Session 1 will feature 12 & Under and start at 7:00 am.

Session 2 will feature 13 & Up and start at 7:30 pm.

Invitational Meet:

This meet is for the individual swimmer. There will be no scoring. The meet will follow the Northwest Swim Circuit order of events.

Medley and Freestyle relays will be conducted at their normal event numbers. Each team will put together as many relays as possible from their pool of Invitational Qualifiers. Relays will follow the NWSC bylaws will be eligible for awards.

CHECK-IN TIMELINE/PROCEDURES:

- **5:15 - SETUP CREW** arrives and begins setup
- **5:45 - SWIMMERS & PARENT VOLUNTEERS** check-in together.
 - Swimmers will not be permitted to check-in without a parent volunteer present.
 - Check-in table volunteers must verify that all needed volunteers and swimmers are present before they will check your swimmer in for the meet.
 - Swimmers then head immediately to their age group tent to allow tent parents time to prepare your child to swim.
 - Please let the tent parents know your child has arrived at the tent before you leave the area.
- **6:15 - SWIMMER SCRATCH DEADLINE** Any swimmer not checked-in at the table by check-in volunteers will be scratched (removed) from the meet at this time. That means they will not be swimming, no exceptions.

POOL INFORMATION:

Warm Up Pool:

The basic rules are:

- As long as the swimmers are swimming in the warm up pool, that's ok (unless the monitors see that the pool has gotten too crowded).
- The swimmers should only use the steps to get into the warm up pool. Entering the pool over the sides of the coping is prohibited.
- Sitting on the steps is not allowed.
- The monitors should contact their meet directors if there are any issues with the warm up pool.
- Also for the safety of our swimmers and to decrease the amount of chaos we will limit traffic behind the blocks to swimmers, timers, and officials only.
- We will not restrict access to the swimmers, nor restrict swimmers from accessing their parents during the meet.

PARKING:

- There is plenty of parking. As always please observe all laws and regulations regarding fire hydrants, painted curbs and so on. Please stay out of the grass and any other no parking zones.

OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS:

Location and Rules:

- The meet will be located at the Micki Krebsbach pool at 301 Deepwood Drive, Round Rock, TX
- Setup for teams will be available on **Sunday 5:15am** for session 1. There will be a loading area at the southwest corner of the pool next to the dumpster for each team to drop off their tents.
- Per NWSC's contract with the City of Round Rock, **the sand volleyball pit and kiddie pool are off limits.** Please remind your swimmers of this restriction. We have asked our coaches and pit/tent parents to help enforce this rule.

Shift Change:

- There will be a shift change in Session 1 only, between event 45 and 46..
- Also for the safety of our swimmers and to decrease the amount of chaos we will limit traffic behind the blocks to swimmers, timers, and officials only.
- We will not restrict access to the swimmers, nor restrict swimmers from accessing their parents during the meet.

Spectators:

- Spectators may observe the meet from the west side of the pool.
- Spectators may not set up tents or chairs within the pool area. Please use the area around the outside of the pool for spectator seating.

- The area outside the pool that is marked “Awards Ceremony” is available for spectator tents during the meet. We ask that any tents be taken down at the end of the meet for the awards ceremony.

Concessions:

- Concessions will include the regular fare and plenty of ice cold beverages.

Cell Phones/Photography:

- Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, including Cell Phones, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including any spectator area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms. Any suspected violation of this policy will be subject to investigation at the discretion of the Meet Director and may result in disciplinary action including without limitation, removal from the meet.

Drones:

- The use of drones is strictly prohibited at all times during the meet.

Weather:

- Since this is an outdoor pool, we may have to deal with unforeseen weather issues. If we have a weather delay that forces us to evacuate the pool, I will ask that all participants wait in their cars until it clears. If it appears that it will be over a 25-minute delay we will make a decision on whether to wait it out or cancel the remainder of the meet.

Heat Sheets:

- Heat sheets for meet officials will be provided by the NWSC. Each team will provide heat sheets for their coaches for this meet.
- NWSC will not have heat sheets to sell. Please print and bring your own.

Qualifying Times:

- As posted at the beginning of the 2022 swim season.

Deck Entries:

- No Deck Entries will be allowed. Entries are due by *Saturday July 9th at 5pm*.

Event Entries:

- Individual Events: Swimmers may enter up to three individual events in which they have a qualifying time during the 2022 swim season.

Relay Events:

- Swimmers must be a qualified invitational swimmer entered in at least one individual event. Swimmers may enter up to two relay events.

Awards:

- Award ceremony given for First, Second, and Third place. The award ceremony will commence right after the meet outside of the pool under the trees on the north side.
- All other places will receive participation ribbons in recognition of their qualifying achievement given by individual teams at a later date.
