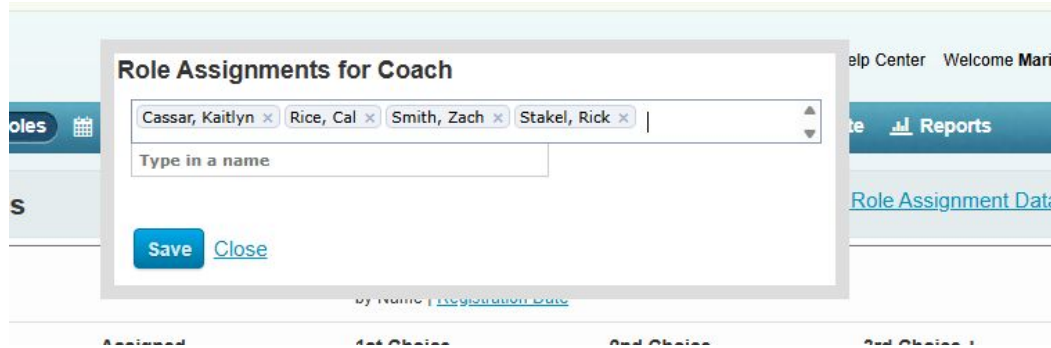

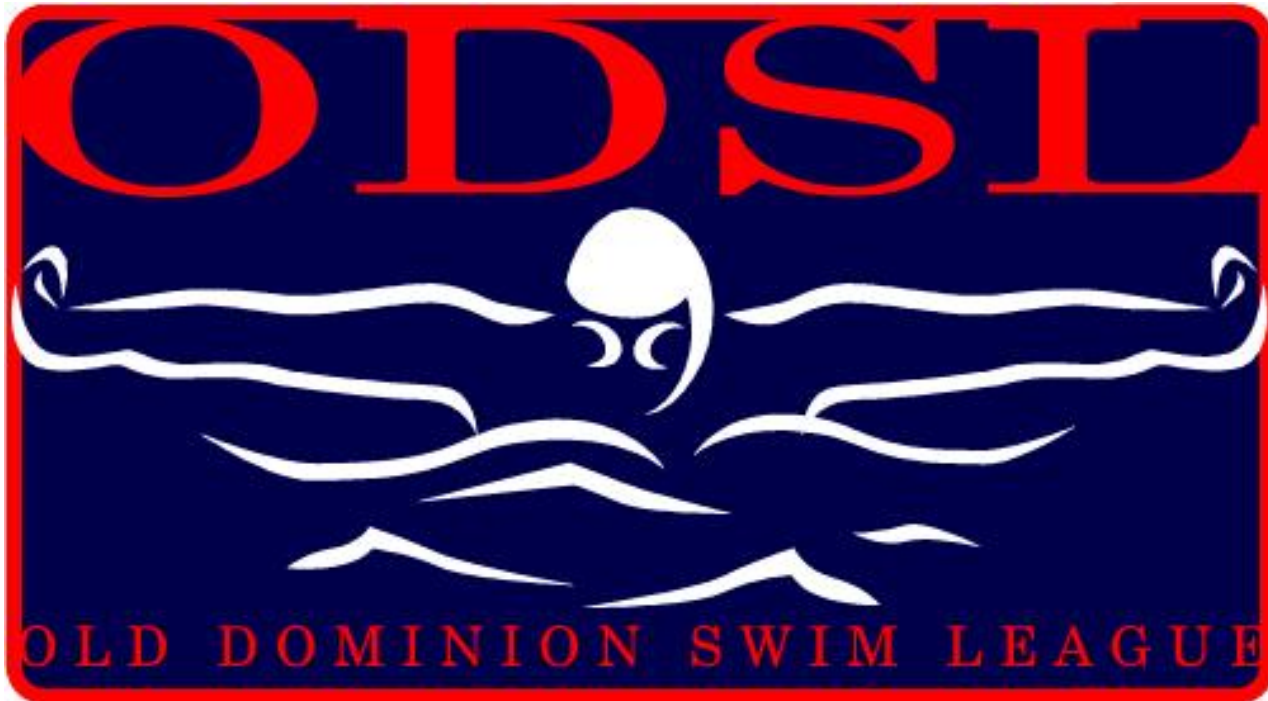

Typical dual meet ribbon count



A typical meet accounts for 52 individual event where a 1st thru 6th place ribbon would be achievable. (Of which the IM

accounts for 8 events)
52 → 1st // 52 → 2nd // 52 → 3rd // 52 → 4th // 52 → 5th 52 → 6th //



Followed by 12 events of team relays with 6 potential lanes of 4 swimmers

48 → 1st // 48 → 2nd // 48 → 3rd // 48 → 4th // 48 → 5th 48 → 6th //



Totaling 100 ribbons per place per event plus an additional 5 per place to account for ties.

2025 Season Ribbon/Medals Discussion

Current Ribbon Construct

Where the current construct tasks the host team will securing

~~form ODSL the entire package of ribbons for the meet~~

- The current model is based on the host team having the responsibility of the “Hosts” computer operator to print the labels following an adjudication of the DQ Slips.
- Second, a team of volunteers from both the host and the visiting teams place their labels on the ribbons while on the pool deck.
- Whereas, when each team leaves the pool deck, with their labeled ribbons for the meet.

