Facility Info:	The competition pool is 6 lanes, 25 meters. The meet will be run with a 3 timer button system in conjunction with Swimtopia's Meet Maestro. The starting blocks are in the deep end of the pool. The depth at the starting blocks is 6 feet and the depth at the turn end is 4 feet. There is no warm down pool. There is adequate parking available at the facility. Teams are asked to follow signs posted by the Bernardsville staff.		
General Meeting:	A General Meeting will be held at the prior to the start of the meet. It is mandatory that all Coaches are in attendance and aware of all information presented at this meeting. The general meeting will consist of the coaches meeting and scratch meeting.

Scoring:	No team scoring
Awards:	- Awards shall be based on times only and shall be given for individual events and relays. - Individuals – Medals for 1st through 6th place and ribbons for 7th through 12th place. - Relays – Medals for 1st through 3rd place with only the A relay team medaling.
Starts:	'Fly-over/Over-the-top' starts will NOT be used during this meet. - At the discretion of the Championship Committee, this may be changed, and breaks added to the timeline, once a given session has been seeded.
Admissions and Programs:	- There will be a \$2 charge for admission to the facility for adults only. - Event programs will be available for sale. Please do not print heat sheets for your own team.
Concessions:	At their discretion, Bernardsville may provide concessions where food and beverages may be purchased throughout the competition.
Vendor:	A t-shirt vendor will be at the meet making MOC shirts
Entry Info:	- Entries will be acknowledged within 48 hours of receipt. - All entries will be accepted until the entry deadline. - Team entries will be considered accepted when the Meet Director accepts the entries. - Entries will be done using Swimtopia on team websites for each meet. Entries must be "locked out for changes" by Thursday July 25th at 9:00PM.
Entry Times:	- Morris County Summer Swim League does not allow 'NT' or 'No Time' to be used as an entry time. - All entry times must be in short course meters. Converted times are permitted.
Relays:	- Relay names must be submitted via Swimtopia's meet entry program. - Coaches may change relay names up until the start of the heat. - Teams may enter an A and B relay (only A relay may place)
Swimmer Eligibility:	- Swimmers must have competed in at least three (3) regular season dual meets. - Verification of athletes shall be done using Swimtopia's Meet Maestro Splash Sheet - For verification questions please reach out to Brendan Tierney (btierney@morriscountysummerswimleague.org)
Adaptive Provisions:	USA Swimming rules and regulations provides "guidelines for officiating swimmers with disabilities" and any athlete who needs any of these adaptations should provide the Referee with a note stating their name, their specific need, and a list of events in which they need assistance prior to the start of each session's competition. If necessary, this information may be provided by the swimmer's coach or guardians. MCSSL will provide all swimmers with disabilities a chance to swim in events for which they have qualified.
Host Club Responsibilities:	- The Meet Director will in conjunction with the host team e-mail entry verification back to the participating clubs. - The MD will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. - The MD will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. - Warm-up schedules and assignments, and timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs and posted on the league website no later than 3 days before the meet.
Participating Club Responsibilities:	- Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs 3 days prior to the meet. - Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck except for timing assignments. - Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible.
Officials:	- Swimming officials from participating teams should contact the Meet Referee (see page 1) with the sessions when they are able to help. - For current USA or YMCA Swimming Officials cards may be checked for deck assignment purposes. - Officials must be USA or YMCA certified. - All officials must wear the standard white and blue uniform. - Officials will be required to work the entire session.

Meet Format Waiver:	- This meet will be run in accordance to current USA Swimming Rules with adaptations to abide by MCSSL rules and regulations. - The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the Championship Committee. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club. Reasons for these changes include: - To allow more swimmers to swim. - To conform to facility capacity limits or for facility safety concerns. - To condense the meet into smaller time frame. - To add a 10-15-minute break after Event #2 and prior to Event #23. - The host club may and at the discretion of the Championship Committee, assuming sufficient time exists for the meet, may fill empty lanes with an additional swimmer from their perspective team. The host club shall only be permitted to fill lanes after all qualified entries have been submitted and the seeding has been completed. Empty lanes may be filled up until the start of the first heat.
Warm-up Procedures:	- Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming's Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. Warm-ups will include general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes. - Swimming Equipment is not allowed in the competition pool during all warm-up sessions. This includes kick boards, hand paddles, and pull buoys. - All swimmers are entitled to a fair and comparable warm-up. All teams must receive the same opportunities for warm-up lanes. - All general warm-up lanes will swim in a counterclockwise direction. - Depending on entries warm-ups may be one general warm-up followed by sprints/starts or multiple warm-ups assigned by teams. - A complete warm-up schedule will be developed once entries have been received and processed. The schedule will be e-mailed to coaches of participating teams a week before the meet.
Check-In:	- This meet will be pre-seeded with NO deck entries - During the General Meeting, a coach may replace a scratched swimmer with another swimmer from their team, provided that the replacement swimmer abides by the eligibility rules and entry limits. The swimmers entered will have the attribute "Bonus" designated with a B next to their name.
Conduct:	Proper conduct at all times will be enforced by coaches, parents, meet marshals, League Commissioners, and the Meet Director. Any athlete found in restricted areas or acting improperly will be barred from further competition.

USA-S Drone Policy Statement:	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
