Thank you for joining us for our 3rd Burnet CISD Meet of The 2022-2023 Swim & Dive Season! We have a long history of Swim/Dive in the Hill Country Area and are looking forward to continuing our legacy this year. We would like to thank you for attending and ask that you read the details below.

MEET DETAILS:

Burnet CISD 3rd Swim/Dive Meet

Friday, October 14th, 2022

- Warm Ups Begin at 2pm - lanes assigned upon arrival
- The Meet Starts at 3pm - when all teams have completed warm ups
- Diving Begins right after then swimming races are completed/pool changed

LOCATION: The YMCA of Highland Lakes Aquatics Center

Parking Located On Site (Busses-please park in the back of the YMCA)

From TX-29 State Hwy 29 (US-183 Hwy N)

- Take Hwy 29 N or US-183 HWY North
- Continue on Hwy 29 or US-183 North
- Turn onto W State Hwy 29
- Continue straight onto TX-29 W/W State Hwy 29 (Pass The Whataburger)
- Turn left onto N U.S. Hwy 281/S Water St. (Pass O'Reilly Auto Parts)
- Buses should park at the back parking lot behind the YMCA near the baseball fields on the right side when you enter the YMCA.

POOLS:

The competition will take place in the eight (8) lanes of our 25 yard indoor pool. Warm up and warm down will take place in the (8) lane, 25 yard indoor pool before and after the Meet. There is no diving allowed in the shallow pool. Open Warm Up/Cool Down will be allowed during the Meet in the shallow indoor therapeutic pool, Note this is a heated pool, use your best judgment.

SPECTATORS:

Spectators are permitted to attend. Entry fee for spectators will be \$6 per adult/child and \$2 per student with their ID. Heat Sheets will be sold at the door for \$2. Parking is limited at the YMCA and will be available on a first come, first serve basis.

*Masks are not required, and we ask that you self-monitor for any illness or systems.

SEEDING: The meet will be timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest. Swimmers who are entered with NT for No Time will be seeded in the slowest heats. Coaches are encouraged to have an accurate time for every swimmer. No proof of time is needed



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ENTRIES: All entries must be sent electronically via email using Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager computer software or Emailed Spreadsheet for Smaller Teams without the Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager Software. This includes team relays and individual events.

- There are no limitations on the number of swimmers per individual event, however only the four (4) competitors from each team may score points for any given event.
- Each athlete may enter a maximum of four (4) events of which no more than two (2) events may be individual events.
- Teams may enter only 2 relays, please number relays A and B.

ENTRY FEES:

-Entry fees are \$15 per athlete entered in the meet. There is no fee for relays. Entry fees are due at the start of the competition.

ORDER OF EVENTS:

Standard high school order of events will be followed, with the exception of diving. Diving will take place after all the swimming races are completed. There will be 5 minute breaks after the 200 Medley Relay, 50 Free, 500 Free, and 100 Breast.

SCORING: Individual Events:

1st - 16th place: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events:

1st - 16th place: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2



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AWARDS: There will be no awards at this meet.

RULES AND SANCTIONS:

The 2022-2023 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and all UIL rules and guidelines will be applied. Pending official availability, this meet MAY be USA swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. Please be sure that USA swimming IDs are correct in the Hy-Tek entry file.

TIMING SYSTEM:

A Colorado electronic timing system with Daktronics electronic scoreboard will be used to time the meet. Two watches per lane will be used as back up. This meet will be available on Meet Mobile with free heat sheets.

TIMERS: We ask that each team submit 2 timers and volunteers for the meet. Should there be any open timing or volunteer positions, visiting teams may be asked to provide more than 2 volunteers.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers, or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION:

Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Athletes will have access to changing rooms, showers, and restrooms at the YMCA.

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will be available at the meet in the lobby area of the YMCA for purchase.

HOSPITALITY:

There will be hospitality for all Coaches and Officials in the pool area by the diving blocks.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

-All coaches should self screen themselves and athletes before arriving. Anyone who does not feel well, or shows symptoms of COVID will not be permitted to enter the facility.

-Spectators will be permitted with their payment of the entry fee. The meet will be on Meet Mobile, however heat sheets will be available for purchase for \$2.

-Spectators, athletes, and coaches are not required to wear face coverings, but they are welcome to wear if they wish.
