**Meet Workers:** Each team is responsible for filling their positions for the duration of the meet (all sessions). All meet workers must sign in at the front desk. Deck passes will be distributed at the coaches' meeting.

**Worker Notes:** Head Timer and Timers - Please furnish 2 stop watches per lane. There will be none available at the AAC.  
 Deck Control - Only allow non-swimmers with proper credentials on deck.  
 Awards - Report to the awards room at the start of each session.  
 Officials - Attire will be navy shorts/slacks/skirts with white polo shirts for all positions.

**Meet Program:** The meet program will be posted on the CSRA Swim League's website on Thursday afternoon, June 27th, as soon as it is available. No meet programs will be available at the AAC. It will also be posted on the Meet Mobile at the start of the meet.

**Note: The final seeding cannot be done until all entries are received by each team. The heat sheet will be posted on the website and emailed to the team reps as early as possible.**

**Warm Up:** Warm ups will follow the schedule above. Lane assignments will be made once the meet has been seeded and the number of swimmers per team/session is determined.

**Note: The all-star meet is extremely crowded! Please ask your families to only attend the session with their swimmers.**

**Order of Events:** We will swim all events in their standard order in the first, second, and third sessions. The event number will be the same as the dual meets (i.e. there will be gaps between event numbers).

**Awards:** Each team is responsible for picking up its awards at the conclusion of the meet (weight room). Unclaimed awards will be left at the AAC.
