FACILITY:	<p>Augusta Aquatics Center 3157 Damascus Road, Augusta, GA. 30909</p> <p>Facility contact (706)261-0424 This facility's competition pool is an 8 lane, 50-meter pool with Colorado Timing System and scoreboard. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The certification is on file with USA Swimming, Inc., and Georgia Swimming, Inc. The pool depth at the start ends equals 7-9 ft and turn end depth equals 7-9 ft. Separate warm-up /warm down lanes will be available.</p>
MEDICAL SUPERVISION:	The Augusta Aquatics Center has a full staff of American Red Cross certified lifeguards trained in using backboards and AEDs. American Red Cross trained Police Officer and Fire Marshal will be on hand. EMT services are available through local 911.

MEET FORMAT:	<p>Standard order of events as set forth by the CSRA Summer Swim league in the by Bylaws ARTICLE III – ALL-STAR MEET.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All events will be in Short Course Yards ● Timed Final Format (TF) ● 10 Lanes will be used for competition. ● Up to 21 Lanes are available for warm up, and will be assigned by Meet Management based on the number of swimmers entered by each team.
EVENT LIMITS:	<p>Swimmers may swim a maximum of 2 individual events and 2 Relays. Each team is permitted to enter 1 girls relay and 1 boys/mixed relay in each age group.</p>
ENTRIES:	<p>At the conclusion of the Divisionals meets, all results from these meets will be combined to determine the top 20 times in each individual event. Any athlete who achieves a top 20 time in an individual event will be automatically entered into the Allstars Meet unless they have previously indicated that they will NOT be competing by submitting an Allstar Scratch. Allstars Scratches will be due the Friday before Divisional meets, on 6/13/2025.</p> <p>Team reps are responsible for emailing a list of scratches to csraswimleague@gmail.com. According to Article II, Section 1, Item 6 of the CSRA Swim League Bylaws, teams that do not submit a scratch list by the deadline will not be permitted to participate in their Divisional meet and, therefore, none of their swimmers will</p>

	<p>qualify for Allstars. Providing a complete and accurate list of Allstar Scratches is the responsibility of each Team Rep. <u>Each team will be notified of all swimmers who qualify for the All Star Meet as soon as possible following the completion of the final divisional meet.</u> <u>Notification of individual swimmers will be the responsibility of the Team Reps.</u></p> <p>Late medical scratches may be accepted at the discretion of Meet Management. These should be communicated as early as possible by contacting csraswimleague@gmail.com with the swimmer's name, age group, team and reason for scratching. Early communication will allow for entry of an alternate swimmer into the vacated event.</p>
<p>RULES:</p>	<p>No Technical Suits or "tie-back" swimsuits may be worn.</p>
<p>USA SWIMMING MEMBER ID'S & SWIMS DATABASE ELIGIBILITY:</p>	<p>As an "Observed Meet", times achieved by USA Swimming members who complete their races in a manner that conforms to USA Swimming rules are eligible for submission to the SWIMS Database.</p> <p>USA Swimming numbers will be entered into <u>Swimtopia</u> by parents or team reps at initial registration or at least 5 days prior to the All Star Meet. Only swimmers who have entered their USA Swimming Member ID into the system will be eligible for submission to the SWIMS Database.</p> <p>Please note the ID numbers for all USA Swimming athletes changed in 2022. Please confirm you have the correct ID number for your athlete by logging into usaswimming.org prior to entering it into Swimtopia. The CSRA Swim League will submit all results for eligible USA Swimming members to the GA Swimming SWIMS Database coordinator at the conclusion of the meet. Any missing times or other inaccuracies are the responsibility of the coach of the athlete and not Meet Management.</p>
<p>DECK ACCESS:</p>	<p>Only swimmers participating in the current session, coaches/shepherds, and CSRA Swim League-designated meet volunteers (i.e. Timers, Heat Coordinators, Meet Marshals, Officials, etc.) will be allowed on deck. All other swimmers, siblings, parents, and other spectators should remain in the lobby, the stands, or outside the facility.</p> <p>Meet Marshals will be strictly controlling deck access. Team reps are responsible for informing their parents/spectators about the deck control policy and developing a way to communicate with their children and/or their team's coaches/shepherds during the meet. In</p>

