Warm-Up Groups	Teams will be split into warm-up groups based on the number of entries and announced on Friday, July 19, 2024 by 3:00 pm.
Coaches Meeting	A coaches meeting will be held at the table at 8:00 am. Scratch sheets are due by the coaches meeting.
Eligibility	Swimmers aged fourteen (14) and under as of May 31, 2024 and competing in no more than one (1) individual event at Championships or one (1) relay at Championships are eligible. Diving at Championships counts as an individual event.

Entry Deadline	<p>Entries will be accepted starting on Sunday July 14, 2024.</p> <p>The deadline for submitting entries is Thursday, July 18, 2024 at 12:00 pm.</p> <p>Entry changes and final submissions are due by Friday, July 19, 2024 at 12:00 pm.</p>
Entry Limitations	<p>Swimmers competing at Silver Championships <u>only</u> may enter four (4) total events.</p> <p>Swimmers competing in one (1) individual swimming, diving, or relay event at Championships may enter three (3) total events at Silver</p>

	<p>Championships.</p> <p>Swimmers are not permitted to compete in any event in which they are competing at Championships.</p> <p>There is a limit of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three (3) individual events • Two (2) relay events <p>Entry times are not required for this meet.</p> <p>There is no club limit for the number of swimmers entered per event.</p>
Entry Format	<p>Silver Championships will be run on Meet Manager.</p> <p>Electronic entries in a Hy-Tek Team Manager/Swimtopia entry file submitted via email are required. With your file, include a Team Manager/Swimtopia report by entry.</p> <p>In your email, provide the number of girls, boys, and total entries. Include coach and club representative contact information (name, email address, and phone number).</p> <p>All entries should list the swimmer's best time in an official 2024 ABE Swim League competition and in SCM or a converted time.</p> <p>All entries should be sent to the Meet Contact and Michael Iacobelli - brooksidesilverchamps24@gmail.com AND iacomich@bu.edu</p>

Parking	<p>BROOKSIDE SILVER CHAMPS PARKING MAP SEEN IN APPENDIX</p> <p>The parking lot in front of BCC Pool is reserved for Coaches (3 per team), Officials, and Handicap parking. Handicap parking is available upon request. Please request in advance by contacting the Silver Championships Committee with the name and vehicle information (make/model)</p> <p>The Driveway Loop at the entrance to the pool is reserved for athlete drop-off.</p> <p>The Parking Lot on the other side of the Club is reserved for Golf and non-swim club members.</p> <p>There is NO PARKING along the driveway leading up to the club.</p> <p>Spectators MUST park at Willow Lane Elementary School: 6135 Sauerkraut Lane, Macungie, PA 18062. There will be a shuttle bus to transport spectators to and from this location.</p> <p>We kindly request that families use the shuttle buses as much as possible. The Brookside Club Championship is also this day and we do not want to overwhelm volunteers with traffic.</p> <p>Volunteers will be present to direct vehicles to proper parking locations and drop-off.</p>

Seating	<p>Each team will have a clearly marked area to set up tents and seating based on entries.</p> <p>Please bring your own chairs for seating. Provided space will be limited.</p>
Grounds	<p>Please observe all roped off areas, including the baby pool, which will be closed during the meet.</p>

Facilities	<p>Swimmers participating in the meet will be permitted to utilize the pool house restrooms and changing areas.</p> <p>Access to the main club is not permitted.</p> <p>All Others: Please use the Porta-Potty located just outside the pool entrance.</p>
Volunteers	<p>Each club will need to provide two (2) volunteers at a <u>minimum</u> to assist with running the meet. This may include timers, runners and line-up helpers.</p> <p>Please use this SignUp Genius to provide volunteer information: https://tinyurl.com/SilversSignUp</p>
Food Options	<p>There will be various food options available at the meet. All food options are CASH ONLY. Additionally, our pool bar will be open with a limited drinks menu. This is also CASH ONLY.</p>
