

The Baraboo Riptide Swim Team (www.barabooriptide.com), a member of the 8 team Tri-County Conference located in Baraboo WI (approximately 45 minutes north of Madison), is currently seeking an energetic, engaging and motivated Head Coach. Baraboo Riptide has approximately 120 swimmers ranging in ages from 5-18 years old. These swimmers participate in the team Spring Stroke Clinic and Summer Recreational Swim Team.

Baraboo Riptide is a coach-facilitated, board-directed, parent-volunteer organization that cooperatively works to have swimmers support one another and to grow both physically and emotionally over the summer months. This is done by promoting good sportsmanship and creating an atmosphere of fun and learning in a safe environment. In the end, team members learn a healthy, lifelong skill and become proficient swimmers.

Responsibilities:

- Attend, plan and coordinate practices, providing constant feedback to swimmers and coaches to facilitate improvement
- Develop meet line-ups for 7 summer meets, including the Tri-County Conference Meet
- Hire, manage, motivate and mentor the coaching staff
- Serve as the primary contact person, with Board support, for inquiries from Riptide swimmers, parents, and potential new members
- Set attendance/discipline policies and maintain communication with Riptide families and swimmers (conducting parent meetings as needed)
- Assess team equipment and make recommendations to the Riptide Board
- Develop and maintain professional relationships with other Tri-County swim coaches, sponsors, vendors, and Parks and Recreation or Baraboo School District employees
- Perform other activities and duties to be determined by the Riptide Board

Qualifications:

- College Degree (preferred)
- ASCA or USA Certification (preferred)
- Two years competitive swim coach experience, coaching multiple age groups (preferred)
- Competitive swimming experience (preferred)
- Needs to be energetic, understand the importance of leading by example and able to communicate with parents and other coaches
- Able to clearly communicate proper strokes and techniques, while motivating swimmers to achieve their potential.
- Lifeguard, CPR, First Aid and Safety for Swim Coach certification (preferred)
- Background check
