Loan is starting to process for need resurfacing and work at the pool

Indian Valley charging \$750 in January and \$800 thereafter
Scottsdale: new families \$650, others \$800
Woodlands: \$500 in 2020; new families \$200

For RSM: recommendation for new families charge \$800; \$750 for returning; everyone up to \$800 in 2022; hard to welcome new families in if no space on swim team and we don't have numbers on that yet; families in 2020 paid \$700 for 2020 and 2021 (buy one, get one free); another recommendation to follow the Indian Valley Model of "early bird" registration at lower price; concern about perception about price increase for 2021

Recommendation to raise fees to prospectively be \$800 beginning in 2022, but discount to 2021 in \$750. Raise maintenance fee to \$200. Use sign up genius for people to sign up to do the first maintenance day and then having a running list of projects and maintenance/non-maintenance skills. Jessica move, Nicole second. Passed unanimously.

Potentially enable opening the snack shack on weekends to work off hours and bring in extra money

Make a survey of the needed skillsets of members to use in addition to random maintenance days. Ryley to take the lead on this