	<p>addition, teams are encouraged to develop a plan to escort their younger swimmers from the pool deck doors to their team's assigned bleacher area prior to warm-ups. Parents <u>will not</u> be allowed on deck to take their swimmers to the bleachers, pass snacks/towels/games, remind swimmers of events, retrieve swimmers at the completion of their events, or for any other reason. Team reps are responsible for the conduct of their team's parents/spectators and arguing or attempts at forcing entry onto the pool deck will not be tolerated. Violators may be removed from the facility by Meet Marshals or Law Enforcement, if necessary.</p> <p>Team reps will be provided color-coded wristbands for their coaches/shepherds to be granted access to the pool deck. Team reps and Head Coaches will automatically receive wristbands. The number of wristbands provided will be based on the number of swimmers each team has entered in a particular session and will be distributed according to the following ratios, with a minimum of two additional wristbands per session provided to each team plus: Session 1 (13-18): 1 coach/shepherd for every 10 swimmers Session 2 (9-12): 1 coach/shepherd for every 8 swimmers Session 3 (8&Under): 1 coach/shepherd for ever 6 swimmers</p> <p>Coaches/shepherds include any Assistant Coach, "Junior" Coach or adult/teen volunteer that is not a swimmer entered to compete in the session. Team reps are responsible for determining how they will distribute their wrist bands. No one without an appropriately colored wristband will be allowed on the pool deck.</p>
COACHES MEETING:	A meeting for the Head Coaches, or their designee, of each participating team will be held at the Augusta Aquatic Center on Saturday 6/22/25 at 730 am. Further details will be provided closer to the meet.
RELAY ENTRIES	Coaches will be handed relay cards prior to each session with the listed relay swimmers for each event. Coaches will need to review swimmers and make any substitutions on the card and turn in to the clerk of course in the Meeting Room 1 hour ahead of the start.
OFFICIALS:	All officials will be USA Swimming-certified and in good standing. Credentials will be checked prior to the start of the meet. The officials' uniform will consist of a white collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirt or slacks with white socks and white shoes. Officials

	<p>are encouraged to always wear name badges. There will be an officials' meeting 60 minutes prior to the start of each session. USA Swimming-certified officials interested in helping should contact the Meet Referee at: mike.groves@swim-asl.com</p>
WARM-UP POLICY:	<p>Warm up will begin one hour prior to each event. Lane assignments will be handed out during the Coaches Meeting on and will be based on the number of athletes entered per team. One-way start lanes will be opened for the last 15 minutes of each warm-up to allow athletes to practice diving from the blocks.</p>
CONCESSIONS:	<p>There will be different teams running concessions at each session. Candy and snacks will be served during all sessions. Breakfast and lunch food will be served during their sessions. ALL SESSIONS ARE ACCEPTING CASH ONLY!</p>
VOLUNTEERS:	<p>-Volunteer positions for each participating team will be assigned by CSRA Swim League Meet Management and will be distributed based on team size. Assignments will be distributed at least 1 week prior to the meet. Due to the size/complexity of the All Star Meet, assigned volunteer positions may not correlate with a team's particular number of swimmer entries in a given session (i.e. some teams may be assigned a volunteer position for a session they do not have a swimmer entered into). Regardless, it is the responsibility of the Team Reps to fill their assigned volunteer spots. "Swaps" may be arranged by Team Reps prior to the meet, but volunteers are instructed to check-in under the *original* team's name.</p> <p>-Volunteer check in will be at the front desk of the Aquatic Center. At check in, volunteers will be provided a position nametag and a color-coded wristband to gain access to the pool deck for their session. No one without an appropriately colored wristband will be allowed on the pool deck, regardless of whether they have a volunteer position nametag. Volunteers need to check in no later than one hour prior to the start of their session.</p> <p>-Teams that are responsible for timing slots need to provide their own stopwatches.</p>
Ready Bench/Staging Area	<p>A ready bench or staging area will be used. Coaches/Shepherds will bring swimmers to the staging area. Volunteers will line swimmers up by lane and event. Then they will be walked</p>

	from the staging area to their blocks. Shepherds please stay until the volunteer dismisses you in case there are last
Swimmers with a Disability:	Coaches of swimmers with a disability (SWAD) that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Referee at mike.groves@swim-asl.com . Failure to provide advance notice may limit the Host's ability to accommodate all requests.
AWARDS:	Awards will be available in the "weight room" and should be picked up by the Head Coach or Team Rep at the completion of the meet.
HEAT SHEETS:	Heat sheets will be emailed to all Team Reps as soon as possible after the Divisionals meets. Teams should print their own copies for use by their coaches/shepherds. Two heatsheets will be posted on the pool deck, and in the pool lobby, but will not be otherwise distributed to parents at the Aquatic Center. Information will be uploaded into the Swimtopia app.
RESULTS:	Results will be posted on deck, on the wall outside the concessions, and via the Swimtopia app.
SPECTATORS & ADMISSION:	Seating is very limited and admission to the event is governed by the Fire Marshal's capacity set for this facility. Spectators must remain in the stands, the lobby, or outside the facility. Please see above for the Deck Access plan. Please follow the instructions of facility staff, Meet Marshals, Fire Marshals and Law Enforcement. Failure to do so may result in removal from the venue.
