



SOFIE DAVIS “ALL IN” LOVETTSTVILLE DOLPHINS AWARD

Recognizing Athletic and Academic
Excellence



The Sofie Davis “All In” Lovettsville Dolphins Award was created to recognize Athletic and Academic excellence and to encourage 15-18 age group swimmers to achieve excellence in both academics and athletics.

DETAILS

Presented to a deserving Lovettsville Dolphins High School Junior or Senior. The Award will consist of a \$1,000.00 college scholarship and a trophy commemorating the Dolphin’s achievement.

REQUIREMENTS

Minimum of 3.5 GPA (unweighted) in High School (or Homeschool certified equivalent) and at least One ODSL All Star qualifying time.

Academic transcripts must be submitted directly to the Board (board@lovettsvilledolphins.org) for review and approval. Coaches, Lovettsville Dolphin’s Board and the Davis family will review the candidates and select the most qualified applicant for the award. Awardee chosen will have a combination of academics and athletics and again, the MOST QUALIFIED applicant will receive the award.

If no Dolphin meets the minimum requirements, there will be no award presented for the year.

This award is being established to emphasize the importance





of excelling in both academics and athletics, as well as to encourage the 15-18 age group swimmers to continue to compete for the Dolphins.



Sofie Davis began swimming for the Lovettsville Dolphins at age 6. In her 12 seasons with the Dolphins, she won numerous ODSL All-Star Championships and set multiple Dolphin and ODSL records. She is undoubtedly one of the top swimmers to be produced by the ODSL since its inception.

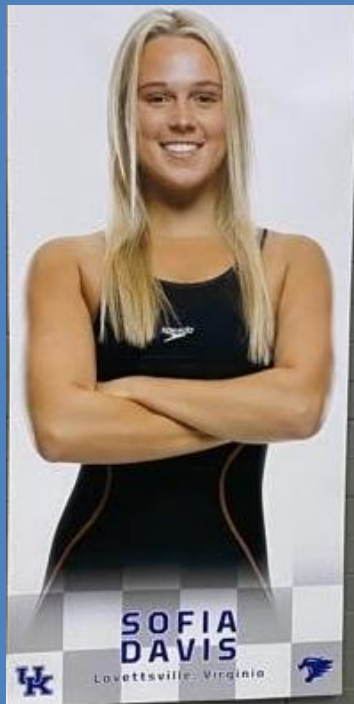
As a club swimmer for SNOW, The FISH and NCAP, Sofie was a:

- *Potomac Valley Swimming (PVS) Athlete of the Year, and a multiple PVS Junior Olympic Champion and record holder.
- *Winner of multiple Virginia State Long Course Championships.
- *PVS Zone Team member at age 9 and medalist.
- *USA Swimming Junior National qualifier, NCSA qualifier and finalist

As a High School swimmer for the Madeira School (McLean, VA) Sofie was a:

- *Multiple Madeira School relay and individual record holder (Graduated with a Perfect 4.0 unweighted GPA)
- *Multiple individual Washington Independent School League (ISL) Champion.
- *Washington Metropolitan Prep School Swim Dive League (WMPSSDL) Champion.
- *Washington Post All-Met.
- *Virginia Independent School Athletic Association (VISAA) All-State.
- *VISAA Individual State Champion, Team Champion and VISAA record holder.
- *NISCA ALL AMERICA and a USA SWIMMING SCHOLASTIC ALL AMERICA (combination of at least 3.5 GPA and a USA SWIMMING JUNIOR NATIONAL Qualifying time).





NCAA career:

*Sofie committed to the University of Kentucky (Member of the Southeastern Conference/ SEC) in September of 2018 (her Junior year).

*Sofie has lettered three times for Wildcats while also garnering three Academic All SEC selections.

*Kentucky Women's Swimming and Diving has finished ranked 8th, 13th and 19th in the country in Sofie's three years on the team, finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the SEC as well.

*Two-time recipient of the Bob Bradley Scholarship Award (4.0 GPA), Academic All-SEC honors for 2020-2021, and Kentucky Swimming and Diving Booster Club Award for best "All Around" teammate.

*Sofie graduated Summa Cum Laude this year.

*She served as a Team Captain and was again named Academic All-SEC and received the Scholar-Athlete Award at the "CATSPYs". Additionally, she was inducted into the prestigious Frank G. Ham Society of Character. The Society of Character annually honors Wildcats who have shown an extraordinary commitment to academic excellence, athletic participation, personal development, career preparation and serving as a role model. The SOC was founded during the 1998-99 school year and is named for Ham, a longtime UK administrator.

We sincerely hope this award will contribute to the overall success of the Lovettsville Dolphins Swim Team, the ODSL and will celebrate the legacy and achievements of our daughter. And we also hope that it will inspire young girls and boys in our part of Western Loudoun to work hard and dream big.
