Job Descriptions:

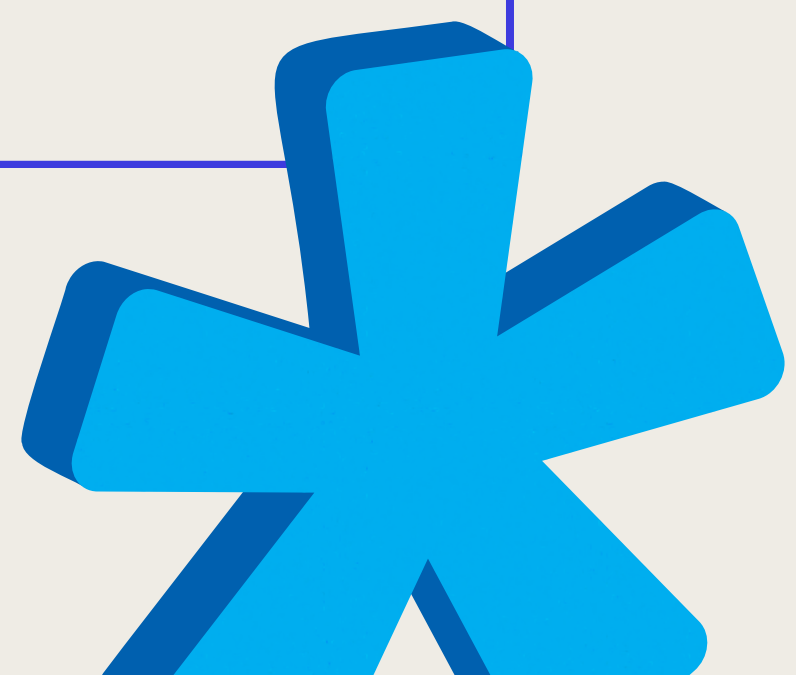
Concession Stand Cashier:
Assist with selling and restocking snacks during a meet.

Timer: Assigned a lane and issued a stopwatch. The Timer is responsible for stopping the stopwatch when the swimmer in their lane touches the wall.

Bullpen: Responsible for calling up our team's swimmers and lining them up for their events. They then escort swimmers to to the ready bench.

Clean Up Crew: Helping the coaches at the end of the meet with breakdown.

Ready Bench Helper: Assist in lining up the swimmers from both teams for each event by heat and lane. They then bring swimmers to the blocks for their race.

Official: Determines if the swimmers are performing the strokes and turns correctly. Experience is helpful, but training is provided. Please let us know if you are interested!

Volunteers Needed!

Swim meets are run by volunteers! Don't be shy or scared to try! There is something you can help out, as there are so many jobs that are vital for the team and for successful meets. And (letting you in on a secret) when you volunteer for certain jobs, you will be closer to the pool! You'll have the best seat in the house!

Area Clean Up: Making sure our area is clean for the hosting team at the end of the meet.

Floater – This person will fill in for volunteer shifts that are vacant, or fill in to give other volunteers a break. Sometimes, this volunteer will be assigned a job as needed at each meet and may not be assigned until just before the meet begins.

Runner: Delivers event sheets to timers, picks up sheets after they are complete and delivers them to the score table.
