For the next two years Amber swam for the Torpedoes. In 2017 Amber was ready to add backstroke to her events. Her time for the 50-meter backstroke in June of that year was 1:37.19. To date her fastest backstroke time is 56.59 seconds. She conquered the fear of diving in 2018 and began diving from the edge of the pool. In 2019 Amber moved to Virginia and the first team her family looked for was a swim team. She has been with the Dahlgren Sharks ever since. In 2019 Amber began swimming the 50-meter breaststroke with a time of 2:00.97. Her fastest time so far is 1:14.52. She overcame another fear this year and began diving off the block. When 2021 came around she was added to a new event. Amber swam the 100-meter freestyle with a time of 2:09.95 and ended the season at 1:59.96. Last year, 2022, has been her fastest so far. Hopefully, in 2023 she will continue to drop times in all her events. Amber has never been the fastest and has been happy just to improve her time. She is especially joyful when she does not come in last. Swimming is her favorite sport and will be a lifelong hobby. Amber is looking forward to what comes next for her. As far as her aquatic future is concerned, she is thinking about becoming a lifeguard and a swim instructor. She has many other aspirations as well. Amber will succeed in everything she does because of things she has learned through swimming. What she has learned is to do her best no matter how others are doing around her, to value being on time, to be diligent, and to persevere no matter what.