Concerns

Multiple teams have raised concerns on the current model:

- Some teams, lack the ability to print from the pool deck during or at the conclusion of the meet.
- At no fault of the computer operators, due to the time it takes to verify the meet results, the ribbon volunteers are having to remain on-deck for an extended period to complete the ribbons for IM and the relays. Often the ribbon volunteers are the last people to leave the meet.
- Often post meet, there are unexpended issues that are discovered. For instance, that the results didn't account for substitutions during relay, which leads to ribbons being printed for the wrong swimmer.

Proposed Course of Action #1 (Counting ribbons COA)

- The “Host” is still responsible for the final meet results adjudication.
- However, instead of printing the labels, the computer operators will email the PDF of the meet labels separated by team to the Team Reps for distribution to their ribbon volunteers.
- The Host team counts out the number of 1st thru 6th place ribbons as indicated from the computer operators. Where there are three prominent methods to handle this splitting of the un-labeled ribbons. The host obtains a hard number of the quantity of ribbons per team up to the completion of the butterfly events.
 - A. Each team uses their own ribbons for IM and relays.
 - B. Each team estimates the quantity of ribbons that are needed to complete IM and Relays.
 - C. Each teams' ribbon volunteers wait until the computer operators have adjudicated IM and relays. Where at such time they could provide the final number of what is needed to complete the ribbons for IM and relays labels.

Proposed Course of Action #2

(Wider ribbon distribution COA)

- As into COA 1, The “Host” is still responsible for the final meet results adjudication. Additionally, the computer operators will email the PDF of the meet labels separated by team to the Team Reps for distribution to their ribbon volunteers.
- Each team is issued 50% of the ribbons that would be allocated for that meet. Transferring the responsibility of providing the meet ribbons from the host to each participated team. In that teams that do not host would still need to pickup ribbons.
 - Since each team will have their own stockpile of ribbons, their will no need for the ribbon volunteers to remain on the pool deck till the meet results have been adjudicated.
 - Teams will have the opportunity to place the labels at their own convenance.

Proposed Course of Action #3 (Status Quo COA)

The process that was depicted in the current process would remain



Constants

- Initial ribbon pickup will take place from the ODSL storage unit
- At the conclusion of each team's sixth meet, each team will conduct a ribbon inventory and determine if additional ribbons will be needed to complete the year.
- Following the completion the last dual meet of the season, each team will submit an ODSL ribbon survey. This survey will account for you on-hand amount that could be carried over the following ODSL season.

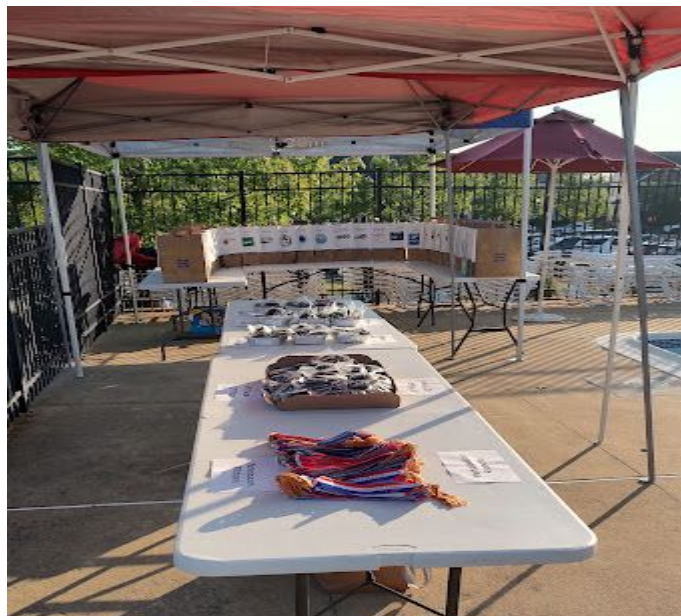


**Divisional/
All-Stars Medals**

Background:

- For the end of season meets for Divisionals and All-Stars, ODSL utilizes medals instead of the ribbons used in dual meets. During the end of season meets, the host team will assign an Awards Lead.
- The Awards Lead will work with the host to generate a plan to conduct the awards process using the information below. During end of season meets, ODSL utilized medals for places 1st thru 12th places and participation awards for all remaining none-medal winning swimmers (excluding DQs).
- With the quantity of awards, it is recommended to have all participating teams to provide 2 volunteers each to complete the awards during the meet.

Options for 2025

- To reuse divisional medals from prior years that do not have the year on the medal (Yes or No)
 - Would require the ribbon/medal committee to sort the medals so that the same style would be able to accounted for within one divisions meet
- For both post season events, continue to have separate medal styles for 1st and third. Then have “one” style for 4th thru 12th or have “unique” medals for 4th thru 12th?
- For all-stars, continue to have the year engraved on the medal or have no engravement and have a lanyard with the year instead?
