**Entry Information:** a maximum of three (3) individual events & two (2) relay events. 15-18 Swimmers may swim a bonus 50 free event

- **All entries are required to have a time entered.** NT will not be accepted. **Any swimmer who does not have a time will not be entered into that event.**
- Coaches will be responsible for entering correct swimmers and times. Coaches must sign and include the "Head Coach Entry Verification" Form with the meet packet.
- **Each swimmer must comply with the Contra Costa County Eligibility Rules to participate in City Meet.**
- A Relays: Each participating club may enter one (1) A relay. Any four swimmers and/or alternates may swim on each relay. For "A" Division ONLY, swimmers and alternates must be on your original Relay Swimmers form as submitted at the Scratch Meeting.
- Exhibition Relays: Each participating team may enter up to 2 exhibition relays (B and C). These relays will not score and will not compete for awards. We will limit exhibition relays to 2 heats. In the event that every team enters a C relay, we will give priority to the teams with the highest number of participants.
- PARENT 100 yard MEDLEY Relays (4x25) will be held on Saturday and PARENT FREESTYLE Relays (4x25) will be held at the conclusion of the meet on Sunday. Enter one Dad's and one Mom's team for each Relay. *We are asking that teams keep this event to a true "Parent's Relay".* Parent and Coaches relays do not score or compete for awards.
- Enter one (1) Coaches Team for the MEDLEY Relay (4x50) and FREESTYLE RELAY (4x50). There is NO CHARGE for Parent or Coach Relay entries, but please submit entry times if possible. Please include your team name for parent/coaches relays with Hy-Tek entries. No parent/coaches names are necessary.

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**SCRATCH MEETING**

**Date/Time:** Thursday, July 26 @ 6 pm

**Location:** Concord Community Pool

The only business to be conducted at this meeting will be:

- *Scratching swimmers* from events. *(NO other changes will be made to entries, including adding swimmers or changing events)*. Scratches must be submitted in writing using the form found in this packet.
- Submit names of relay swimmers including alternates for A relay using the form found in this packet.
- Programs, lunch tickets, name badges will be handed out to coaches (we are limiting these to 5 per team).

**RULES**

1. This is a championship meet. All swimmers must be capable of swimming across the pool unassisted. Each swimmer should be competent in the strokes in which he/she is entered.
2. Current USA Swimming Rules will govern the entire meet including; strokes, turns, starts, finishes, warm ups, swimsuits, etc.
3. 6 & under 'B' division (only) breaststroke and butterfly stroke judging will not conform to USA Swimming rules. The swimmer must do some semblance of the stroke, as determined by the stroke and turn judges:
  - ✓ Swimmer must not do anything 'illegal' to gain a significant unfair advantage i.e. doing freestyle for most or all of their swim
  - ✓ A 'B' swimmer in these two events will not be allowed to be bumped into the 'A's if they have one of the fastest eight times
  - ✓ One-hand touches will not count as a disqualification
  - ✓ Freestyle and backstroke will be judged as usual with USA Swimming rules
4. There will be two ALTERNATES listed for each individual "FINAL" event.
5. The Alternates should check in with Clerk of the Course and be present and ready to swim if an opening occurs.
6. Referees will have sole authority in determining whether a swimmer is too late.
7. USA Swimming Rule 102.14.G: Any swimmer who is charged with committing or causing a False Start shall be disqualified.
8. All events will utilize the semi-automatic push button **Colorado Timing System with touch pads.**

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9. NO complimentary swimmers will be allowed.
10. SUBSTITUTIONS & CHANGES: NO change in submitted times or names of competing swimmers in individual events will be allowed, either Trials or Finals.
11. NO swimmer may swim under another swimmer's name.
12. Noncompliance with these rules will result in the DISQUALIFICATION of the swimmer(s) from the current meet and sanctions against coaches and/or team.

**SEEDING**

All seeding is based on entered times. The fastest three heats of individual events of the Trials are "circle seeded". Heats prior to those are seeded according to entered times. Individual Medley and Relays are "Timed Finals" and will be seeded by entered times and are not circle seeded.

**SWIMMER'S AGE GROUP & SWIM-UPS**

- A swimmer's age as of June 15, 2023 will determine the age group in which they may compete.
- Swimmers may "swim up" for Medley and Free Relays, but may only swim 1 Medley and 1 Free Relay.
- If a swimmer swims up for an individual event, the swimmer must swim up for all individual events with the exception of "Swimming up" for the 7/8 IM in which 6 & Unders may compete.

