Warm-Up Lane assignments will be provided based on entries.

Friday: Heating will be provided for Events 1-4 (400s). Swimmers will be expected to report to the heating area in a timely manner prior to their event. Heating will be provided for Events 5-40. Swimmers will be expected to report to the heating area shortly after First Call for their event.

Saturday: Heating will be provided. Swimmers will be expected to report to the heating area shortly after the First Call for their event.

Coaches/Parents: Please provide assistance with your younger age group relays.

Eligibility:

1. Only invited teams may participate.
2. Only swimmers that satisfy the Eligibility and Exclusion requirements of the Colorado State Summer Club Swimming Association Bylaws Article VI, Section I may compete in this meet.
3. Each team must assure that all of their swimmers have adequate medical/accident insurance and that all coaches have adequate liability coverage.

Rules:

1. A swimmer may compete in a total of 3 individual and 2 relay events.
2. The Colorado State Summer Club Swimming Association Competition Rules and Meet Guidelines will govern the competition.
3. Submit short course METER times only.
4. **No Exhibition** swimming allowed.
5. CASO officials will facilitate the meet.
6. Two Dolphin watches and one manual watch will be used with a minimum of 2 timers per lane. The Meet Committee shall make final decision on any disputed place or time.
7. Protests shall be presented in writing to the Meet Coordinator within 30 minutes after the conclusion/result posting of the protested event. Protests must come from the swimmer's Coach.
8. The Meet Committee shall consist of the Meet Referee, Meet Coordinator, and a Coach not affected by the dispute/protest.
9. Per Colorado State Summer Club regulations, year round swimmers can not compete at the Ken Caryl Invitational swim meet.

Events: All events are Timed Finals. Swimmers shall swim in their assigned heat and lane. Changes will only be made by the Meet Coordinator.

Scoring: 12 Places
Individual Events: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1
Relays Events: 32-26-24-22-20-18-14-10-8-6-4-2
All Team Relays may score.

Awards: Individual Events: 1-6 Medals, 7-12 Ribbons.
Relay Events: 1-3 Medals, 4-6 Ribbons.
High Point: 1st in each age group girls and boys.
Team: Trophies 1st, 2nd and 3rd place Team.
Spirit Award: 1st place Team.
Each Team will receive 1 Spirit vote to be turned in the end of the Event
100.

Entry Fee: \$50.00 per Team plus
\$3.00 per each Individual Event entry
\$8.00 per each Relay Event entry

Payment for 2018: Please arrange to **hand deliver your check** made payable to KCSC on Friday to the Meet Coordinator when you pick up your meet packet. If other arrangements are necessary, you must receive approval from the Meet Coordinator prior to the start of the meet.

Tent Set Up: If you plan to set up a team tent for this meet, set up begins no earlier than **10 am Friday** on a first-come, first-serve basis. All team tents must be set up outside the gated area.

Entry Deadline: All entry material must be in the hands of the Entry Chair by 5pm, Sunday, June 17, 2018.

Once all entries are received on June 17, 2018, a psyche sheet will be emailed to all coaches. Once the psyche sheets have been published, NO changes to entries can be made with the exception of scratches.
