POOL:

- The competition pool will consist of two 25-meter course with 9 lanes each pool.
- 8 lanes, one pool will be used for competition.
- All 25M events will start from starting blocks on the bulkhead.
- All 50M & longer events will start from starting blocks on deck.
- The 2nd pool is available for warmups/cool down.

COMPETITION RULES:

- The meet will be governed by current United States Swimming Rules except as modified by PPSL Rules.
- Age as of the first day of June will determine eligibility for the meet.
- Ohio Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet. See the section: **Warm-ups** for description of warm-up procedures in this meet.

EVENTS:

The meet will swim in accordance with the accompanying Schedule of Events.

All preliminary heats will be swum on Tuesday, and all FINALS heats will be swum on Wednesday.

- 8&Under Medley Relay is Timed Final event which will be swum Tuesday only.
- Top 16 and 2 alternatives return to FINALS for all individual events.
- Top 8 relays return to FINALS for all RELAY events (except for 8&Under Medley Relay)

SWIMMER CONDUCT:

- All swimmers are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. It is the responsibility of all parents to ensure all minor participants/spectators are well behaved and under supervision at all times. Any swimmer acting in an inappropriate manner will be reported to their coach. If the swimmer is reported a second time, they will be banned from participating for the remainder of the meet.
- There is NO team parading permitted on the pool deck or parking lot.
- No PPSL guests or participants may access the outdoor Rec Pool.

MEET MARSHALS:

- Marshals have authority through the Meet Director over warm-ups, warm down pool, deck, and clear aisles during the meet.
- A swimmer and/or coach may be removed from the deck for non-compliance with procedures.

CONDUCT RULES:

- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.
- Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

STAGING:

- ALL 25s: report to Bulkhead Stagers for entry to block.
- ALL 8&U events: each team will be authorized for 2 members, with appropriate deck pass, to escort 8&Under swimmers to the blocks.
- All other events: Swimmers are to report to their blocks.

FINALRESULTS:

Individual Events: Medals 1st – 3rd place, Ribbons 4th – 16th place

Relays: Medals 1st – 3rd place, Ribbons 4th – 16th place

- Plaques for Most Improved Team determined by % point change vs. previous year
- Team Spirit Award

TEAM SPIRIT AWARD (*updated 2022!*):

- Team 'shout out' cheers of 30 seconds or less will be conducted upon roll call per the Final Schedule below. (*new 2022*)
- Awarded based on votes at Finals session. 1 Head Coach of each team may vote for 1 team (NOT their own). Please come to the Scoring table to vote.
- **NO Team PARADES** permitted in the lot or pool. A team parade will disqualify that team from the spirit award.

ENTRY FEES:

\$2 per individual event

\$8 per relay

\$1.50 surcharge per athlete ('officials' fee)

Team entry fees must be paid to the Meet Director, or League Treasurer **at the meet**, payable to PPSL.

ENTRY RULES:

- Swimmers shall enter no more than two (2) individual events. If an entry is submitted with an individual entered in more events than this rule allows, the entry will be made by order of events starting with event #11 until the rule is satisfied.
- All participants must be current FAMILY Swim members of their Club and must have participated in at least two dual meets during the regular season. Please refer to complete rules in PPSL League Rules document.
- Swimmers who participate in "B" Swimming Finals may not participate in this meet (including relays).
- Late entries or phone entries will not be accepted.
- Relay athletes AND alternates must be declared in the Relay entry to be eligible to compete on that relay. Alternates may swim in Prelims or Finals sessions (**new in 2021**)

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Entry file should be e-mailed to Lisa Habel: lisa.habel1@gmail.com Please include the following in the subject: "PPSL team name".
- Teams should submit entries electronically, using Team software of your choice. Team Manager Lite is free and found on hy-tek.com under Downloads.
- Relays must be entered using actual times.
- A copy of current year's Top Times **RELAY** Report with 1 Relay time for each event must be included/attached with electronic submission.
- Relay athletes **AND eligible alternates must be included** with relay entries. Alternates are included when you include up to 8 athletes in the relay entry. Relay ONLY athletes (athletes without individual entries) are allowed but must be listed and may not have participated in Eastside/Westside Finals.
- **NT entries will NOT be accepted.** Please estimate a time!
- All entries will be confirmed by email to the distribution list of the email with entries. It is the senders' responsibility to review that report and reply with any errors as well as address any entry exceptions as identified by the Entry Chair.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

- Entries will be submitted electronically and must be **submitted by 6 pm. Friday, July 8, 2022.** • **No entries will be accepted after the entry deadline.**
- A psych sheet will be posted on the Cincinnati Marlins website when entries are complete: www.cincy-marlins.com

CONCESSIONS/FACILITIES:

- Concessions will be provided and are available to everyone.
- Hospitality for coaches and officials will be available in the Hospitality Room.
- NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- No towels, bags or personal belongings may be left in or outside the facility between prelims and finals.
- For your safety and the safety of others exit aisles and exits must remain clear at all times.
- The team areas outside the natatorium will open to the public 60 minutes prior to the start of the warm-up session.
- Outside camp space is available. Team areas must be cleared and cleaned at the end of each day.
- Aisles should be be clear at all times.

Each team is expected to communicate this information to their team including all guests!

INDOOR SEATING:

- Bleacher Seating for athletes and coaches is available on deck. Seating is assigned per team
- Teams are assigned bleacher spectator seating by section (separate attachment). It is expected that teams SHARE their space with their team fans and family. Please do NOT assume that empty seats in another team's area are available for your use.
- Limited handicap seating is available. Please note that there may not be space for family to accompany guests in the handicap area.
- No coolers, chairs, or glass containers are permitted in the natatorium.
- Swimmers' bags are permitted in the athlete seating only.
- Aisles must be clear at all times.

OFFICIALS:

- Qualified officials are needed for all sessions: Tuesday Prelims (afternoon & evening), and Wednesday evening's Finals.
- A qualified official is one certified by USA, Y, or the OHSAA swimming, or who is an extremely experienced PPSL official.
- Each club representative is expected to provide the following: Officials' names, email address and certification information, emailed to the Meet Official (see contact above) by July 8, 2022

TIMING ASSIGNMENTS: (assignments rotate annually, top 2 previous finishers time both halves)

- Timing responsibilities are assigned to all member clubs for EACH of the 3 meet sessions.
- Each club must provide TWO timers for each lane, with stop watches.

WARM-UPS: (assignments rotated right annually)

- Ohio Swimming Warm Up Procedures will be followed. Swimmers must enter the water feet first from the edge of the pool with one hand in contact with the deck. Hanging on the bulkhead is prohibited.
- Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session.
- Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up period and DRY OFF to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during the warm-up session.
- Backstroke swimmers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks, and they must enter the pool feet first. Swimmers shall not step up on the blocks if there is a backstroke swimmer waiting to start.