**SWIMMER CLASSIFICATIONS AND DIVISIONS**

**"A" Division - all individual & relay events      "B" Division - individual events only**

These separate divisions are not intended to classify swimmers as one type or the other. In fact, a swimmer may be an "A" swimmer in one event and a "B" swimmer in another. It is meant to provide opportunities for more swimmers to receive special recognition by participating in the finals of a championship meet. Operation of the "A/B" Divisions will be as follows:

13. "B" Division will apply ONLY to individual events; the "B" relays are not scored and the purpose is to allow swimmers to participate in additional races.
14. The number of entries in an event will determine whether or not there will be a "B" Division in that event. There will be no minimum "B" Division time requirements.
  - ✓ If there are nineteen (19) or more entries in an event, there will be a "B" Division. The entries will be divided into "A" heats and "B" heats, based upon entered times. The heats will be divided in half with fastest heats being the "A" Division and the slower heats being the "B" Division. Ties and the odd heat go to the "B" Division.
  - ✓ If there are less than nineteen (19) entries in an event, there will be no "B" Division for that event. All the entries will be in the "A" Division.

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15. The “A” Division Finalists will be the 10 fastest trial times, no matter where the swimmer was seeded based on entered times. The alternates for the “A” Division will be the next two fastest swimmers.
  - ✓ A “B” Division seeded swimmer will only qualify for the “A” Division Finals if they have one of the 10 fastest trial times or ten fastest final times in the IM (as the IM is a timed final). For example, if a swimmer who is originally seeded in the “B” Division swims the seventh fastest overall time in the IM, he or she will be scored seventh place in the “A” division.
  - ✓ The exception to this is the “B” division 6 & under breaststroke and butterfly swimmers, who are not eligible to move up to the “A” division finals (due to the special stroke & turn considerations being allowed-see the Rules section).
16. The “B” Division Finalists will be the 10 fastest trial times of “B” Division entries NOT qualifying for the “A” Division Finals with the alternate being the next fastest. An “A” Division entry may NOT qualify for the “B” Division Finals.
17. No-shows and Scratches will not change the “A” or “B” Division seeding. Seeding is based on the entered times as received.
18. There is no guarantee as to “A” or “B” Division seeding for any swimmer until all entries are received and consolidated. Submit “true top times”, which means each child must have achieved the entry time during the summer swimming season in a *competitive dual swim meet*.
19. All entries are required to have a time entered, **NT will not be accepted**. Any swimmer who does not have a time will be removed from the race.

### **CLERK OF THE COURSE**

**All swimmers MUST check in with the Clerk of the Course for all events and may enter the pool area through the Clerk ONLY.** If a swimmer does not check in, they will not be allowed to swim in that event. If a finalist is a “no-show” a “first call” will be announced. If the swimmer still does not show up, a “final call” will be announced and then the Alternate will be seated with that heat. Once the heat STANDS up to exit the Clerk of the Course, the Finalist will be scratched and the Alternate is moved to the Finals. The Head Referee’s decision regarding these matters will be final.

### **WARM UPS**

#### Competition Side of the Pool:

For safety purposes, warm up times and lanes will be assigned by team and based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet.

**A TEAM COACH MUST BE ON DECK SUPERVISING WARM UP ACTIVITIES—SWIMMERS CANNOT ENTER THE WATER UNLESS THE COACH AND LIFEGUARDS ARE PRESENT.** The coach is responsible for the safety of their swimmers during warm ups.

Lanes 1 and 10 will be designated as "DIVE" lanes and that is the only warm up activity that is to take place in that lane.

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All other lanes are for CIRCLE SWIMMING ONLY. There is NO DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING lanes. **Entry to these lanes is to be feet first entry from a sitting position at all times.**

Non-Competition Side of the Pool (Warm up Pool):

Only swimmers entered in the meet are allowed in the warm up pool and only warm ups or cool downs are allowed. For better control, lanes will be designated by age group

Warm up pool will be open: Friday starting at 4:30 pm; Saturday & Sunday starting at 7:00 am.

**At NO time during the meet, may swimmers dive in the warm up pool. All lanes will be CIRCLE SWIMMING, with feet first entry from a sitting position at all times.**

Each team (as part of their meet work assignments) will be responsible for providing Parent Marshals to oversee and enforce the warm up rules. Parent Marshals will be on duty in addition to the lifeguards.

**GROUND SITE RULES**

- Access to the pool area for decorating and/or setting up team areas will begin at **12 pm on Friday, July 21 and NO earlier.**
- Posters may be hung on fences and/or bleachers only, NOT on any buildings.
- Please limit food and drink to team areas not the pool deck.
- Use of Alcohol is strictly prohibited. The police will be called to arrest individuals in violation of this policy.

