Entry Fees: Individual events

Heat & Final \$12.00/event, Timed Final \$10.00/event

Relays \$20.00

Entry Fees are non-refundable after the scratch deadline

Entry Deadline: Monday, January 27, 2020 11:59PM

Deck Entries: Deck Entries will be charged \$20.00/ event for all individual events, Relays \$25.00. All

Deck Entries are exhibition swims, and will not be scored.

Refunds: No refunds for any scratched swimmers after February 16, 2020

Expected Entries:

Maximum of 350 Swimmers and Minimum 275 swimmers

Nose Creek Swim Association reserved 125 swimmers

Entry Procedures:

- All entries to be submitted using Hy-tek through the Swimming Canada online system.
- > All entries must contain the swimmer's name, Swimming Canada swimmer ID and date of birth. If entering from outside of Canada, please email Hy-tek file directly to the meet manager
- > Please enter all events with a time. NT's will not be accepted.





- Swimmers are limited to a maximum of seven individual events, maximum three per preliminary session and one event on Session 1
- Maximum of 3 relays per team per age and gender
- Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system and will be accepted as long as no new heats are created and at Meet Management's discretion.
- Swimmers who have achieved the Alberta Champion time in a given event for their age level (short course and/or long course), may swim preliminaries as exhibition, but are not eligible for Finals.
- When a swimmer's birthday falls between February 27 and March 19 and move up higher age category at the Alberta Champion, he or she is willing to swim higher age category, coaches must notify meet manager at the time of entry with the swimmer's name for all age-up requests.

Time Trial:

➤ Each registered swimmer member is permitted to compete in one individual or relay event. No entry fees are permitted for Time Trials.

Official Sprit Time:

- Official Split time request deadline by 30minutes before start of the session in which the official split is requested. The coaches required to fill "Official Split Request Form.
- ➤ There will be a fee of \$5.00 for each single official split request. The fee is payable to the Clerk of Course at the time of the request.

Age Groups:

Individual events

50m, 100m, 200m, 400m distance events (preliminaries to be senior seeded); Finals to be swum in the following age groups:

• Female: 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 &over, Male: 11&under, 12-13, 14-15, 16 &over

Relay events

Female & Male: 12 & under; 13 & over

Qualifying Times:

Swimmers are able to enter 400IM and 400 freestyle if they are able to swim faster than event qualified time.

MEET INFORMATION

Rules:

- ➤ The meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or WPS rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- > Swimming Canada warm-up procedures will be in effect.





Safe Sport:

All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both "open" and "observable" to others.

Competition and Diving Readiness Standards

➤ Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.

Diving Rules:

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW 4.1.

Meet Format – Timed Final and Preliminary Events

- All preliminaries events will be swum Senior seeded.
- > 400 freestyle and 400IM must limit entries based on the times on due to numbers of entrants.
- 200 Breast, 200 Butterfly, 200 Back events are timed finals
- > Relays: all relay events are timed finals

Meet Format – Finals Sessions

- for Female 10&under and Male 11&under 50m and 100m stroke events and 200Free, 200IM, "A" finals only
- "A" & "B" finals for Female 11-12, 13-14 and 15&over / Male 12-13, 14-15 and 16&over 50m and 100m stroke events
- "A" final only for Female 11-12 and 13-14, 15&over / Male 12-13 and 14-15, 16&over 200 Free and 200IM
- ➤ "B" Finals only if 18 and more qualified swimmers entered in the event

Scratches:

- The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition.
- > Scratches are to be submitted to the clerk of course by the start of the previous night's finals, or before 3:00 pm the day prior to the start of the meet, in order that the preliminary session can be seeded.
- ➤ To make the meet run more efficiently any last minute scratches would be appreciated until Wednesday, February 26, 2020 by 3:00PM. Please notify by e-mail.
- ➤ Late scratches for timed final events and preliminaries: Submit to the Clerk of Course 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. No re-seeding will occur. Meet Management may collapse heats to within an event to optimize meet proceedings.

Scratch Deadline and Penalties for Finals:

- > Scratches are to be submitted to the clerk of course 30 minutes after conclusion of the preliminary session. The conclusion of the preliminary session will be the completion of the final race of the session
- ➤ The Late Scratch Deadline shall be 30 minutes prior to the start of the Finals session. However, there shall be no re-seeding to include scratches made after the initial scratch deadline.
- Scratches received after the late scratch deadline, no-shows, step-downs and unexcused incomplete swims will result in the swimmer(s) being scratched from all remaining events, including relays, scheduled for that day.

Deck Entries:

- Deck Entries will be "Exhibition" only and accepted only if the entry does not create a new heat.
- > They must be submitted no later than the Late Scratch Deadline of that session.





Relays:

- > Provide swimmers name and name changes are to be submitted to the clerk of course 30 minutes after conclusion of the preliminary session.
- Limited to three teams per age group and gender
- > Clubs may be limited to the number of relay teams per relay event based on session time out

Individual Awards:

- All events are awarded according to entry age categories.
- ➤ Individual Awards Ribbons for 1st 8th places for age group Female 12 & Under and Male 13 & Under and Relays Ribbons for 1st 3rd places.

Best Time Awards

- There will be a best time prize table for swimmers achieving one or more best times during session 1, 2 and 4.
- > Draws for prizes for swimmers achieving best time will be conclusion of the session 4.
- ➤ All prizes must be picked up the conclusion of the Competition.
