Phoenix Country Day School and all meet officials shall be held harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this meet, which includes all warm-up sessions.

**Course:** 10 Lane, 25 yard with non-turbulent lane dividers, Colorado start and timing with 2 button system. Continuous warm-up will be available throughout the meet.

**Eligibility:** 1. Open to any Arizona/USA Swimming registered athlete 8 years or younger. Swimmers can enter 25s as NT. Swimmers must have legally achieved a time in a Sanctioned or Approved USA Swimming competition for 50 free, 50 back, 50 fly, 50 breast, 100 free, and 100IM.

#### Rules Governing Sanctioned Meets

1. Age on the first day the meet will govern for the entire meet.
2. Conduct of the sanctioned event shall conform in every respect to current rules of USA Swimming including technical and administrative rules.
3. All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participating in the conduct of this competition.
4. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
5. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) as to pool length. A copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
6. The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 7 feet at the start end and 7 feet at the turn end.
7. Deck changes are prohibited.
8. The Arizona Swimming Controlled Meet Warm-up and Safety Guidelines will be posted and enforced.
9. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member of USA Swimming. On deck registration is not available at any Arizona Swimming meet.
10. The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms or other areas as may be designated by the Meet Director/Meet Referee.
11. All referees, starters, administrative officials, chief judges, and stroke and turn judges serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event must be non-athlete members of USA Swimming or members of other FINA member organizations. All meet directors for meets sanctioned by USA Swimming must be members of USA Swimming. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be a coach member of USA Swimming.
12. Officials and Meet Marshals must sign in and present proof of current membership and/or training respectively, to the Meet Referee prior to the start of each session of competition.
13. Coaches must sign in and present proof of current membership at the Clerk of Course prior to the start of each session of competition.
14. Meet Marshals shall wear their identifying attire, as provided by the club.
15. Swimmers with disabilities are welcome. The swimmer (or swimmers coach) is responsible for notifying the Referee, prior to the competition, of any disability of the swimmer and the requested accommodation. The swimmer/coach shall provide any assistant(s) or equipment (tappers, deck mats, etc.) if required.
16. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
17. The following medical supervision will be available to athletes participating in the meet: AED device.

## Arizona Swimming 2023 8 and Under Spring Classic

- Meet Rules:**
1. This is a timed final meet. Entry requires the athlete to have previously swum legally 50s and 100s entered in a Sanctioned or Approved USA Swimming competition and must be entered with the time achieved at such competition. 25 of each stroke can be entered as a no time due to lack of 8&under events at meets this season. Coaches should use their best judgement when entering the athletes that they will be legal in the strokes entered. Individual events are pre-seeded, timed final events except as noted in the session schedule below. All individual events are functionally seeded but awarded by separate age group.
  2. Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events per day not including relays. If an entry has greater than eight (8) individual events for the meet or greater than four (4) individual entries for a day, the highest numbered event will be dropped until the entry limits are met.
  3. Relay Entries: Relay cards for events 1, 2, 15 and 16 must be submitted 45 minutes prior to the start of the session in which they will be swum. There is only 1 relay per team which may enter for each age group/gender. Teams are encouraged to pre-enter their relays electronically with the individual events.
  4. Entries: Entry times must be the swimmers best short course yard (SCY) time if available. Entry times for 50s or longer must have been legally swum in a sanctioned/approved meet. If an athlete has achieved a SCM (Short Course Meter) or LCM (Long Course Meter) time but has not achieved a SCY time, they may enter the meet with their SCM or LCM best time. The meet will be seeded in the following order: SCY, SCM, LCM.
  5. Time trials will not be offered.

**Entries:** **All entries must be submitted via email in electronic format which can be uploaded into Hy-Tek Meet Manager.** Entries must be sent to [slee@phoenixswimclub.org](mailto:slee@phoenixswimclub.org), received by 5:00 p.m. on March 11, 2023, and must be accompanied by a .pdf of the meet entries as contained in the electronic file. Non-conforming entries (LCM, SCM) must be noted. The electronic copy will have precedence in case of discrepancy.

**Awards:** **Individual events** will be functionally seeded but awarded according to age groups as follows:  
8-Year-Old Girls and Boys, 7-Year-Old Girls and Boys, 6 Year and Under Girls and Boys

Individual Events: Custom Medals 1-8th place, Custom Ribbons 9-16th place  
Relays Custom Medals 1-8th Place

Awards will be mailed to teams for distribution from Arizona Swimming, Inc. No awards given at the meet.

**Relays events:** Will be swum as 8 and Under events for boys and girls. Custom medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Places for relay events, with only one relay per team being eligible for awards.

**Officials:** Please contact the Meet Referee to indicate availability for the meet. Attire for timed final events is white over blue.

**Deck:** The deck may be closed or partially closed at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Only athletes or those acting in an Official capacity for the meet may enter the closed area.
