- Facility:** 8-Lane competition course. Two 8-lane, 25-yard competition courses, 9 foot lanes.
Daktronics timing system buttons and stopwatches will serve as backups.
Four 25-yard continuous Warm-up/Warm-down lanes
- Directions:** Pool is located just north of I30. From I30 east, take the exit 68/Texas Route 205. Turn left on Goliad and right onto Yellow Jacket Lane. Pool will be at the end of the street next to the football stadium.
From Tyler and Longview: From I20 West, take the exit 499A toward US-80W Dallas. Take exit for FM-148, turn right onto FM-148. Continue onto North TX205 until you reach I30. Go under bridge and turn right onto Yellow Jacket Lane. Pool will be at the end of the street next to the football stadium.
- Covid 19:** An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. - Competition pool will be closed during breaks.**

Timers: RHS and RHHS will provide 4 timers each for this event.

Warm Up: Lanes will be assigned for warm ups, but finals will be open warm up. The first hour will be a general warm up in all lanes. General warm up lanes: NO DIVING. Circle swimming only. No sprinting or pace work will be allowed during the general warm up session. NO DIVING will be allowed from the blocks or the edge of the pool. Swimmers shall enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner. The last 15 minutes of warm up per lane will be:

PUSH PACE	RACING STARTS	GENERAL WARM UP
1 & 8	2, 3, 4, 5,	6 & 7 Warm pool

Push pace lanes: Push off one or two lengths from starting end. Circle swimming only. NO DIVING.

Racing starts: Sprint lanes for racing starts from blocks or for backstroke starts in specified lanes at designated times. Swim one direction only and exit the pool on the opposite end in the same specified lane.

Swimmers w/Disabilities: Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition.

Entries: An individual shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. All seed times should be submitted to the 100th of a second. Each team may enter a maximum of four (4) individuals per event and one (1) relay per event. Entries are to be sent in via the [advancer file](#).

Entry Deadline: All team entries will be submitted using the [advancer file](#) from districts. **Email scratches only to rockwallswimentries@gmail.com**
Advancer files should be sent to rockwallswimentries@gmail.com from the District meet
 All advancer files shall be received not later than **12:00PM Central Time, on February 1st, 2021. All scratches are due by February 2nd, 2021 at 12 pm.**
Coaches, please notify your district meet director of any regional qualifier that you are planning on scratching for the region meet. This will allow us to insure that the alternate athletes are called up, and able to compete.
****Remember**** Divers must be included with the team's entries that are due by 12:00 PM. Monday, February 1st, 2021. **Dive Sheets are due Monday February 1st, 2021 at 12:00pm to rockwallswimentries@gmail.com in pdf**

Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$15.00 per swimmer. Entry fees or proof of the requisition of fees must be received prior to competition. Relay only swimmers are \$15.00. There is also a \$100 facility management fee per School to cover the cost of regular meet management as well as professional live stream of meet with announcers. **ENTRY FEES PAYABLE TO: Rockwall ISD Aquatics**

Hospitality: Hospitality will be provided for coaches and officials.

Officials: All officials are required to attend an officials meeting one hour prior to the start of the meet. This meeting will review and clarify any rules necessary as well as answer questions. The uniform for all Prelims sessions, will be white polo over khaki shorts/pants/skirt. All finals sessions will be navy polo over shake shorts/pants/skirt. No shorts at finals.

Governed By: The 2020-2021 National Federation Swimming Rules.

Rules: Effective 2016-2017 season, deck changing is now unsportsmanlike conduct and can result in disqualification from any further events. If conduct is considered excessive, the team personnel can be removed from the meet.

The use of audio or visual recording devices including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

USA Swimming Observed:

This meet will be USA swimming observed. **Please make sure that any swimmer wanting their swim to be observed has their USA swimming ID number entered correctly.** The host will not add them manually.

Weather

In the case of bad weather Regionals will be delayed until Later in the day or the first day we can run the meet. Emails will be sent to all coaches to updates.

Contingency plan:

Team Trophies will be awarded to Boy’s and Girl’s 1st-3rd place. Medals shall be awarded for 1st – 3rd place for individual and relay events. Ribbons will be awarded 4th-8th place.

Awards & Scoring:

Points will be awarded as follows:

Individual events: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Relay Events: 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Championship Certificates for

- Girl and Boy Diver of the Meet (determined by coach’s vote)
- Girl’s and Boy’s Diving Coach of the Year (votes due to the Meet management room before the end of diving)
- Girl and Boy Swimmer of the Meet (determined by individual event power points)
- Girl’s and Boy’s Swimming Coach of the Year (votes due to Meet management room before 100 breast)

The following criteria will be followed to determine TISCA Awards:

- Coaches must be current members of TISCA to be eligible to vote or receive a TISCA
- Regional Coach of the Year Award. Each TISCA member will get one vote.
- Coach of the Year Award will be determined by a vote of the eligible coaches. Coaches will vote for a Girl’s Region Coach of the Year and a Boy’s Region Coach of the Year for both Swimming and Diving.
- TISCA Athlete of the Meet for girls and boys swimming will be determined by utilizing the NISCA powerpoint system. The swimmer(s) with the highest individual point total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for swimming.

Advancers:

The top finisher in each event will advance to the UIL State Championship
