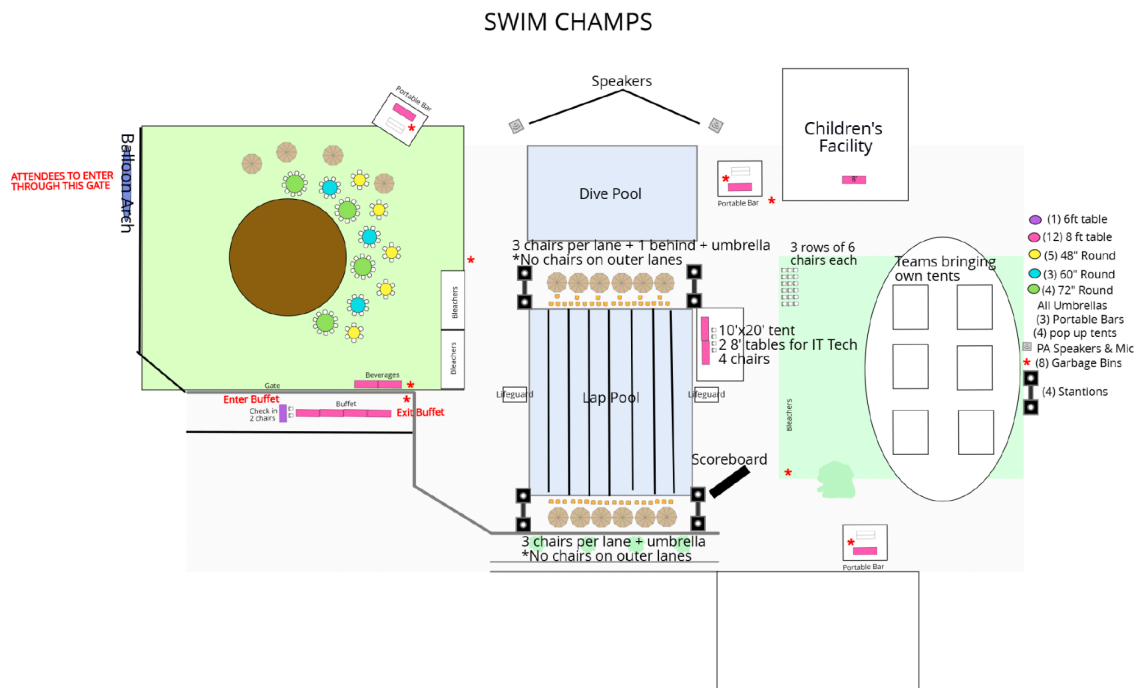
Information for PARENTS

Parking:

Cars should enter at the main driveway on Park Ln and proceed to the Polo Field for parking on the grass. Please adhere to low speed signage and follow any instructions given by Club personnel. Entry to the pool area will be from the polo field at the north end of the main

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building. Swimmers and spectators do not need to enter the main building or any part of the main parking lot to access the pool.

Seating, the Sun, and Food/Drink:

Menlo Circus Club has minimal bleacher seating. We will have some extra seating available and also welcome families to bring their own seating for away from the pool between their swimmers' races. ** There WON'T be tents set up at the blocks, bleachers or timers end of the competition pool. All clubs can bring extra tents for spectators to use away from the pool, if available. – *** **Food/Drink:** The Club will provide taco and beverage bars that swimmers and attendees can credit to their respective Club accounts. Clubs are also allowed to bring appropriate snacks and non-alcoholic drinks for their spectators and swimmers. Hospitality water is for volunteers and staff ONLY; **swimmers must bring their own water**. Please remind swimmers to be mindful of their trash, as there should be ample garbage cans available for use. **No "byo" alcohol or glass is permitted.**

Volunteers:

No parents other than volunteers will be allowed in the "Officials and Swimmers" areas on the pool deck. Each Club should direct their non-volunteer parents and spectators to remain in the designated seating area in an effort to keep the pool deck as clear as possible and ensure a smooth running meet. The Meet Director will wear a yellow vest, and volunteer coordinators will have club tags for easy identification. The warm-up pool marshal and deck marshals will wear orange-colored vests. Badges/vests can be collected at the announcer's table upon arrival. Volunteer timers should also check in at the announcer's table to confirm their lane assignment. **Each club needs to forward the name of their Volunteer Coordinator to Sally Loverro, sallytruck@gmail.com.

Programs:

Peninsula GCC will send out in PDF form the finalized Champs Program by 8 AM on Thursday, July 16th, the day of meet. Coaches should be ready to forward the program to their team families. Programs will only be printing a small number of paper copies for the meet. Coaches should notify their families in advance that the program will be arriving via email on Thursday morning, and families should print the number of copies they would like to have for their personal use.
