Friday Night Set Up

If desired, you may set up in the RSM team area on Friday between 6 - 7 pm.

Please wait in line at the gate by the diving pool for the gates to open. As there is limited space in the team area, wait until the team pop ups are set up before putting up your own. The gates will be locked each night but leaving items overnight is at your own risk.

Programs are available for purchase on Friday night as well.

RSM Team Area

Meet Programs

This is an invitational meet. As such, heat and lane sheets will not be posted online and instead, programs will be available to purchase at the meet (and after 6pm on Friday). Individual entries will be posted on the RSM website.

I would highly recommend bringing cash for your program on Friday night. This way you can mark your swimmers ahead of time.

Jobs

All families who participate in invitational meets are required to work at least one shift per meet. This is on top of regular season jobs. Look for a separate email to sign up.

If you are unable to cover your job, you must find your own sub or swap with another family. No-show timers cause meet delays and will be charged a fee.

If you are an On Call Substitute, you will be contacted if needed so be at the meet and ready to fill a timing seat.

Warm Ups

RSM is scheduled both Saturday and Sunday 8:10 - 8:30am lanes 1, 2, 3 and 4 warm-up lane 1

Touch Pads

Tell your swimmer about TOUCHPADS! Things to remember - push firmly against the face of the touchpad as you finish your race to ensure your time is accurately captured. Backstroke swimmers, be especially careful to strike the face of the touchpad at the finish.

Clerk of the Course

All swimmers will be required to check into the Clerk of the Course prior to their races. Please mark (with a permanent marker!) your 6&Us and 7&8s swimmers with last name, initial first name, age, event, heat and lane on left shoulder/back.

Where do I find my younger swimmer after the race?

When finished with their races, all swimmers exit near the warm up area / diving pool (near our team area). You can meet your young swimmers at the pool exit. Prep your younger swimmers ahead of time for this because you will not be able to get in to the pool area where the timers are located. All parents are required to wait outside the fence.

Relays

For relays, it is recommended that swimmers gather as a group at our RSM team area and walk to the Clerk of the Course together.

Parking

There is plenty of free parking available near the baseball and soccer fields or along the streets for this event.

If you would like to park in the lot, passes will be sold by Walnut Creek Swim Club- it is first come first serve: these will be available on Friday 6/21 Click on the All City tab on Walnut Creek swim club team's homepage.
