POOL:

- The competition pool will consist of one 25-meter course with 8 lanes.
- All 25M events will start from the deck, all 50M & longer events will start from the blocks.
- Pool available for warm ups/cool down? (Outstanding question to Mason)

RULES:

- The meet will be governed by current United States Swimming Rules except as modified by PPSL Rules.
- Age as of the first day of June will determine eligibility for the meet.
- Ohio Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet. See the section: **Warm-ups** for description of warm-up procedures in this meet.

EVENTS:

- The meet will swim in accordance with the accompanying Schedule of Events.
- All preliminary heats will be swum on Tuesday, and all FINALS heats will be swum on Wednesday.
 - 8&Under Medley Relay is Timed Final event which will be swum Tuesday only.
 - Top 16 and 2 alternatives return to FINALS for all individual events.
 - Top 8 relays return to FINALS for all RELAY events (except for 8&Under Medley Relay)

ENTRY FEES:

\$2 per individual event
\$8 per relay
\$1.50 surcharge per athlete ('officials' fee)

Team entry fees must be paid to the Meet Director, or League Treasurer **at the meet**, payable to PPSL.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS:

- Swimmers shall enter no more than two (2) individual events. If an entry is submitted with an individual entered in more events than this rule allows, the entry will be made by order of events starting with event #10 until the rule is satisfied.
- All participants must be current members of their Club, and must have participated in at least two dual meets during the regular season.
- Swimmers who participate in "B" Swimming Finals may not participate in this meet.
- Late entries or phone entries will not be accepted.
- **Relay athletes AND alternates must be declared in the Relay entry to be eligible to compete on that relay. Alternates may swim in Prelims or Finals sessions (new in 2021)**

ENTRY INFORMATION:

 - Please include the following in the subject: "PPSL *teamname*".
- Teams should submit entries electronically, using Team software of your choice. Team Manager Lite is free and found on hy-tek.com under Downloads.
- Relays must be entered using actual times.
 - A copy of current year's Top Times **RELAY** Report with 1 Relay time for each event must be included/attached.
- Relay athletes AND alternates must be included with entries. Alternates are included when you include up to 8 athletes in the relay entry. Relay ONLY athletes are allowed.
- **NT entries will NOT be accepted.** Please estimate a time!
- All entries will be confirmed by email to the distribution list of the email with entries. It is the senders' responsibility to review that report and reply with any errors.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

- Entries will be submitted electronically and must be **submitted by 6 pm. Friday, July 9, 2021.**
- **No entries will be accepted after the entry deadline.**

Team Spirit Award: (new procedure 2021!)

Awarded based on votes at Finals session. 1 Head Coach of each team may vote for 1 team – NOT their own. Please come to the Scoring table to vote

SCORING:

MEET MARSHALS:

Marshals have authority through the Meet Director over warm-ups. A swimmer and/or coach may be removed from the deck for non-compliance with warm-up procedures.

COACHES:

- There will be a coaches meeting at 1:00 on Tuesday morning next to the scorer's table. One coach from each team should attend.

CONCESSIONS/FACILITIES:

- Concessions will be provided and are available to everyone. Hospitality for coaches and officials will be available in the Hospitality Room.
- NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- The team areas outside the natatorium will open to the public 60 minutes prior to the start of the warm-up session.
- No towels, bags or personal belongings may be left in the facility between prelims and finals.
- Limited seating is available in the bleachers and will be assigned by section to each team. Teams are expected to share the assigned space to them. This will be monitored by Marshalls and your cooperation is appreciated.
- No coolers or glass containers are permitted in the natatorium. Swimmers' bags are not permitted in the spectator seating.
- For your safety and the safety of others exit aisles and exits must remain clear at all times.
- Limited handicap seating is available. Please note that there will not be space for family to accompany guests in the handicap area.
- NO outside camp space is available.
- Team space: there will be assigned sections for swimmers and their fans in the HS Common area adjacent to the Natatorium.
 - Teams are expected to keep their area clean during and after the meet.
 - Chairs/coolers/bags ARE allowed in this area
- NATATORIUM SEATING
 - Teams are assigned bleacher seating by section (separate attachment). It is expected that teams SHARE their space with their team fans and family. Please do NOT assume that empty seats in another team's area are available for your use.
 - LIMITED handicap spaces are available.
 - There is NOT space for chairs in the Natatorium. Limited standing space is available at the top of the bleachers.
 - Each team is expected to communicate this information to their team including all guests!

PARKING:

CONDUCT RULES:

- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.

CLERK OF COURSE/ SWIMMER CONDUCT:

- There will be a clerk of course **for the preliminary session** for swimmers 8 & under. Swimmers 9 & over should report directly to the starting blocks for their events.
- All swimmers are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. It is the responsibility of all parents to ensure all minor participants/spectators are well behaved and under supervision at all times. Any swimmer acting in an inappropriate manner will be reported to their coach. If the swimmer is reported a second time, they will be banned from participating for the remainder of the meet.
- There is NO team parading permitted on the pool deck or parking lot.

The Meet will not start until all clubs' volunteers are present.

OFFICIALS:

- Qualified_officials are needed for all sessions (Tuesday Prelims (afternoon & evening), and Wednesday evening's Finals).
- A qualified official is one certified by USA, Y, or the OHSAA swimming, or who is an extremely experienced PPSL official.
- Each club representative is expected to provide the following: Officials' names, email address and certification information, emailed to Bartley Jutze (bartley@jkcpafirm.com) by July 2, 2021

TIMERS:

Timing responsibilities are assigned to all member clubs for EACH of the 3 meet sessions. The top 2 scoring clubs from the previous year will time BOTH halves.

- Each club must provide TWO timers for each lane, with stop watches.
- The sessions will be split in two halves changing after BACKSTROKE events.

WARM-UPS:

- Ohio Swimming Warm up Procedures will be followed. Swimmers must enter the water feet first from the edge of the pool with one hand in contact with the deck. Hanging on the bulkhead is prohibited.
- Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session.
- Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up period and DRY OFF to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during the warm-up session.
- Backstroke swimmers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks, and they must enter the pool feet first. Swimmers shall not step up on the blocks if there is a backstroke swimmer waiting to start.
- Warm-ups will be split into 3 sessions as listed below (added Sprint session @ Finals)