**PARKING**

**We ask all teams to make their swimmer families aware of the reduced parking available, and encourage families to only bring one vehicle to the swim meet. Also, we ask that families be courteous to the neighbors. Please park respectfully. Do not block driveways. Do not litter on their yards. Do not loiter in front of their houses.**

There will be reserved parking for our *Meet Officials (i.e., Head Referee and Starters)*. There will not be parking for Stroke and Turn officials.

We will run 10 final lanes and award to 10 places; however, we will only be scoring to 8 places.

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**AWARDS**

**Medals and Ribbons**

- “A” Division, for individuals and relays – Awards for 1st through 10th places
- “A” Division for Relays – Awards for 1st through 3rd places
- “B” Division, for individuals only – Awards for 1st through 10th places
- Record Breakers, for individuals and relays
- Heat Winner Ribbons will be awarded to both A and B division individual events: Individual Medley timed finals, Butterfly, Freestyle, Breaststroke and Backstroke preliminary swims. Heat Winner ribbons will be handed out immediately to the swimmers as they exit the pool.

**Awards and Trophies**

- Team Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places in the “A” and “B” Divisions
- High Point “A” Award to the boy and girl in each age group who score the most points in individual events in the "A" Division only. In the event of a tie, both swimmers will be awarded a trophy. The swimmer that has taken off the most accumulated time, final times versus prelim times, in their events swam will receive the trophy at the awards ceremony after the meet. The other swimmer will receive their trophy a few weeks after the event because the trophy will need to be ordered.
- High Point “B” Awards to the boy and girl in each age group who score the most points in individual events in the "B" Division only. In the event of a tie, both swimmers will be awarded a trophy. The swimmer that has taken off the most accumulated time, final times versus prelim times, in their events swam will receive the trophy at the awards ceremony after the meet. The other swimmer will receive their trophy a few weeks after the event because the trophy will need to be ordered.
- Sportsmanship Plaque will be awarded to the team that best exemplifies the spirit of sportsmanship as voted on by participating teams.
- Outstanding Boys and Girls RELAY Team Plaques will be awarded to the relay team, where consideration is based on a specific Relay event (Medley or Free).

Criteria to be used includes:

1. Relay records broken. If more than one record is broken, the award goes to the relay team that takes the highest percentage of time off of the existing record.\*
2. If no records are broken, then the award will go to the team that wins a relay event and is the closest to the existing record based on percentage.\*

\*This is calculated as % to make it fair for the younger age groups, whose relays are only 4x25's.

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**SPORTSMANSHIP JUDGING GUIDELINES**

The judging is based on the following:

1. The voting committee will consist of one (1) representative from each participating team. *Sportsmanship representatives must be present and able to make observations throughout the entire meet evaluating not only the swimmers, but also the coaches and parents (including meet workers).* The representatives will not be eligible to vote for their own team.
2. **Each team will be rated by scoring one number (one being the lowest and five the highest) for each category: Sportsmanship, Enthusiasm, and Courteousness.** Completed rating sheets will then be given to the Sportsmanship Award Coordinator, who will calculate each team's overall score to determine the winner of this prestigious award.
3. The meet referee will be available for consultation, especially in the event of a tie.
4. Any pre-meet practical jokes or foul play by one team (club) against another team (club) will count against the offending team.
5. Category considerations:
  - a. Sportsmanship – Respect for the other team's swimmers in the midst of competition (i.e., waiting in the pool until all swimmers complete the event, shaking hands after the event). Positive communications – no “bad mouthing” other teams or swimmers. Professionalism in responding to an unfortunate event (i.e., disqualification, not a best swim).
  - b. Enthusiasm – Spirit, cheering for swimmers, and having fun.
  - c. Courteousness/Politeness – Being friendly and polite to *everyone* at the meet not only other teams, but your own team, the life guards, coaches, officials, and concessionaires. Respecting team areas and picking up after yourselves. Meet workers (timers, warm up marshals, and stroke & turn) showing up on time for their scheduled work assignments.

**The activities, both favorable and unfavorable, of swimmers, parents (including stroke & turn and meet workers) and coaches will count towards your team's ratings.**

Please be sure that a copy of this is given to your sportsmanship representative prior to the meet. The representatives from all teams will meet on Saturday at 8:00 a.m. If necessary, they will also meet on Sunday at 8:00 am. Voting will take place immediately following the conclusion of the meet on Sunday.

All of our swimmers are aware that entry into either pool area for warm ups must be feet first from a seated position (the only exception being posted DIVE Lanes in the competition side of the pool).
