We are looking forward to welcoming you to our pool on Saturday! In order to ensure a relaxed, fun, and positive atmosphere for all, we ask that you please review and respect a few guidelines:

Your warm-up time will be 7:25-7:45am, and the meet will start at 8:00am.

**Parking:**

Please park in the parking lot adjacent to the pool and parking spots on Riverwalk Blvd and Kendall Crossing. Open spots are first-come, first-served. See the parking lot attendant to assist you with parking. Please do not park on any grass areas.

**Team Areas:**

We have designated three areas for your team to set up (see map below). You may use the grass area next to the lap pool and the two grass areas at each end of the pool. Personal pop-up tents and folding chairs are permitted.

**Volunteers:**

We would appreciate assistance from your team with the following volunteer positions:

- Head Meet Official (HMO) to assist with relays
- Stroke and Turn Judges (4 total, 2 per session)
- Timers (12 total, 6 per session)
- Ready Bench (4 total, 2 per session)

The times of all volunteer meetings will be announced on deck prior to the meet. Please have all Stroke and Turn Judges and Timers (both sessions) attend the meetings to receive instructions for the meet.

**Ready Bench Information:**

The ready bench entrance is located at the grassy area adjacent to the pool. Please ask your swimmers to have their last names, along with team initials, written on their shoulders. We also suggest that swimmers write all Events, Heats, Lanes, and Strokes on their forearms. This information is very important, especially for the younger swimmers, and helps the Ready Bench significantly.

**Concessions:**

We will have two food trucks available during the meet, Moos Coffee Truck and Rolling Dough. They will be located in the circle part of the parking lot.

**\*\*Please bring lots of water and sports drinks for your swimmers to stay hydrated throughout the meet!\*\***

**Heat Winners:** All heat winners can take their ribbon to the designated table for a free ice-pop!

**Restrooms:**

Restrooms are located near the entrance of the pool, they are on the left side down the path as you walk in.

**Photography area:**

There is NO photography allowed from behind the blocks—at both ends of the pool. You can take pictures of your swimmer on either side of the pool.

**Additional Information**

The family pool is only available to residents not participating in the swim meet. Please keep your swimmers out of this pool. There are showers on deck or in the restrooms for cooling off.

Additionally, the flying of any drone, remote-controlled aircraft, or similar item is prohibited.

**Have FUN!**

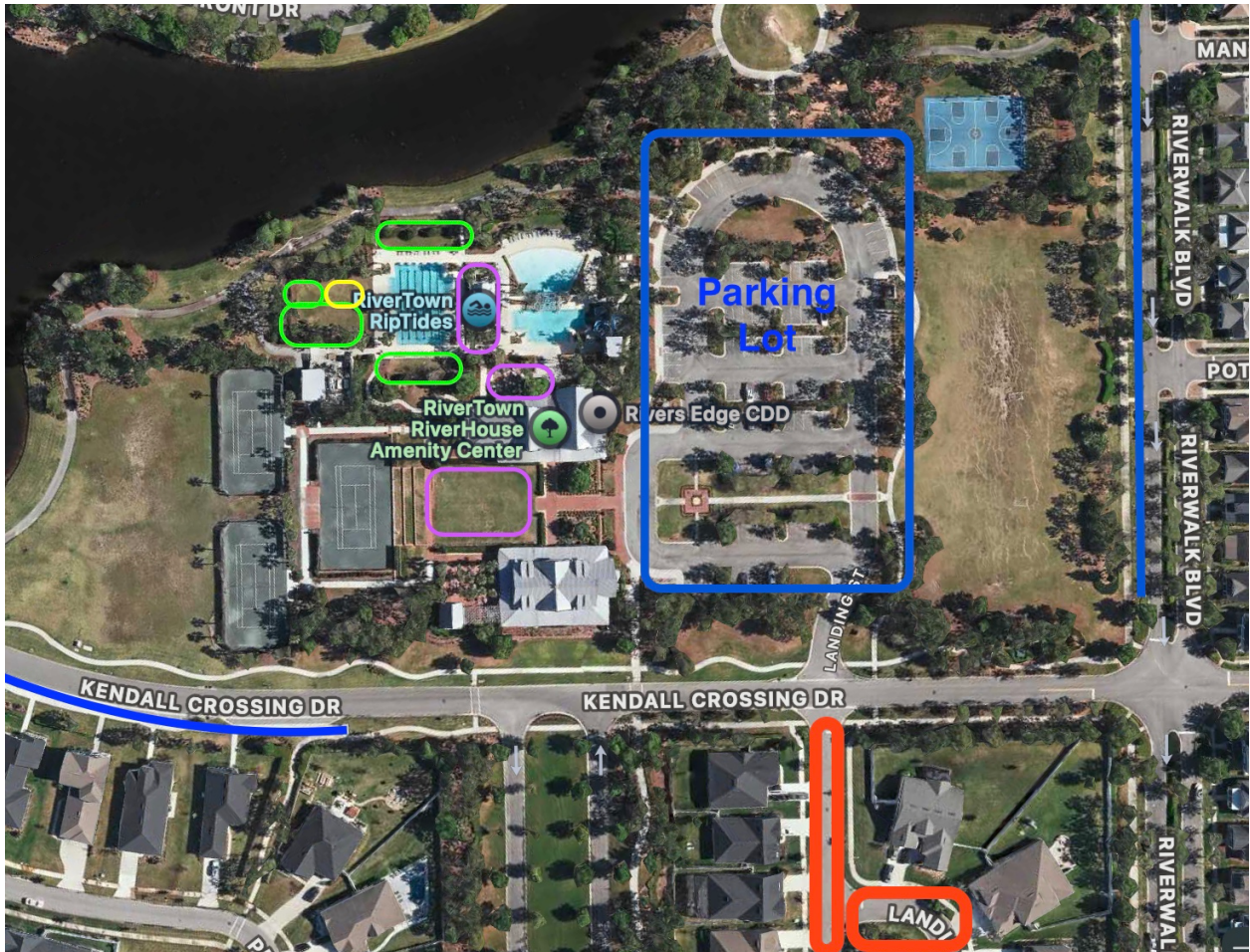
Please cheer for all swimmers, especially those who struggle. We are a recreational league and want our meets to be enjoyable and for every swimmer to feel accomplished!
