Facility

8 lane, 25 yard pool with competition non-turbulent lane markers. Daktronic Timing System, Spectrum starting blocks, continuous warm up/down pool available. Pool depth is 7' at the starting end and 4' at the turn end. Swimmers must always enter the warm-up pool feet first. Spectator seating is available in the spectator viewing area above the pool.

Swimmers Crash Area and Spectators Viewing Area

Swimmers and their families are welcome to set up tents on the lawn outside the pool area. If the weather does not cooperate the main gym floor will be used as the crash area. Swimmers can enter the pool on the west entrance or go through the main lobby. The spectator's viewing area is above the pool, capacity of 300 spectators. Spectators' entrance will be on the exterior of the building next to the swimmer's entrance. Spectators will go directly up the stairs just inside the door, watch their swimmer from the viewing area, then exit through the same stairway and doors.

Meet Format

This meet will be timed final.

Meet Warm-up and Start Times

Warm-ups will start at 7:00AM.

Eligibility

Swimmers must finish in the top eight (8) places in at least one individual event at their respective conference swim meet. Swimmers may then enter up to four individual events for the Summer League Championships. These events may, or may not, be the same events the swimmer swam at their conference meet.

Entries

Swimmers are permitted to swim four (4) individual events for the meet plus one relay. There will be a limit of 400 swimmers. Entries can be submitted beginning Monday July 22nd at 9:00AM. Entries will be accepted until the meet is full or until the deadline of Tuesday July 30th at 9:00PM. Email entries to heartlandswimming@gmail.com

Entry Procedure

All entries are to be submitted through a Hy-Tek compatible format via email. A team entry list and invoice will be mailed to the entry contact person for review on Wednesday July 31st. Any corrections or changes can be submitted until Thursday August 1st by 12:00PM noon. Entry fees must be submitted before the meet start at 9am. **We will accept one payment (cash/check) for the total fee from each conference...NO individual swimmer fees will be accepted.* Please give entry fees to Coach Alex Savage or Ashley Ludwig. ***Please make checks payable to Effingham Swim Club***

\$5.00 per individual event

NO fee per relay event

\$5.00 swimmer surcharge in lieu of admission fees

Deck Entries

If space allows and at the discretion of the meet director, deck entries will be accepted at a charge of \$10.00 per individual event and \$20 per relay event. ***Any events entered after Thursday, August 1st at 12:00PM noon will be charged a deck entry fee.*** Deck entries will only be permitted if they do not create additional heats.

Bullpen

Swimmers will bullpen just outside the west pool doors and then enter those doors directly behind the blocks. Coaches will be spaced around the deck for swimmers to talk to and then swimmer will exit through the north doors directly to the crash area.

Heat Sheets

Heat sheets will be posted throughout the complex and available on Meet Mobile. Heat Sheets will also be available for purchase at the concession stand.

Awards

Custom medals will be awarded for 1st – 8th and single ribbons for 9th – 16th places, for all individual events. No awards will be given for relay events. High point trophies will be awarded to the top 3 high point finishers in each age group. Awards will be divided by conference, and one representative can collect the awards to be distributed accordingly.

Results

Event results will be posted outside near the bullpen. Complete results will be available at the conclusion of the meet as well as on the Effingham Swimming website event page.

Timers /Officials

Each conference is expected to provide timers. Lane assignments by team will be posted on the Effingham Swimming website event page as well as posted the day of the meet throughout the complex. Volunteer officials will be appreciated!

Concessions/Vendors

Safety Guidelines

**Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones are not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

**No flash photography is permitted in the competition pool area.

**No photography is permitted behind the starting blocks.

**Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not permitted.

ANY SWIMMER IN OR MESSING WITH THE LANDSCAPING ROCKS WILL RESULT IN AN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE MEET. THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR PLAYING WITH THE ROCKS, IN THE EVENT OF A ROCK BREAKING A WINDOW, ALL FEES WILL BE SENT TO THE RESPONSIBLE PARTY.
