” time standard, published by Erskine Lakes on the Sunday following the Highland Lakes “B” invitational swim meet. ● Erskine Lakes will follow the “C” Meet invitational swim meet tradition by adding .01 seconds to the 8th place or nearest finish time for each relevant event of the Highland Lakes “B” invitational swim meet. ● If a Highland Lakes “B” invitational swim meet event does not have 8 places, the cut off time will be determined by adding .01 seconds to the last place finisher in that event. ● The Meet Director may opt to set a time based for a given event based on his or her discretion to ensure a fair and competitive meet. ● All swimmers with a “C” time following the Highland Lakes “B” invitational swim meet are eligible to swim for points and awards. ● Swimmers with “A” times in given strokes are eligible to swim but will be entered in the age group open events for the strokes in which they have “A” times. ● The open events are not scored, and the swimmers will not be eligible to score points or win awards. ● There is no limit to the number of events in which swimmers may participate. Each swimmer may swim in as many individual events for which he or she qualifies. 								
Relays	We just have one Mixed Open “Family” Fun Free Relay that is open to all ages including parents, siblings, aunts, uncles and cousins! It will not be scored								
Meet Format	Lakeland Swim Conference Constitution and by-laws will apply. USS-LS Conference Rules will govern the conduct of the meet. It is a deck-seeded timed finals invitational swim meet. Deck entries will be permitted until 8:00 AM on the day of the invitational swim meet.								
Meet Format Waiver	ELAC reserves the right to adjust warm-up times, sessions and start times after all entries are received and session time estimates are computed by Meet Manager to best manage the meet timeline. Any changes to the meet will be determined by the Meet Director and communicated to the coaches and officials.

Warm-up Procedure	Entry into swim lanes: all swimmers must enter the swim lanes from the start end of the swim lanes. Warm-up sessions will be divided fairly and equitably by team based on the number of a team’s entrants. There will be specific lanes assigned to each team								
Participating Team Responsibilities	<p>Participating teams are expected to assist with timing. Timing assignments will be emailed to participating teams, and will be assigned fairly and equitably by team based on the number of a team’s entrants.</p> <p>Participating club parents must stay off the deck except to report for timing assignments.</p> <p>Participating teams should assist with officiating whenever possible.</p>								
Seeding	The meet is a deck-seeded timed finals invitational swim meet, and all events will be seeded slowest to fastest.								

Scoring	<p>Scoring for individual events will be awarded on a standard basis, i.e.:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1st – 20 points; 2nd – 17 points; 3rd – 16 points; 4th – 15 points; 5th – 14 points; 6th – 13 points; 7th – 12 points; 8th – 11 points; 9th - 10 points; 10th - 9 points; 11th - 8 points; 12th - 7 points; 13th - 6 points; 14th - 5 points; 15th - 4 points; 16th 3 points ● Relays will not be scored ● The 1st – 16th place finishers will be eligible to score points, and to receive medals (1st - 3rd) and ribbons (4th - 16th). ● Events for swimmers 6 and under will not be scored or counted toward team totals. ● Age group open events will not be scored or counted toward team totals.
Awards:	<p>Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to 1st-3rd place finishers. Ribbons will be awarded to 4th-16th place finishers. Team Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams All 6 and under event participants will receive one trophy. No awards or points will be awarded for age group open events.</p>
Entry Fees:	<p>Individual Event is \$4 per entry if submitted by Thursday, August 3, otherwise \$5 per entry on the day of the meet, Saturday, August 5. The mixed Open "Family" Fun Free Relay is free to enter – come and have fun!</p>
Admissions and Programs	<p>Admission: \$5.00 per person. Children under 5 free. Program: \$5.00 each.</p>
Entry Format	<p>Entries must be submitted in Hy-Tek Team Manager format. On Sunday, July 30, the meet will be sent by Email to all statisticians with a time standards file. Entries should be entered into the meet provided and Emailed to ELAC at elac_mm@outlook.com. Entry fees should be submitted with a check made payable to "ELAC," and brought to the meet on Saturday, August 5. Deck entries must be paid in cash or by separate check.</p>
Results	<p>Final results will be Emailed to each team by 6:00 PM the day of the meet, Saturday, August 5.</p>
Lifeguards	<p>At least 2 lifeguards will always be on duty.</p>
Parking	<p>Due to an extremely small parking lot at the lake, we regret that only cars displaying an "ELPOA" parking sticker will be permitted in the lakeside parking lot. <u>Please be respectful to local residents and avoid blocking driveways and roads when parking on the street: the area will be coned by the police</u></p>
