ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

4. Acceptance to college, community college, or career school.

A representative committee of the St. John's Summer Swim League will review applications. Award criteria will include, but not necessarily be limited to the following:

1. High school academic record
2. Contribution to your team in terms of good sportsmanship, attitude, and a positive role model for younger swimmers.
3. Quality of response to application essay/questions.
4. Letters of recommendation from coaches, teachers, team parents, and officials (minimum of 2).
