



Division 2 Championship Meet @ Villages of Urbana Blue Crabs

Meet Information
July 18, 2026



Location: The home of the Blue Crabs is located at **3630 Stone Barn Drive, Urbana, MD 21704**. The Villages of Urbana Stone Barn pool is a 25 meter, eight-lane pool with starting blocks. The depth at the starting end of the pool (left side of the lap pool in image) is 9 feet.

Parking: Parking is available around the entire pool complex, along Stone Barn Drive, and throughout the surrounding neighborhood. There is also parking available at Sugarloaf Elementary School. Please be mindful of our neighbors as you park your car. We recommend carpooling and encourage you to drop off swimmers and belongings to the left of the grassy area in the above image before finding a place to park. Each team will be provided with 3 reserved spots.

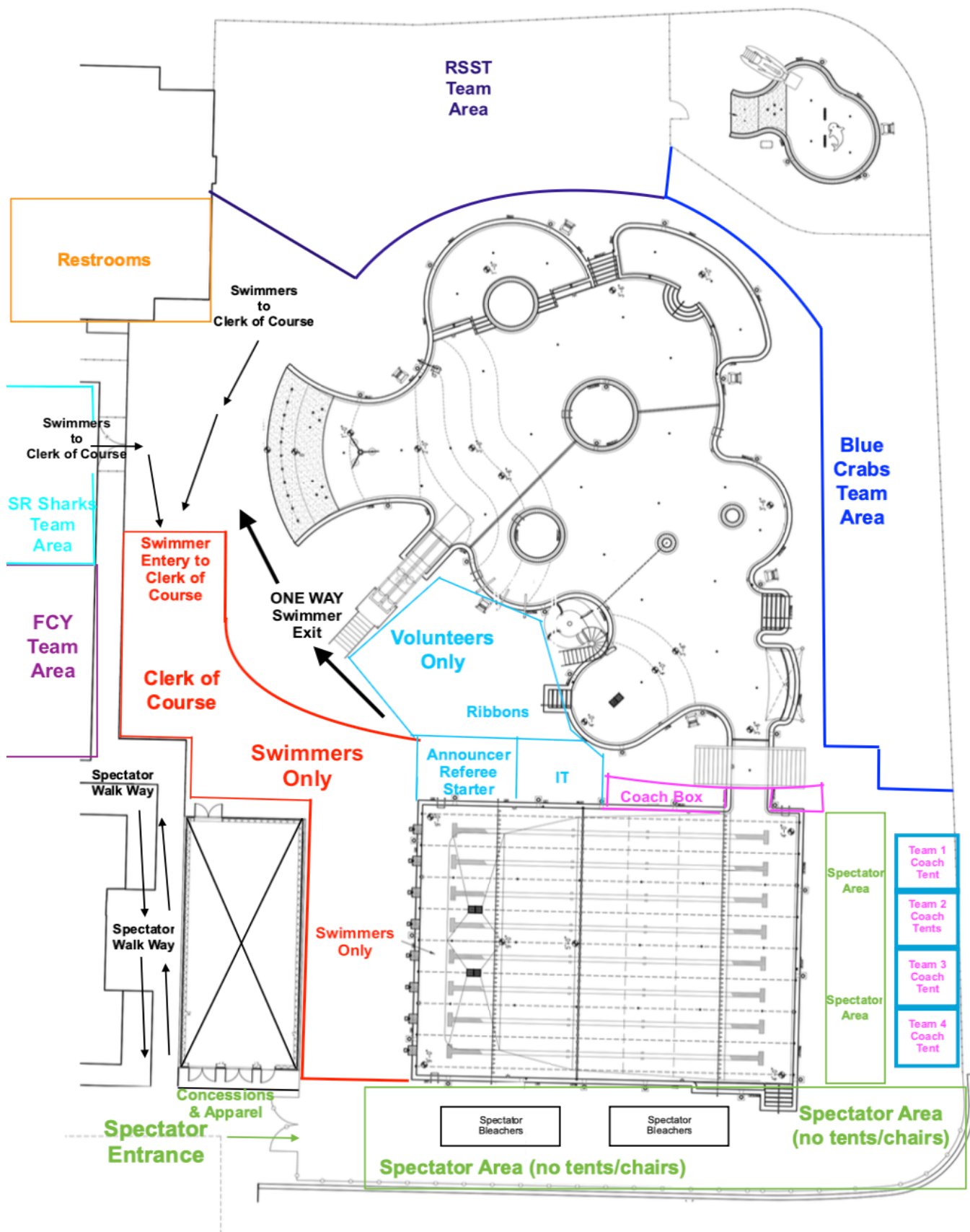


Team Seating Areas: FCY and Spring Ridge will set up in the grassy area between the two buildings, while the Blue Crabs and RSST will set up on the pool deck. All teams will have quick access to the clerk of course which will be located on the pool deck in the center of the above image. Trash bags will be provided around your team area. Thank you in advance for keeping your team area clean and disposing of all trash at the conclusion of the meet.

Coach Areas: We will have space for each team to set-up one tent for your coaches on the end opposite the starting blocks (see page 2 map). There will be a coach box on the starter's side of the pool to watch swimmers as needed.

Spectator Information: Spectator viewing will be available along the pool deck opposite the starter and along the end of the pool opposite the starting blocks. There are no personal tents or chairs allowed in the spectator area.

IT Entries: Samuel Nevares (it.urbanbluecrabs@gmail.com) is our IT rep and will be seeding and running the meet. Per FSSL rules, entry files are due to Sam no later than 8:00 PM on Wednesday, July 15. Please upload your entries to the Google Drive Folder sent via email. Once the meet is seeded, Sam will upload the Meet Program, Entry List, and Meet Manager back up file to this same location. We will not be selling paper programs, so you are free to distribute them to your team as you deem helpful. We will provide 4 printed programs for your staff.
