

Gower Swim Meet Visiting Team information

Pool Location: 126 Shallowford Road, Greenville, SC, United States —

Parking: Enter main pool parking lot then stay straight up the hill into Gower Park where you can park on the grass. Parking is also available on the streets near the pool. NO PARKING signs designate restricted areas.

Swimmer Drop Off: Enter main pool parking lot and follow the short counter-clockwise loop to the bottom of the ramp for the main pool entrance, where swimmers can unload.

Stone Lake Swimmer Area: Located near the back/upper pool next to the fence. Area is uncovered but sufficient size for multiple small tents if you would like to bring them. Swimmers are encouraged to bring deck chairs.

Warm Ups:

GOWER 2:50-3:15pm

STONE LAKE 3:20-3:45pm

MEET START TIME 4:00pm

*Back pool will be used for cool down/warm up during the meet and is restricted to lap swimming only, preferably ages 11+. It will be under the supervision of lifeguard staff.

Volunteers:

Officials: meet near back right corner of main/front pool

Clerk of Course: meet near deep end of main/front pool

Timers: meet near back left gate of main/front pool

Records/Runners: meet near gate for baby pool

Ribbons: meet at picnic table across from Apparel under covered middle section of pool

Computer operators: meet in corner near Coaches Room by main/front pool

Heat Sheets: \$3/each (cash only), can be purchased at GOWER APPAREL table immediately to the right once you enter the pool. Swimtopia electronic heat sheets also available.

Spectator Seating: First come first serve. No bleachers available. Please bring your own deck chairs.

Restricted areas will be appropriately roped off around the main/front pool.

Concessions: Available for purchase the duration of the meet. Accept Cash or Credit

Severe Weather Policy: Weather delays are activated and monitored by the pool Lifeguards. There is a limited covered area between the pools if just heavy rain, otherwise we will send everyone back to their cars to wait for instruction via text and the PA system
