Facility:	The Dresden Swim Center features an outdoor 8-lane, 50-meter by 25-yard competition course. The water depth ranges from 4' 8" to 6' at the start end and from 4" to 4'6" at the turn end. The pool is surrounded by a large grassy park for swimmer camps and spectator seating. Bleacher seating is not available.

Meet Information	
Facility Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The competition course and diving well are open to meet participants ONLY. All other areas of the pool, including the shallow splash area and wading pool are CLOSED during the meet. Rest rooms, locker rooms and showers are available. Team camping and spectator seating is available in the park area surrounding the pool and grassy areas outside the gates. Tents and chairs are permitted. Coolers are permitted. All bags and coolers are subject to search. Upon conclusion of the meet, all teams must clean up their area and put trash in the proper receptacles. Spectators are not permitted at the start and turn ends (inside the cones) of the competition course. This space is reserved for meet officials, coaches, and timers. For safety reasons, spectators and meet participants shall not stand on the flower boxes/planters/retaining walls along the sides of the pool. Stormy weather (thunder and lightning) in the area will cause a meet delay per facility policy.
Safe Sport and Photography Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the competition course during race starts, competition and warm-ups. Deck changes are prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.
Parking	Parking is available in the lots at the Dresden Swim Center, Dresden Elementary and Tri-Valley Middle School. Street parking is NOT permitted.
Concessions	Full concessions will be available onsite at "The Hangout" and food trucks will be onsite. Cash, credit, and debit cards accepted.

Technical Suit Ban	Per TCAL Bylaws no tech suits will be allowed. A Technical Suit is one that has the following components: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or • Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.
Applicable Ohio State Laws	Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3314.03) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Certified lifeguards will be on duty as required by Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.

Meet Entries	
Eligibility:	Swimmers must have swum in at least three (3) league meets to be eligible to compete in the champs meet. Swimmers must have swum in at least one league meet in each event in which they are entered.
Entry Limits:	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 2 individual events and 2 relay events.
Entry Procedures:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entries must be completed in SwimTopia. • Only entry times from the current season may be used. "No Time" (NT) entries will not be accepted. • Submit names for relays. • Entries must be locked and ready to be merged by 6pm on Saturday, July 13, 2024. • Late entries will not be accepted unless approved by the Championship Meet committee. All late entries approved will be assessed a \$50 fine. • Coaches are responsible for checking their entry submissions. It is recommended that teams print and review Meet Participant and Meet Entry reports before <u>and</u> after locking entries to ensure entries have been completed in SwimTopia. • Psych sheets will be posted to the TCAL website after the meet is merged.
Warm-up and Safety Guidelines:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm-ups procedures will be distributed prior to the meet. Lanes and times for each team will be assigned for the AM and PM sessions. • Warm-ups will be monitored by the Meet Director and Meet Referee (or their special designees). • Except during supervised racing starts, swimmers must enter the pool feet first. • The diving well will be open during the meet for continuous warm up/cool down ONLY.
Competition Guidelines:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will be a timed finals meet. • This meet will be contested in SCY. • This meet will be pre-seeded. Deck entries will not be accepted at the meet. • A clerk of course "bullpen" will be required for 10 & Under events only. All 11 & Over swimmers are expected to report to the blocks for their events several heats in advance. • All events will be seeded from slowest to fastest. All events will begin at the start end of the pool. Timers will move to the turn end for the 25's. Relay participants starting from the turn end must start in the water.

Meet Entries	
Awards:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A trophy will be awarded to the 1st place finisher in each event. Medals will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each event. Ribbons will be awarded to 4th – 16th place finishers in each event. The top team in each division will receive a trophy. Results will be available on the SwimTopia app.
