### AGENDA TOPICS

#### Merchandise

- Board will evaluate for future seasons if swimsuits will be provided depending on coaching staff expenses and increase on membership fees. Team caps and T-shirts should be provided as part of the team image.

#### Private Coaching Recommendations for DYSL Coaches

- Private coaching guidelines have been prepared and will be reviewed by the board and share with the Coach for his readiness. Guidelines are based on Attendance, Attainment, Attitude and parent's commitment to the volunteer roles.

#### Coaching Update

- Coach Mark successfully renewed his visa in Bahrain.
- Coach Saeed's received his visa approval from the government. However, he has not being able to obtain the visa stamp in the Embassy of Saudi Arabia in Cairo, Egypt. DYSL and Saeed continue to make all possible efforts to obtain the visa.
- Recreation have given the green light to bring coaches on guest visas to cope with the lack of coaching staff in the Team.
- Naouar Yassine (Tunisian Coach) was offered a coaching position. He will be brought initially on a guest coach visa.
- Coach's Jay (Ernest Ungoco) received visa approval from government. He is investigating if he can process the visa in Manila to come and assist in coaching.

### Clinics/guest speakers' requests

- Coach Gareth will come 2 weeks at the end of October 2022 to focus in coaching Minnows and Piranhas.
- Coach Snow, a Canada Swimming Coach to perform Coaching and video analysis in the swimmers is tentative to visit in February 2023 during the spring session.
- Waiting on Peak Performance (Nike-US Sports Camps partner) visa approvals to send out the link for camp registration to interested Juniors/Seniors swimmers.

### 2022 – 2023 Season Schedule

- New Swimmers tryouts will be to be performed on October 3, 2023.
- New swimmers and new groups to start on October 9, 2022.

### Treasurer update

- Zehra Aftab presented detailed report. Available upon request.
- Total cash held by recreation is 411,742 sar. DYSL cash in hand 170,439.84 sar including Fall 2022 returning swimmers fees.

### Other Items

- Lanre to investigate how SSF pool can be booked for practices.
- The Saudi Swimming Federation meets run in 50 m Pool allow 9-10 years old to swim the 200 IM. To enable swimmers to achieve entry times in this event, it will be added to the 9-10 age group in future meets starting with the Frankenmeet on October 29.
- Liam purchased cables required to fix the scoreboard.
- Barbara continues to be the focal point of contact for international meets.
- Jose Valbuena to review the rules for no show in internal meets in DYSL handbooks.
