



The 2025 Stingray Saltwater Invitational

This meet will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Rocket City Swim League (RCSL). RCSL technical rules and regulations will be followed, with the exception of items specifically addressed in the meet information. Sanctioned by RCSL.

HOSTED BY: Mountain Springs Swim Club (MTSP)

LOCATION: Mountain Springs Pool – 905 Kennamer Dr SE, Huntsville, AL 35801

FACILITIES: POOL – One Outdoor 6-lane, 25 yard competition saltwater pool. Non-turbulent lane lines. Automatic timing (TBR). ***Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.***

SPECTATORS: Adjacent common area will be available for swimmers and spectators. Space may be available for chairs allows on the pool deck (such that they do not interfere with conduct of meet).

CONCESSIONS: Will be available.

COACHES: A coaches' meeting will be held Saturday at 9:00 near the scorer table.

RULES: The Current Rules of Competition will govern the conduct of the meet unless otherwise noted

ELIGIBILITY: A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine his or her age for the entire meet. Age groups for competition are: 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, and Open. Results will be separately for each age group. ***Open events are open to swimmers in ANY age group, coaches and parents included.*** The meet will be limited to the first 500 swimmers.

SAFETY: In the event of safety and accident prevention, coaches and swimmers must observe all posted rules and to conduct themselves in a safe and prudent manner.

WARM-UP: The meet director will post and announce the warm-up assignments prior to the start of the meet warm-up. Racing dives will only be allowed during the last 10 minutes of the warm-up session with swimming allowed in one direction. Each team must have at least one coach present.

PARKING: Parking will be allowed in the Mountain Springs lot and also in the Three Caves Land Trust lot down the hill. Please follow the direction of the parking coordinators posted in the lots.

START TIME: Saturday June 14th, Warm-up 8:15am, Meet start 9:30am.

ENTRY FEE: \$2 per individual swimmer (Facility Fee)
\$3 per individual event

NOTE: All entry fees are non-refundable (unless **cancelled** due to rain in which case only Facility Fee is non-refundable).

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter no more than four (4) individual events. The meet may be limited to the first 500 swimmers.

If an entry is due to a Mountain Springs error, the swimmer will be entered in an open lane of the heat nearest his/her entry time or in a new heat. The entire event will not be re-seeded.

Entries will be required in HYTEK'S TEAM MANAGER export (and Backup) and emailed to stingraysmtsp@gmail.com. See below for the deadline for emailed entries. Meet results will be emailed to the address entries are sent from as well as posted on the RCSL website.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by June 8th @ Noon. Entry fees including any surcharges must be received by the entry chairperson by the beginning of the meet. Teams should coordinate and then submit ONE payment to Mountain Springs. **Please fill out the Team Information Sheet, Team Waiver, and attach the Check made payable to Mountain Springs Swim Club.**

MEET FORMAT: This is a timed finals meet. All events will be pre-seeded. A bullpen with a clerk-of-course will be provided based on the number of swimmers entered. Swimmers are responsible for arriving at the bullpen in time for their registered events.

AWARDS: First, Second, and Third place will be awarded for all events.

SPECIAL NOTE: Should there be any questions, meet officials will recognize only coaches or their designated representatives. The referee reserves the right to combine heats and/or events.
